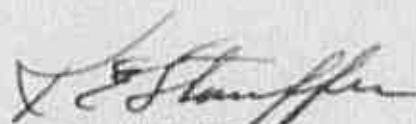

SUBJECT: Wages Regulation in Private Industry in Emilia,
Venetia, Liguria, Lombardy and Piemonte Regions.

TO : Legal Sub-Commission

1. It has been decided in principle that the wage rates prevailing in industry in Northern Italy on 8 April, 1945, should be recognized, but that no change in wage rates should be allowed to take effect unless previously approved by AFU through the Regional Commissioner.

2. It is requested that an Order be prepared for general promulgation through the Regions of Emilia, Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardy and Venetia giving effect to this decision and saying that proposals to vary wage rates, as the result of negotiations between representatives of industry and of organized workers, should be submitted to the nearest Ufficio del Lavoro for transmission to the appropriate Regional Commissioner for his approval. It is also requested that a form of approval, a form of rejection, and a form requesting the negotiating parties to reconsider the proposal be drafted in legal form.
