1. In view of the fact that problems of requisitioning may arise in your area, forwarded herewith for your use is an additional copy of AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No. 20 of 3 April 45, which supersedes AAI Administrative Instruction No. 10, 1944 and AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No. 54, 1944.

2. Your attention is called to the conditions governing requisition of a Listed Monument in territory behind rear army boundaries. Responsibility for authorizing requisition is not here delegated, but rests with AFHQ in consultation with the Monuments and Fine Arts Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission. Regional Commissioners are not therefore entitled to approve directly of the occupation of any Listed Monument in such territory. Advice should be addressed in such cases to this Headquarters for the attention of the Monuments and Fine Arts Sub-Commission.
