are as follows:

1. Colonel Carlos A. Smith - now Acting Director.
Will remain in that capacity until arrival of civilian head
in which case he will assist the latter for the period of time he specifies.
Thereafter will be assigned to Comarca Region as Regional
Labor Officer.
2. Colonel James E. Belmont - at present Deputy Director.
He is leaving shortly for special assignment in Legation-
Piedras Blancas. Will accompany Col. Smith to the Comarca Region
as Assistant Regional Labor Officer.
3. Colonel R. Lopez Lugo - liaison with the Mexican Govern-
ment.
Will remain with Headquarters as Regional Labor Officer for
Mexico Region.
4. Captain James E. Smith - now Headquarters as Field Opera-
tions Officer.
Will be assigned to Mexico Region as Regional Labor Officer.
5. Captain John A. Smith - just assigned out of Headquarters
to 5th Army. Thereafter, will be assigned as Assistant
Regional Labor Officer, Mexico Region.
6. Captain J. E. Williams - now Headquarters, in charge of Social
Insurance Division.
Should remain at this post for some time but if need be, will
be assigned as Regional Labor Officer, Mexico Region.
7. Captain John A. Smith - just assigned to 5th Army.
Subsequently will become Regional Labor Officer for Pie-
dras Blancas Region.
8. Captain J. E. Smith - at present assigned to 5th Army
as Assistant Labor Officer and cleared to become Assistant
Regional Labor Officer for Mexico Region. However, Captain

James is at present ill in hospital in Rome, and his future availability is uncertain.

9. Lieutenant J. Venturi - just assigned from Headquarters to 5th Army as Assistant Labor Officer. Subsequently to be assigned as Assistant Labor Officer for Emilia Region.

10. Lt. Col. James A. Lane - at present assigned Labor Officer 5th Army. No change contemplated.

11. Major Thomas R. Bishop - present assignment as Regional Labor Officer Marche Abruzzi Molise Region. May be assigned as Regional Labor Officer Emilia Region.

12. Major R. Hall - present assignment as Regional Labor Officer Toscana Region. No change contemplated.

13. Captain Jeff Robertson - present assignment as Assistant Labor Officer Army 5th Army. No change contemplated.

14. Captain Robert Finzer - present assignment as Assistant Regional Labor Officer Toscana. No change contemplated.

15. Captain R. Holsten - present assignment as Regional Labor Officer Umbria-Lazio Region.
(Major Cicchuna (B) at present Labor Relations Officer, Headquarters. When no longer needed at Headquarters, it is planned to assign the Major as Regional Labor Officer Umbria-Lazio Region, but retain Captain Holsten as Assistant Regional Labor Officer.)

16. Captain Michel E. Bailey - present assignment as Assistant Regional Labor Officer Marche Abruzzi Molise Region. No change contemplated.

17. Captain L. Lessandrini - at present Assistant Regional Labor Officer Southern Region. No immediate change contemplated.

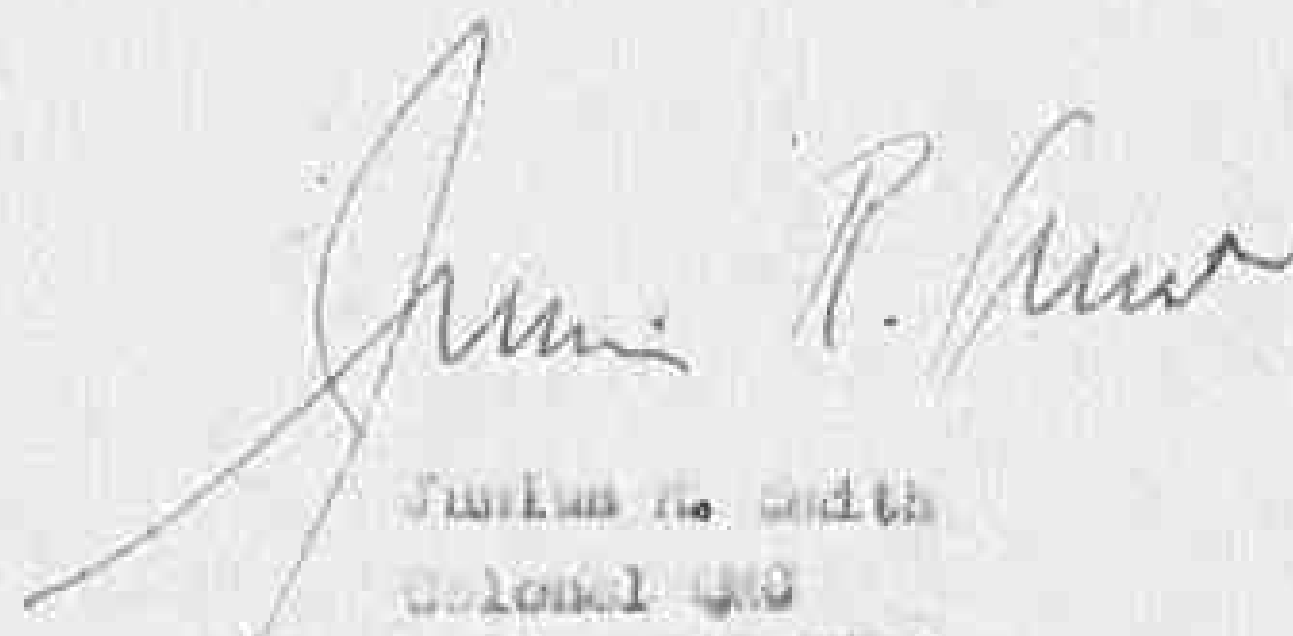
