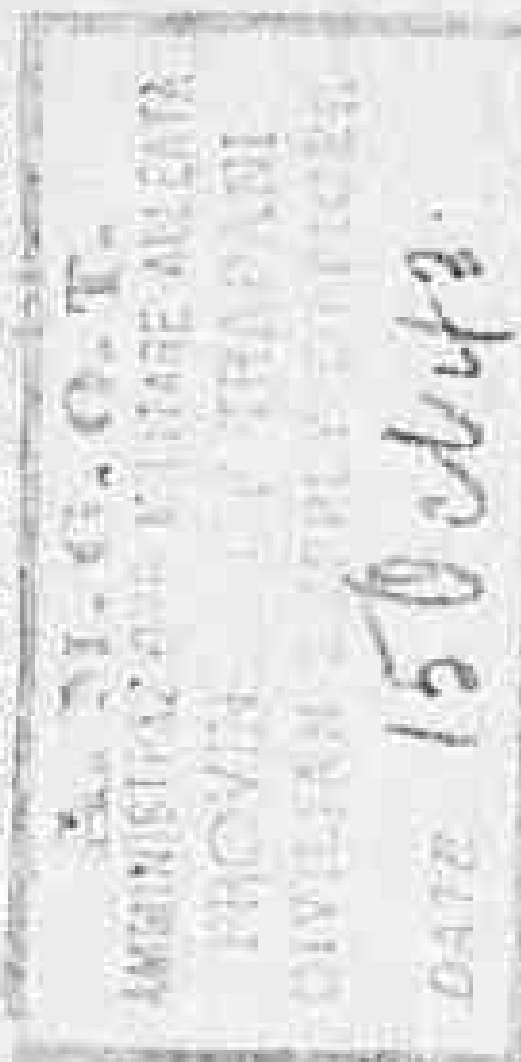

7. General activities in the Labor Office: The Labor Office reports that during the past month, they have sorted out and attempted to set in order again a great number of documents of the dissolved Fascist organizations, which are necessary to the Previdenza Sociale for the payment of pensions to agricultural laborers. The most difficult job has been to convince labor delegations from the various Communes that no increase in wages is possible at this time and to urge them not to have recourse to illegal and violent means or to destroy the very property that provides them a living.
