5. The above-mentioned minimums include the following elements:
 Monthly wages on present basis referring a 48 hour week;
 War Indemnity;
 Contingenza Indemnity.

In cases where the above-mentioned minimums are not reached for each category an integrating allowance of the Contingenza Indemnity will be granted so as to reach the minimums. The monthly minimums, thus guaranteed, in no way modifies the contract clauses concerning working hours, payment for overtime, holidays, night work, etc. in the sense that the respective percentages on increases to be therefore granted besides the above-mentioned minimums must be paid.

The best actual conditions both existing for and acquired by workers are thereby confirmed, and therefore all the special indemnities for transfer to work, and of any other kind, remain valid besides the minimum laid down.

6. In cases of unjustified absence and absence following suspension from work as punishment, the above-mentioned minimums will be reduced for each full day of absence as follows:

1/26 of the total of the daily Contingenza Indemnity, war Indemnity, as also of the difference between the established minimum, and the sum reached by the monthly Indemnity of Contingenza and Indemnity of War.

Example:

for a skilled worker, for each day of absence in question, the monthly minimum is Lire 7500, it will be decreased by Lire 273, that is the following formula:

$$100 + 20 + \frac{7500 - (3000 + 520)}{26} = 273$$

This is a specimen Liguria Agrest containing minimum wages clause. There is no comprehensive Milan Agrest for Liguria (at any rate I cannot trace it) but the Gov. has dealt with the issue by a series of separate agrests for different industries — & all of them contain this minimum wages provision. Note — this (& other) agrests made before Milan.

Lecho has taken original agrest note to discuss at Milan — from angle that

- a. It is not as revolutionary as it gets implied — the 7500 lire is for specialization — & the average minimum wage is not excessive.

- b. There is no question of meeting Milan firms' agrest made before Milan.

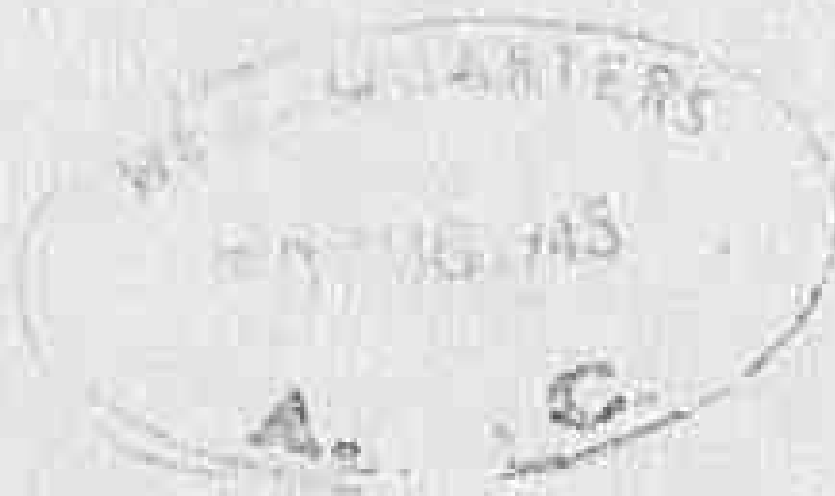

Subject is strike agricultural workers, reference your signal 4300 cite ACLAB. Agricultural workers throughout island but principally in CALTANISSETTA and AGRIGENTO are in agitation as to the implementation of Decreto Legge 319 of 19 October 1944 referring to the division of the autumn crop between landowners and workers. Regional Labor Office had arranged for conference between Federterra (workers) and Unione Delle Associazioni Agrarie (landowners) for 9 August and then postponed it to 13 August. Purpose was to reach agreement regarding division of autumn crop. Landowners group refused to participate. Since then the workers have been agitating to have landowners come to an agreement with them. Landowners do not wish to enter into such an agreement as they feel that the Commissioni Circondariali in each province in their judicial arbitrary character are empowered to deal with each situation that might arise between landowners and workers. No incidents reported but situation appears to be deteriorating. Agitation based on economic issues.

Subject is special police force for VENEZIA GIULIA. Pending receipt from Combined Chiefs of Staff of approval in principle for the formation of this force interim directive is being issued by this Hq. Following are interim instructions on pay and conditions of service.

1. All pay and allowances and other expenditures will be met from funds as arranged by AMG.
2. You will determine such rates of pay and family allowances as deemed appropriate by you in the circumstances pertaining in VENEZIA GIULIA provided such rates do not exceed current rates for the CORR in ITALY.
3. Payments for compensation for injury are to be determined by you but will not exceed current CORR scales.
4. You are authorized to institute a scheme for gratuity at time of discharge based on not more than 1 months pay for 12 months service or a proportionate sum for lesser period.
5. No fixed period of service will be established. Service of members of police force may be terminated at any time by AMG on one months' notice.
6. Remaining questions will be dealt with in interim directive from this Hq.

Subject is disturbance in TORINO. Reference is made to your cable No 1942 on results of meeting between Camera Del Lavoro and Unione Industriale regarding the demonstration organised by the Unione Donne Italiane.

2. FIORIO Industrial representative signed agreement conceding equal treatment to women in respect of CARO VITA indemnity. FIORIO signed under pressure of disorderly demonstration and in that he was told by Italian authorities present that he would be responsible for any eventual disorders that might ensue if his signature was not forthcoming.

3. Regional Commissioner has been informed of situation and your LSC/413 dated 14 July 45 has been brought to his notice. It is intended to take a stand over this issue and an official press statement now being prepared to declare the agreement null and void and to make it known that any agreement overshooting the MILAN wage ceilings would require Italian Government approval.

4. Detailed reports on events and action taken will follow at earliest possible time.

Dear Minister,

The Regional Commissioner, Piemonte, reports that as the result of a disorderly demonstration of women workers in Turin on 14th July, the Unione Industriali have, under pressure, signed an agreement to give equal treatment to women workers in respect of the recent indemnity.

In view of the fact that the Italian Government have decided to apply the principles of the Milan Agreement to Northern Italy, it is considered that an important variation such as the granting of equal terms to the women should not be made without the knowledge and approval of the Italian Government. The Regional Commissioner is accordingly refusing to recognise the agreement and we should be glad to learn at the earliest opportunity the decision of the Italian Government with regard to this Turin variation.

Subject is labour demonstration in TORINO.

At 0900 on 14 July an unauthorised demonstration was organised by the Unione Donne Italiane (Communist Organisation). Some 5,000 women from leading factories like Fiat Mirafiori Lancia Riv Marus were involved.

Reasons for demonstration were 1. elimination of differential between men and women heads of families in connection with TORINO industrial agreement for high cost of living bonus 2. elimination of differential between male and female bonus for juveniles 3 insistence that Unione Donne Italiane should be allowed controls over sepral and on the economic situation in general.

The demonstration first went to Camera Del Lavoro where FLECONIA Communist Joint Secretary addressed them saying that labour representatives had done their utmost to obtain the most advantageous terms for workpeople.

From the Camera Del Lavoro demonstrators proceeded to the premises of the Unione Industriale where they remained until 1100 hours ingeniore FIORIO Chief Industrial Exponent decided to receive a deputation. When FIORIO was presented with points aforementioned he explained that industrialists had met all requests presented by the Camera Del Lavoro and that it was not possible for him to deal with demonstrations or with individual workers but was prepared to contact official Labour Representatives.

An appointment was fixed for 1500 hours between FIORIO and FLESCCHIA but this did not meet with the approval of demonstrators who then broke into the industrialists building causing some damage and scattering such documents as were within reach. FIORIO was taken to the balcony from where he gave public assurance that he would contact FLESCCHIA immediately.

On leaving the building FIORIO and AVVOCATO CODICHI principal executive of the Unione Industriale were subjected to considerable abuse and threats. They were afforded police protection as they moved away but the latter was later accompanied under police escort to the Questura. The demonstration broke up at 1315 hours.

Joint secretaries of Camera Del Lavoro are holding meeting of womens Commissioni Interne evening and at 1900 hours will be meeting FIORIO with more specific requests and suggestions. FIORIO has protested vigorously with joint secretaries over undisciplined and aggressive action of demonstrators. Joint secretaries beginning to feel that the situation is not altogether under their control. CARLO NOLA Socialist Joint Secretary expressed disappointment and concern over demonstration while RAFFELLI DEMO CHRISTIANO Joint Secretary referred sarcastically to the organised "Spontaneity" of the agitation.

The former addressed the crowd now amounting to over 15,000 saying that he was not in a position to suspend the publication as authority for this had come from LONDON. Provincial Commissioner confirmed above had been that one this newspaper would of course not be publishing fascist inspired articles, 2. he would bring to the notice of his superiors the objective of the demonstration, 3. discipline and order were to be maintained.

Repeat to Regional Commissioners Milan, Turin, Genoa, Padua, Bologna, SCAO 5th Army AMG., SCAO 4th Corps, SCAO 8th Army, G-5 AFHQ. attention Regional Labour Officers, Subject Wages in industry in Northern Italy meeting at Milan on 8th July attended by representatives of industrialists from Genova, Torino and Milan, Ministers Gronchi, Ruini, Barbareschi and Amendola, Romita, discuss proposed indennità contingenza for private industries as applicable to workers fully employed and those suspended for working only part time.

Discussion lasted five hours and resulted in agreement to apply in Genoa the principles of the Milan agreement throughout Northern Italy.

Note for Regional Commissioner Genoa. This means a variation of the terms of the Genoa agreement which had proposed full pay for those suspended or working part time and will now be modified to provide 75% instead.

Industrialists will meet 25% of these 75% while the "Cassa Integrazione" will be subsidized by the Italian Treasury as necessary to provide the remaining 50%. The extent to which if at all the State will require industry to repay sums advanced to "Cassa Integrazione" will be discussed further at Rome.

Agreement for payment of indennità contingenza based upon Milan agreement and in general providing 120 lire per day for

Bologna, SCAO 5th Army AMG., SCAO 4th Corps, SCAO 8th Army, G-5 AFHQ. attention Regional Labour Officers, Subject Wages in industry in Northern Italy meeting at Milan on 8th July attended by representatives of industrialists from Genova, Torino and Milan, Ministers Gronchi, Ruini, Barbereschi and Amendola, Romita, discuss proposed indennità contingenza for private industries as applicable to workers fully employed and those suspended for working only part time.

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Note for Regional Commissioner Genoa. This means a variation of the terms of the Genoa agreement which had proposed full pay for those suspended or working part time and will now be modified to provide 75% instead.

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Agreement for payment of indennità contingenza based upon Milan agreement and in general providing 120 lire per day for adult heads of family, scaling down for other workers absorbing and therefore abolishing indennità di guerra, but adding dependents' allowance at 15 lire per day up to three dependents which provides for 75% of such contingenza to be paid to suspended or part time workers may therefore be approved by AMG. because the Italian Government undertake to subsidize "Cassa Integrazione" as necessary and are in agreement with the arrangements made between representatives of industrialists and workers.

Industrialists expressed concern that Provincial Offices of "Cassa Integrazione and Previdenza" should be immediately advised and put in financial condition to make necessary advances of cash to employers payable on behalf of previdenza.

Minister Barbareschi guaranteed immediate instructions from Rome. Suggest Labour Sub-Commission and Finance Sub-Commission co-operate to insure early issue of instructions and that Provincial Finance Officers be advised by Finance Sub-Commission.

Ministers Ruini, Romita and Gronchi gave clear undertakings to operate alternative work schemes and relief measures without "bureaucratic" delay, so that prior to 30 September when wages agreement is due to expire, the employment conditions shall have materially improved to such an extent as to substantially relieve the burden on industry. Doubtless this aspect will be discussed at Friday's conference. There was no opportunity to mention price of bread for other details during five hours' session which at times was heated. It will be advisable for Labour Sub-Commission to go into detail with Barbareschi at Rome.

Printed copies of General Order 48 not yet available for posting in the north. This lamentable delay fully prejudices application of earlier agreement between Alcom and Italian Government as this agreement is becoming out of date.

Emilia and Venezia may expect to be requested to approve agreement on Milan model with some provincial differences.

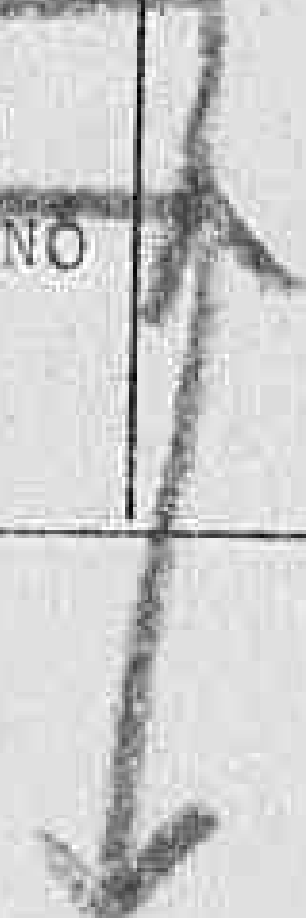

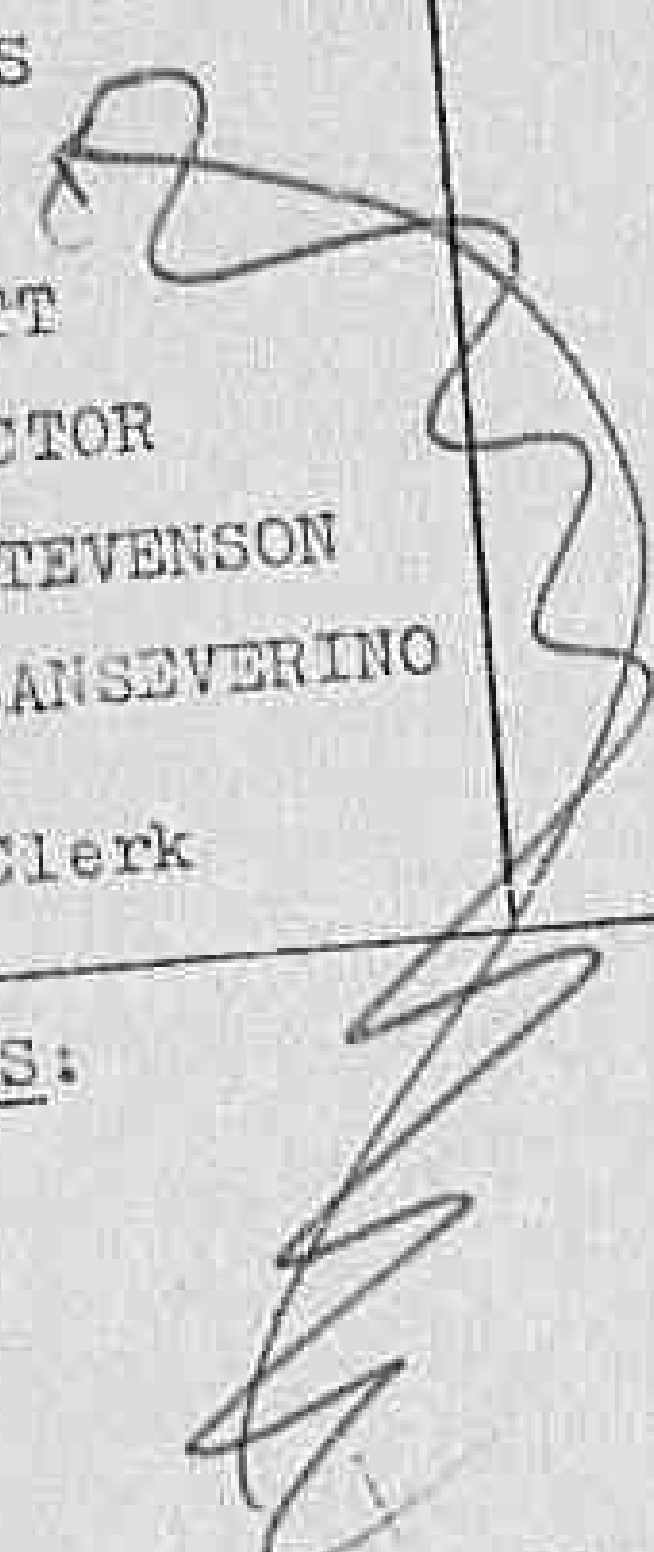

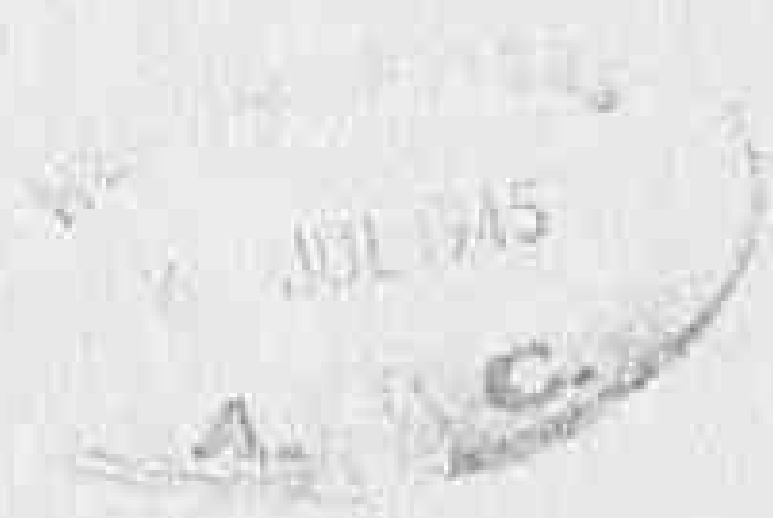
