

2. You will remember that she and the boy had to leave their house in a hurry and when they came back to Rome did not have the chance to collect anything but the barest necessities.

3. There is no danger of the person becoming a burden for housing or food as the house is well outside of Florence and is self sustaining as far as food is concerned.

4. Have you been able to do anything with reference to a permit for Dr. Fano's caretaker Carlo Eller. You wrote a note about the request some time ago at which time you thought something could be done in a few weeks.



The above spare parts are required also for the telephone Service of Sardinia, according to many links requested by the Allied Command. 43

Such spare parts, together with other spares at our storehouse in Rome, were decentralised in many places of Toscana (Leghorn, Florence and Lucca) in order to avoid destruction or requisition by Germans in retreat.

Therefore Sig. Becocci has to proceed to the above places to recover it stores, necessary to maintain the efficiency of the exchanges.

Sig. Becocci has to return to Sardinia as soon as possible, before the situation become worse, (that is before 16th October, when the Cagliari A.C.C. Pass will cease).

Therefore we beg you to kindly and urgently grant us the required pass, according to the importance of the matter.

- 2) - It has been noted that for the present it is impossible to obtain passes for every kind of trip; but we have made our request, owing to the fact that the STET President and engineers (Prof. Bordoni, Angelini, etc.) have been supplied, possibly by the Allied Army Command, with a pass like that, in force up to the end of September.
- 3) - Therefore we give up the request of pass for Ing. Osti e Gigli. But we inform you that sig. Gigli will be perhaps obliged to carry out an inspection trip, during the 3rd or 4th week of September, in liberated Provinces north of Rome.
- 4) - Ing. Cimigalli and Rag. Pancaldi, of the STET, as soon as they obtain the pass, will be obliged to go in TIMO areas, and to obtain permission for entering into liberated Marche, and to go forward to the Gothic line, as soon as possible.
- 5) - It has been noted that Ing. Travaglia, of the STET, was not allowed to go in Ancona. However we point out the urgency of the matter; and we beg you to grant, as soon as possible, the required authorisation; because the work of reactivation of the local exchange depends on his arrival in Ancona.

We confirm that Dott. Salvatore de Havo, President of the Collegio Sindacale della TETI, needs a travel pass for Arezzo and Florence areas, where he wants to go during the last 15 days of September.
