A list of workers and technicians, who are prisoners of war, was forwarded to you with letter N° 254 A.G. of 31.3.1945, with the object of proposing for repatriation, among others, the Lieutenant Simeone Pasquale, son of Filippo, N° 80999, belonging to camp 28, Wing 3/A, c/o G.P.O. Bombay (India).

This Ministry is requesting you kindly to furnish particular information about the above mentioned Lieutenant, regarding his repatriation by care of the Allied Commission.

This request is grounded on the fact, regularly proved, that on 17 March 1945 the father of the mentioned officer died, leaving the family in a hard situation. This family, indeed, composed of the mother who is very old and not very healthy, a sister, wife of an officer of the Italian Army who is actually prisoner of war in Egypt, with three little children - gets the means for its subsistence from the cultivating of various pieces of land. After the death of the only person able to administer them, these lands are now rather abandoned, so that the family remains without any income.

With reference to our conversation of Tuesday last, I have great pleasure in sending to you copies of the following publications issued by the British Ministry of Labour:

- (1) Industrial Relations Handbook
- (2) Ministry of Labour Gazette, for the months of June and July 1945
- (3) Ministry of Labour Handbook
- (4) Engineering Bulletin, for September 1944 - page 8 of which gives up-to-date details of the organisation of the Ministry.

I note that copies of the Ministry of Labour Gazette are sent to you each month by Mr. Braine from the British Embassy.

With regard to your nephew who is a Prisoner of War in India, as indicated in telephone message of yesterday, I have consulted the appropriate Allied Authorities on this matter, and it is suggested that you should make a further application for the release of your nephew through Italian Government channels, and send to us a copy of such application. Dear Signor Barbareschi,

The Italian Prisoners of War Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission has drawn our attention to the fact that the Uffici del Lavoro at Bologna, Piacenza, Modena and Ravenna have, during the last ten days or so forwarded a considerable number of applications for the repatriation of specially qualified prisoners of war.

These applications have been addressed direct to the Italian Prisoners of War Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission, whereas they should have been submitted through Italian Government channels for a decision by the Council of Ministers and for the application of a priority.

It has been necessary to pass the applications to the Italian Ministry of Post-War Assistance for their action and recommendation.

In order, therefore, that delay and unnecessary work may be obviated, it would be appreciated if you would request the Uffici del Lavoro in the towns mentioned to arrange to forward any further applications of this nature through Italian Government channels in the first place, instead of addressing them direct to the Allied Commission.

1. This confirms telephone conversation: PROCTOR-BROODBANK and acknowledges your LSC/1003 dated 11 Aug.
2. During the last ten days this Sub Comm. has received packages containing applications of this nature from the "Ufficio Regionale del Lavoro (Ministero del Lavoro e della Previdenza Sociale)" at BOLOGNA, PIACENZA, MODENA, RAVENNA.
3. All such applications must be submitted through Italian channels for a decision by the Council of Ministers, and allocation of priority.
4. Allied Commission then deals with such cases as may be forwarded by the Italian Ministry of Post War Assistance (PW Bureau) on behalf of the Council of Ministers.
5. Applications received, and referred to at para 2 above have been passed to the Italian authorities and request has been made that local labor offices be informed of the correct procedure.
6. As it seems likely that this sudden influx of applications is due to misguided advice given by AC labour representatives in this area, may the correct procedure as outlined above, please be brought to the notice of these concerned.

Reference is made to your letter of 16 August,
Proct. No. 3915/0514 with which you enclosed a list of
Italian workers at present in Germany.

Inquiries have been made in this office and it is
regretted that there does not appear to be any machinery of
Allied Commission through which contact can be made with
the individuals concerned. We are, however, informed that it
is a responsibility of the Italian Red Cross to make in-
quiries through their own channels with regard to Italians
who have been taken away from Italy to work in other countries.
It is suggested that you forward details of the workers to the
Italian Red Cross and that you elicit their help in tracing
these people through the International Red Cross machinery.

It is regretted that we have not been able to give
material assistance, but it is hoped that efforts on the lines
we suggest above will be successful.


