1. Under the authority of AFHQ Aim Memorandum No. 78 dated 12 Nov. '43 the Allied Force Local Resources (Italian) Board has approved the setting up in No. 2 District of Labor Sub-Committees. The functions of these Sub-Committees will be similar to those of the Control of Rages Sub-Committee set up by the Board.
2. There will be one Sub-Committee called No. 2 District Labor Sub-Committee, with subordinate Area or Sub-Area Sub-Committees. Except as stated in para 5 below, Sub-Committees are advisory bodies and action or recommendations will be through normal command channels.
3. The composition of the Sub-Committees will be as follows:-

District Labor Sub-Committee

Chairman, - Col i/c Adm
 Members - DDL
 Col Q (M)
 SSTO Adriatic Ports
 Rep RN
 Rep RAF (214 Op RAF)
 Rep US Forces (XV AFSC)

4. The terms of reference of the Sub-Committee will be as follows:-
 - (a) To make recommendations regarding the local rates of pay and conditions of employment of civilians employed by the Allied Armed Forces in accordance with the policy of the Allied Local Resources (Italian).

(b) To make recommendations regarding the issue of food and clothing to civilian labor in special cases, and the rate of payment to be exacted in each case.

5. With regard to conditions of employment, an important function of the Labor Sub-Committees will be to provide a representative body at District and Area or Sub-Area level, ~~may~~ to receive and decide on such complaints and disputes as may be referred to them for decision.
