3. The share for the thrashing is apportioned on the basis of the total production. If the feeders are supplied by the employers the share for the thrashing is 1% less.
4. Wine to be given to "meandini" L. 50 a litre.
5. The hail insurance is divided pro-quota for the price as well as for the danger.
