1. The above-mentioned man has been with this Sub-Commission since September, 1943, and came from GRTD, Phillipville.
2. There is a vacancy on this establishment (WS.NA/266/1) for a D/man R. Signals, and application was accordingly made to G-2 2nd Echelon for Sigm. Mason to be posted here. A reply was received to the effect that in view of his age (25) and medical category (A.1) authority could not be granted, and a low medical category replacement would be posted at the earliest opportunity.
3. I recommended Mason for promotion to L/Opl. as he is a very good draughtsman, besides doing clerical work and supervising the office in the absence of the Chief Clerk.
4. It should be appreciated that the majority of clerks are Italian civilians (6) and therefore the few Allied personnel (2 British and one American) form the backbone of the office organisation.
5. The recommendation to L/Opl. was approved by G-1 (British), the establishments branch of this Commission, but the promotion could not be effected owing to authority for posting not being received.
6. As five months have now passed and a replacement has failed to appear, I should be very grateful if you could do anything to have Mason posted here, which would fully justify the excellent work he is doing and subsequent promotion to L/Opl.
