As determined by the Local Sub-Committee of the Labor and Wages Control Committee, per authority contained in AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 25, dated 18 April 1945, the following changes effective 1 May 1945 are published for necessary action by employing units of the Allied Commission located within the boundaries of Rome Province.
