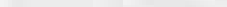

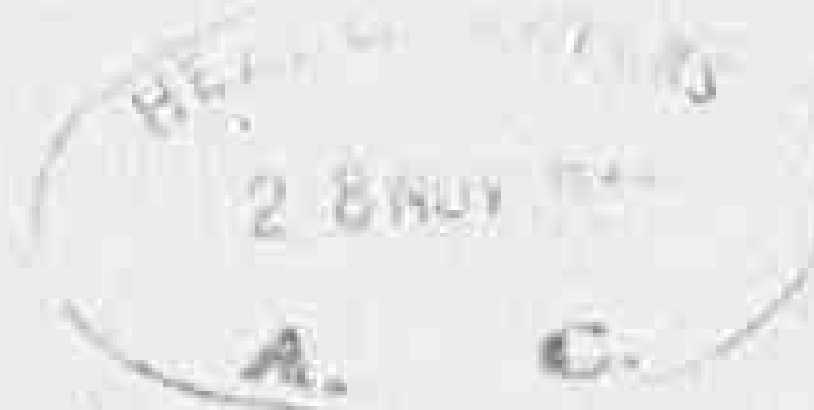

Such spare parts, together with other spares at our storehouse in Rome, were decentralised in many places of Toscana (Leghorn, Florence and Lucca) in order to avoid destruction or requisition by Germans in retreat.

Therefore Sig. Becocci has to proceed to the above places to recover it stores, necessary to maintain the efficiency of the exchanges.

Sig. Becocci has to return to Sardinia as soon as possible, before the situation become worse, (that is before 16th October, when the Cagliari A.C.C. Pass will cesse).

Therefore we beg you to kindly and urgently grant us the required pass, according to the importance of the matter.

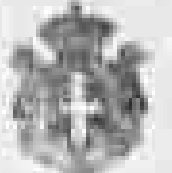

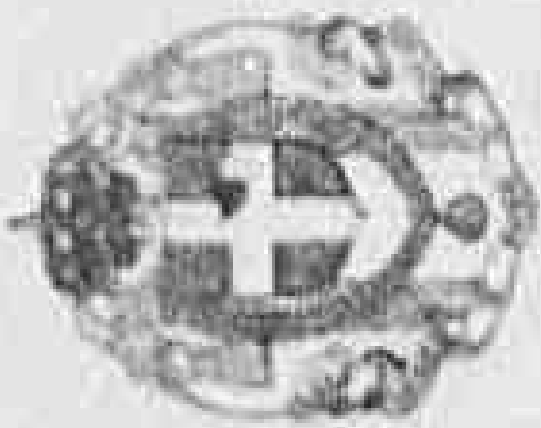
