1. Reference is made to your letter of 26 November 1944 (Lig/Fin/1503/8/2).

2. A copy of "The Gulde" is provided herewith for your information. This Guide is intended for Regional Labor Officers, and will be kept up to date by the addition of procedures and policy statements issued from time to time by the Labor Sub-Commission.
