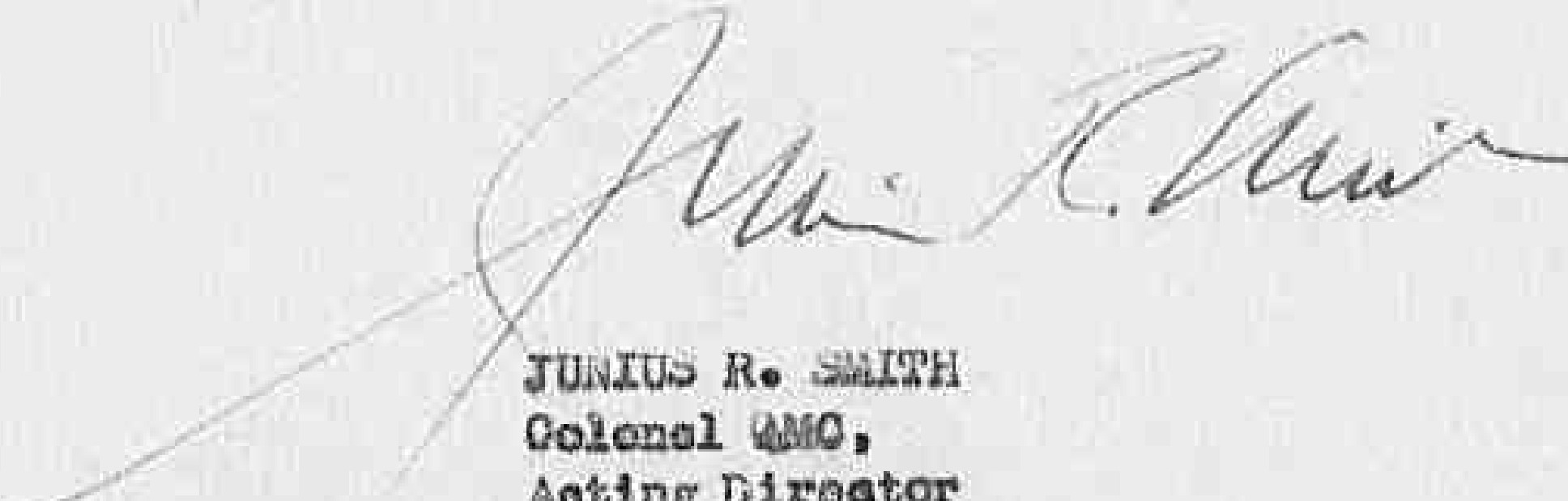

2. This procedure has not been correctly carried out in all cases in the returns recently submitted, and it is, therefore, requested that particular care be taken to ensure that this information is accurate in the future.

3. In case there is any doubt regarding the qualifying periods for British Officers, it should be noted that Acting rank is convertible into Temporary rank under Art 121 of the Royal Warrant and the periods of time necessary are as under:

4. The change from Acting to Temporary rank carries with it the War Substantive rank of one rank below. All 2nd Lieutenants will automatically be promoted to the rank of War Substantive Lieutenant on completion of 6 months commissioned service on full pay during the emergency, in the absence of a non-recommendation.

2. 16098/C-1, 14 February 1944 calling for a monthly return of officers and NCOs is cancelled.

3. A monthly return in triplicate of officers will be forwarded to the Economic Section by 0900 hrs. 4th of each month showing officers assigned or attached to Sub-Commissions. Form ACC R-1 attached will be used. Additional copies may be obtained from HQ, Commandant.

4. Information given by some Sub-Commissions in the February return was not only incomplete but some details were inaccurate. All Sub-Commissions please ensure that returns are fully checked before they are forwarded and that all officers who have been assigned are shown and that officers who have been released from assignment are not shown.

5. The medical categories given were many and varied. American personnel should be given either a G.S. or I.S. and other original unofficial classifications will not be used.

6. British officers are either A, B or C and sub-classification used in the case of B's do not apply.

7. Regt. or Corps classification requires the arm of the service e.g. Inf., C.A.B., or R.A. etc. 2675 Regt. will not be used in this column.

8. Column (E) must be completed giving the date and reference of the order for attachment.

9. Column (F) will show the city or district where the officer is located and "HQ A.C.C." will not be used.

12. Your cooperation in maintaining accurate personnel records will be greatly appreciated.
