1. The survey which was started last month to determine the transportation needs of the Ispettorato was completed. The Regional Offices of the Ispettorato in Bari and Potenza were contacted and the head of each of these Regional Offices was interviewed.

2. These interviews disclosed that conditions here are similar to those found in the Regional Offices contacted on the first phase of my trip. Continual pressure is being put on these offices by the Ministry of Labor and the Italian Statistical Bureau for information and these offices are finding it very difficult to comply with all requests because of lack of transportation.

3. As was the fact in the first phase of my trip, no promise was made that we would definitely supply the needed tires for any requisitioned cars. It was clearly understood that after the cars were requisitioned an attempt would be made to get tires with no definite promise.

4. In Bari and Potenza I was told by the Ispettorato that their offices had been trying to get cars for months. However, when I made them understand that it would be necessary to requisition a car the very day I was there, in order to receive my full cooperation, they did so.

5. All offices have indicated that they will be able to supply necessary tubes.

6. It is recommended that the writer be permitted to take all steps which he may deem necessary to have the tires, which the Transportation Sub-Commission has promised him for this purpose, delivered to the Italian Government.

MEMORANDUM FOR FILE

SUBJECT: Mr. Cerrito's action regarding Ispettorato.

Attached herewith are copies of two telegrams in Italian which Mr. Cerrito proposed to send in advance of his recent trip to the various offices of the Ispettorato del Lavoro, in which he makes a probable commitment about furnishing tires for the automobiles of the inspectors. Obviously such a "probability" means definite action to the Italian mind, a fact with which Mr. Cerrito has not had the opportunity to become acquainted.

He further addressed the wire to ACC Reggio, which is non-existent. These wires were sent to the front office without my knowledge and were fortunately, however, brought to me for initialing at which time I was able to stop their transmission.

It is obvious that such incredible naivete can prove exceedingly embarrassing to the Sub-Commission's activities. Fortunately I detailed Captain Dorf to go along on the trip and no commitments for tires were actually made.

SUBJECT: Report on the first phase of the trip concerning the transportation problems of the Ispettorato

1. A survey was made to determine the best possible means of increasing the effectiveness of the Ispettorato. The Regional Offices of the Ispettorato in Reggio Calabria, Catania, Palermo, Cagliari, and Sassari were contacted and the head of each of the Regional Offices was interviewed.

2. These interviews disclosed that the Ispettorato's activities were very limited because of lack of transportation, which in turn was due to a lack of tires. Some of the cars were inspected and the condition of the tires confirmed the statements of the Ispettorato.

3. No tires were promised to the Ispettorato. It was explained that we would investigate and see if we could get some for them and that this in no way implied that we would.

4. From our interviews and inspection of the cars on hand it was disclosed that the Ispettorato could supply the tubes from other old cars with tires in an unusable condition.

5. It is recommended that the second phase of this survey be completed as soon as possible so that the information on the transportation requirements of the Ispettorato may be completed and so that all possible aid may be given to this agency to put it back in the proper functioning order.

1. Reference is made to your letter of 22 January 1944 concerning the issuance of an Administrative Instruction with respect to the Ispettorato del Lavoro. Although a General Order authorising the establishment of a Regional Labour Office in Region 4 has been issued, such an office has not as yet been established.

2. Foggia Province is the only territory at present under control of Region 4 and it is anticipated that this will be transferred to Region 5 at an early moment. In Foggia Province a Provincial Labour Office has been created and is now functioning.

3. Immediately upon the establishment of a Regional Labour Office the above mentioned Administrative Instruction will be issued for such territory as is at that time within the jurisdiction of Region 4.

SUBJECT: Ispettorato del Lavoro.

1. The powers, duties, functions, records and jurisdiction of the Ispettorato Corporativo, a State organization, heretofore subject to the direct jurisdiction of the Ministry of Corporations in Rome and presently located at 219 Via Duomo, Naples, are hereby transferred to the Regional Labor Office for Naples, Avellino, and Benevento Provinces, and shall operate as a division thereof.

2. The name of the Ispettorato Corporativo is hereby changed to Ispettorato del Lavoro.

3. The Director of the Regional Labor Office for Naples, Avellino and Benevento Provinces shall have complete jurisdiction over the Ispettorato del Lavoro, and shall be responsible for its administration and the fulfillment of its legal duties.

4. The said Director shall forthwith examine the statutory functions of the Ispettorato del Lavoro and suspend those functions which are of a political nature, or unrelated to the problems of welfare of workers. Suspension of any function or functions shall be subject to the final approval of the Regional Civil Affairs Officer, or officer designated by him for such purpose.

5. The personnel of the Regional Labor Office are State employees. Payment of their salaries will be arranged by the P.O.s of Region III AMG through the proper state channels.

REPORT ON LABOR INSPECTORSHIP1) OFFICE HOURS

After the conferment with the Director of the Inspectorship on office hours has been fixed from 8 to 12,30 and from 14 to 16,30.

Also the reinstatement of the "List of Presents" has been established.

2) REVISION OF FUNCTIONS

After the examination of the list of the Inspectorship functions which is also at the Labor Division, with regard to the Administrative Special Instruction No 1 by ACOOT, I have considered as follows:

- a) The examination regarding the legality of the collective labor contracts should be made by the Regional Labor Office because it is strictly connected with the keeping of the "Register of Collective Labor Contracts".
- b) The work concerning the information for the authorization to open and to enlarge some new industrial establishments, and to open and modify the mills and bakerhouses, must be stopped.
- c) Instead all the other functions must be maintained and helped because they are strictly connected with the work.

The proof-sheet of the administrative instruction, which the Regional Labor Office intends to issue with the approval of the Labor Division, is attached.

3) REVISION OF THE PERSONNEL

The Inspectorship has executed the order concerning the dismissal of Mr. Presini Edoardo.

In regard to the remaining personnel the Inspectorship has suggested to postpone the revision of the personnel, waiting for the renewal of the activity of the Inspectorship, considering the dispositions under the next paragraph.

At present there are in service: 2 administrative employees; 5 office workers; 2 common employees; and the janitor.

4) SUMMARY OF THE ACTIVITY

At present I have found a very reduced and in part formal activity of the Inspectorship. The reason is simple. The principal function of the Inspectorship was the verification of the violations of the labor laws. This verification was accomplished by some CC.RR. (about 10) who were dependent upon the Inspectorship and more on the

istrative Special Instruction No. 1 by ANOT, I have considered as follows:

- a) The examination regarding the legality of the collective labor contracts should be made by the Regional Labor Office because it is strictly connected with the keeping of the "Register of Collective Labor Contracts".

4) CANCELLATION OF THE ACTIVITY

At present I have found a very reduced and in part formal activity of the Inspectorship. The reason is simple. The principal function of the Inspectorship was the verification of the violations of the labor laws. This verification was accomplished by some CC.NR. (about 10) who were dependent upon the Inspectorship and were paid by it.

I have ordered to find the above Carabinieri who are all ready expert in the field of labor-legislation and to use them again, previous agreement with the command of CC.NR. Legion.

But I suppose the new judgment, which must animate the work of the Inspectorship under the dependency of the Regional Labor Office requires not only the work of the Carabinieri, but also that of other civilian employees who have a larger contact with the workers problems.

Therefore, I propose the engagement of 4 Additional Labor Inspectors who can take on part of the Carabinieri's work and collaborate with them for the remaining part. The expenses would be

equal or a little higher than using four Carabinieri, but it should have a better result because the Inspectors have a better cultural knowledge. Some lessons on the labor legislation could be given them in 15 or 20 days, and after, for an indefinite period, they would work together with the Carabinieri who have already a good experience.

The engagement shall be made after a brief examination.

5) PREMISES

I have approached a trustee of a building and have requested from him the prompt necessary repairs, giving him assurance about our help to surmount the present difficulties in finding the material.

6) OFFICE IN CATANIA

The transfer of the Labor Inspectorship under the dependency of the Regional Labor Office creates the problem either to transfer the Inspectorship of Catania under the dependency of the Inspectorship of Palermo as its peripheral office; or to leave it as an autonomous office directly depending upon the Regional Labor Office. But it is better, because of the present circumstances, to maintain the actual arrangements without change.

Therefore, it is advisable to maintain in charge the present Director, giving temporarily the Office of Palermo to the Inspector Mauro Italo whose moral position should bear an investigation.

Renewal of the activity

At present I have found a very reduced, and in part formal activity of the Inspectorship. The reason is simple. The principal function of the Inspectorship was the supervision of the violations of the labor laws. This supervision was accomplished by some 20 R.R. (about 10) who were dependent upon the Inspectorship and were paid by it.

I have ordered to find the above Carabini, who are all ready expert in the field of labor legislation and to use them again, previous agreement with the Government of E. R. R. Region.

But I suppose the new judgment, which must minimize the work of the Inspectorship under the dependency of the Regional Labor Office, requires not only the work of the Carabini, but also that of other civilian employees, who have a larger contact with the workers' problems.

Therefore I propose the engagement of 4 additional labor inspectors who can take on part of the Carabini's work and collaborate with them for the remaining part. The expense would be equal or a little higher than using four Carabini, but it should have a better result because the Inspectors have a better cultural knowledge. Some lessons on the labor legislation could be given them in 15 or 20 days, and after for an indefinite period, they would work together with the Carabini who have already a good experience.

The engagement shall be made after a brief examination.

1) Office hours

After the conferment with the Director of the Inspectorship, our office hours has been fixed from 8 to 12, 20 and from 14 to 16, 20. Also the constitution of the "List of presents" has been established.
