1. The British Liaison Officer in the area immediately south of PARMA reports that all art treasures from the city of PARMA are stored in a castle at TORRECHIARA (L 0570) and those from REGGIO in the Castello GIUGLIA, above the village of SPILAMBERTO (L 6353).

To : Director, MFA&A, Sub-Commission.

1. The following places in Northern Italy may contain deposits or Archives of the greatest importance.

a. GARGNANO sul Lago di Garda (Brescia). F 4183
Palazzo Feltrinelli.

Secret Archives of Mussolini (political and military).

b. ROCCA DELLE CAMINATE (Forlì). N 4105

The Castello was the residence of Mussolini and contained correspondence with D'Annunzio and other personal papers.

c. TRESCORE (Bergamo). K 7686.

Address unknown, but it is believed that the Archives of the "Ufficio Storico dello Stato Maggiore" removed from ROME to ORVIETO were later transferred to this village. 426c

2. Although it is presumed that a. and b. will be dealt with by G-2 agents it is suggested that MFA & A Officers in the field should be in possession of this information.
