SUBJECT: Proposed Labor Convention in Milan, 24-25 June.

TO : Acting Vice President
Economic Section

1. It is understood that the General Confederation of Italian Labor desire to have a meeting of delegates from the various Camere del Lavoro in Northern Italy, to be held at Milan on 24th and 25th June. The meeting would consist of 200 properly appointed delegates and would not be open to the general public. The questions to be discussed would be general labor questions and not party politics.

2. In accordance with the policy of recognizing organized labor in the form of the CGIL, and following the precedent set in respect of the First National Congress held at Naples at the end of January, 1945, it is recommended that approval be given for the holding of the proposed convention, subject to any conditions which it may be thought desirable to impose.
