You wrote to us on 18 July, Proct. No. 10648 and Proct No. 10651, requesting assistance in obtaining the release of quantity of cement from Morgnano to Terni, allotment of cosl, and transportation of the cement and coal. E. All the problems raised are now within the competence of the Italian Government. The following are, however, specific points which may be of interest to your (a) Cement -- Certain operating cement plants have now been handed back to Government control and application for cement for civilian purposes should be made to the Italian Ministry of Industry 1613 and Commerce. (b) Cosl -- Requests for solid fuel should be made to the Italian Winistry of Industry and Commerce. Arrangements for the allocation of coke to Terni are under consideration. (c) Transport -- The Italian State Railways have now taken over the responsibility for the raception of requests for transportation and the preparation of loading programs for the movement of civilian traffic by land. Rome, 16 July 1945 TO: the LABOUR SUB-COMMISSION Allied Commission Rome and, for information: the MINISTER OF INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE TO: LABOUR RECOMSTRUCTION AGRICULTURE TRANSPORTATION Rome In order to face the very serious danger of unemployment with which several thousands workers of the industrial centre of Terni are confronted, the Confederal Labour Chamber of that town, through this CGIL, has asked the intervention of the Labour Sub-Commission as well as of the interested Ministries, in order to obtain the release of a certain quantity of cement from Morgnano (by Spoleto) to Terni and an allotment of at least 2500 tons of coal per month, in order to afford the necessary means for the production of carbide and calcip-cyanamide in Papigno (Terni). In order to effect the transportation of the said cement and coal, as well as to continue the transportation which is actually going on of the brown coal (lignite) from Morgano to Terni, the allotment of means of transportation is necessary, preferably by railways, because otherwise the requested allotment of stocks of dement and coal could not have any practical effect. We are quite certain that this Labour Sub-Commission will grant the requests set forth in our letters, and we sek also that the reallways or road means of transportation -1٤

to Termi, should be adequate to the quantity of materials to be released.

Unemployment is threatening: therefore it is urgent to begin a few works of the greatest necessity, such as the re-building of houses for the workers. For this, the allotment of a congruous stock of cement is necessary. Cement is obtainable on alarge scale in Termi' territory (Morgnano by Spoleto) and intil quite recently the entire output was blocked up on account of the war necessities. The war operations having ceased, the output was heaped up in the siles, to such a point as to cause the discontinuance of the work, unless an action is taken for removal of the blockade. Therefore the Confederal Labour Chamber of Terni is saking that a portion of the cement in question should be made available for the above mentioned re-building activity.
