The following statement of present redeployment policy (MTOUSA Cable C14309, dated 16 January 1946) is published for the information of all officers and enlisted men and will be given such publicity as necessary to bring it to the attention of all.

"1. Effective immediately the following will govern the demobilization of the Army until 30 June 46. It is desired that the entire system be explained in the greatest detail to every soldier:

- A. By 30 April 46 the following will be separated from the Army or aboard ship returning home: (1) all enlisted men (except volunteers) with 45 points as of 2 September 45 or with 30 months service as of 30 April 46. (2) all enlisted women's Army Corps Personnel (except volunteers) with 24 months service as of 30 April 46 (3) all male Officers (except Regular Army, volunteers, Medical Department Officers) with 67 points as of 2 September 45 or 45 months service as of 30 April 46. (4) all women Army Corps Officer (except volunteers) with 36 months length of service as of 30 April 46.
- B. By June 30, 1946, 3 following will be separated from the Army or aboard ship returning home: (1) all enlisted men (except volunteers) with 40 points as of 2 September 45 or with 24 months service as of June 30, 46. (2) all male Officers, (except Regular Army, volunteers and Medical Department Officers) with 65 points as of 2 September 45 or with 42 months service as of 30 June 46. (3) separate instructions covering the discharge of women Army Corps personnel, Officer and enlisted, for the period after 30 April will be issued by the War Department.
- C. Medical Corps Officers will be demobilized by separate criteria established by War Department.
- D. As soon as the tabulation of the desires of Officers according to category as prescribed in War Department circular 366, 1945, has been made, further instructions on their separation will follow.
- E. It is emphasized that release of all personnel will follow the principle of priority of release for those with highest points and longest length of service.

2. Computation of length of service will include total active commissioned and enlisted honorable service, continuous or interrupted, since 16 September 1940. Time lost under article of War number 107 will not be included.

3. Eligibility for separation of personnel made eligible by previously published Criteria is not affected by this message. Such personnel will be given priority for separation over personnel demobilized in accordance with paragraph 1 above.

4. The term volunteers as used herein includes enlisted personnel who have volunteered under provisions of change 2 of readjustment regulations 1-1 or who have enlisted in the Regular Army. Officer volunteers are those who sign certificates under War Department circular 366, 1945, as category 1, 2 or 3, or category 4 until date specified in the certificate.

5. Scarce category personnel whose military occupational speciality appear in circular 321, War Department, 1945, and in circular 382, War Department, 1945, may be retained in the service until replaced provided they are utilized in their speciality; but in no case longer than 6 months beyond date upon which he would be discharged under these instructions.

6. The above constitutes with War Department program of demobilization for the period until 30 June 46. Commanders are responsible for the immediate release of every individual for whom there is no military need, and for releasing Officers and men in sufficient time to carry out these instructions. However, no individual will be discharged under this directive with less service or smaller scores than set IV herein."

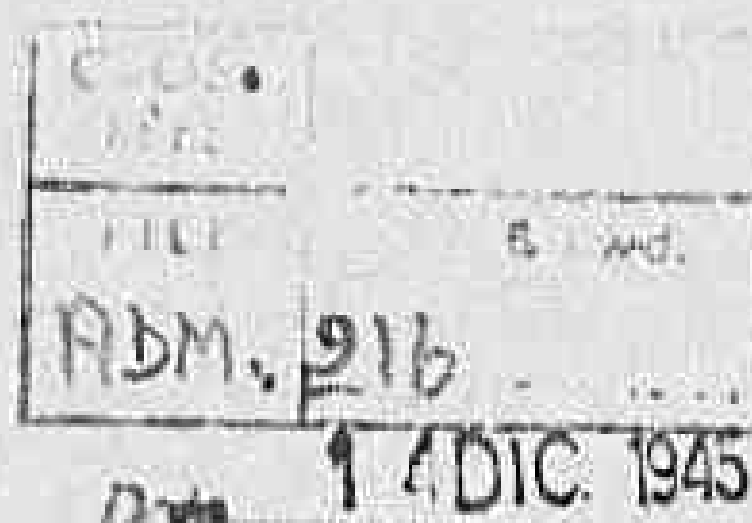

1. Regulations for Release from the Army, 1945 paragraph 326 is being amended to permit voluntary deferment of release by Officers, Warrant Officers, Staff Serjeants and Serjeants of all arms for a period of six months calculated from the first day the Age/Service Group is due to be released.
2. The conditions of deferment for six months are identical with those now operative under GRO 541/45 but eligibility is at present restricted to personnel in Groups up to 35 inclusive.
3. Officers and NCOs volunteering to continue to serve will make their applications on Appendices "B" and "C" respectively to GRO 541/45.
4. The above does not apply to members of the ATS and VAD.
5. War Office are considering extending this scheme to certain specialists and tradesmen below the rank of Serjeant but details are not yet available.

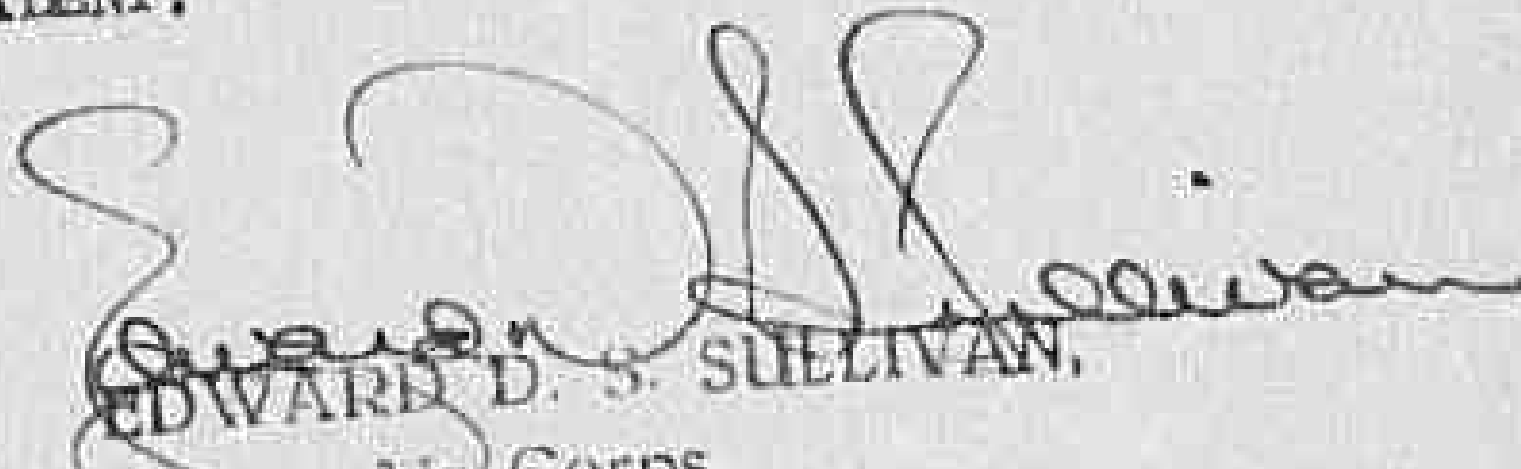

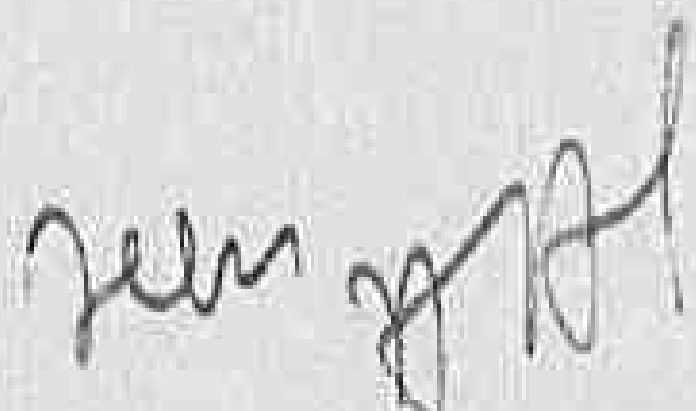

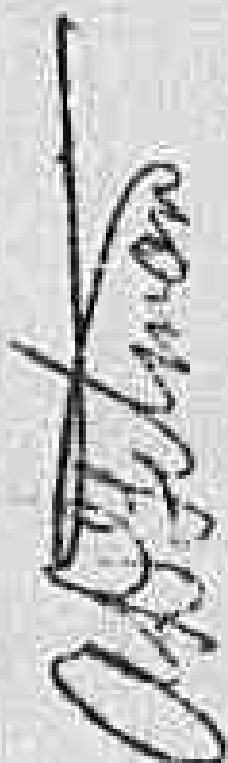

3. Applications may be submitted without regard to quota. In the event the number of applications exceed the quota allocated to this headquarters for any particular period the most deserving cases, determined from information submitted by applicants, will be approved first.

4. Applications will be submitted on the form appended to this letter as Appendix #1. It is necessary that each statement in the letter of application be completed.

5. The application will be forwarded to the person under whom the applicant actually performs duty for accomplishment of the 1st Indorsement, who will in turn forward it so as to reach this headquarters not later than the 15th of the month preceding the requested effective date.

SUBJECT : Compulsory retention of British Officers
in this Theatre.
TO : Distribution below

1. Reference is made to paragraphs 6 and 7 of this HQ letter G-1B/144/A dated 18 Oct 45 on the above subject.

2. The latest position with regard to officers in release group 21 is that they may be released at any time between 12 Nov 45 and 10 Feb 46. They will in any event be released on 10 Feb 46, but may be considered for release before that date, as and when they become surplus to THEATRE requirements. It is emphasised that the mere declaration that any individual officer is surplus to the requirements of this Commission will not result in that officer's release. He must be declared by GHQ to be surplus to the requirements of the theatre before his release can be entertained. It is, however, known to be the policy of GHQ to release as many officers as possible in Group 21, when once present commitments have been met.

3. The release of officers in Group 22 will not begin before 11 Feb 46, but officers in Groups 22 - 24 may apply for reversion to Home Establishment or release on compassionate grounds. In considering such applications, full weight will be given to the fact that an officer may have arranged to take up a civil appointment or have entered into domestic commitments in expectation of release under the earlier programme.

Applications on Civil appointment grounds must be accompanied by a signed statement from the proposed employer that a bona fide arrangement has in fact been made between himself and the applicant. Application on the above grounds will be submitted to G-1(B) this HQ.

4. No general ban is being imposed on Class 'B' release; refusals will be limited to cases where individual officers' retention is considered vital by GHQ.

TO : Distribution below.

1. The object of this letter is to give you the fullest information which is at present available regarding the compulsory retention in this theatre of British officers from Group 24 inclusive.

2. It is calculated that at the present time the shortage of officers in GAF is of the order of 3,500. As a result of this GAF has ordered that all male officers, excluding medical officers (on whom orders will be issued later), and including Age Service Group 24, will be deferred as orderably vital. The period of deferment is provisionally set at 4 months.

3. In addition, on the basis of a War Office ruling, it has been decided by GAF that officers in Group 24-24 will not be granted LMP, since they will be within some form of release, assuming that the law is limited only in such as possibly occur.

4. It is emphasized, however, that the rulings given above have only been made pending the receipt from the War Office of a final decision which will deal with the question of the deferment of officers on a world-wide basis. It is not known what the terms of this War Office order are likely to be, nor what conditions may be attached to it, but the order is expected to reach this theatre about a fortnight from now.

5. It is recognized by G.A.F. that there are likely to be a number of individuals in Groups 24-24 who, in expectation of early release, have made private arrangements in connection with their return to civil life, the cancellation of which would involve them in considerable hardship. A special allowance of 14 days leave has therefore been authorized by GAF to meet such cases of hardship. This applies only to officers in Groups 24-24, and may be granted to an officer who is experiencing genuine hardship, even if the officer has had LMP already. Permission to grant this special leave has been delegated to S.E.A. 13 Corps, and approved by District HQs. Local orders should therefore be scrutinized for any special instructions on this matter, and application for this leave should be made through normal Army channels, with a copy to G-1(P) at this HQ.

6. An assurance is given that this HQ will keep continuously in the closest touch with the situation, and that you will be informed of any further developments or changes at the earliest possible moment.

2. It is calculated that at the present time this GQG CTR has ordered in CTR is of the order of 2,500. As a result of this GQG CTR has ordered that all male officers, excluding medical officers (on whom orders will be issued later), and including Age Service Group 21, will be deferred as operationally vital. The period of deferment is provisionally set at 6 months.

3. In addition, on the basis of a War Office ruling, it has been decided by GQG that officers in Groups 24-26 will not be granted leave, since they will be within some four months of release, assuming that the war is limited early in March or possibly sooner.

4. It is understood, however, that the rulings given above have only been made pending the receipt from the War Office of a final decision which will deal with the question of the deferment of officers on a War Office basis. It is not known what the terms of this War Office order are likely to be, nor what conditions may be attached to it, but the order is expected to reach this theatre about a fortnight from now.

5. It is recognised by G.H.Q. that there are likely to be a number of individuals in Groups 24-26 who, in expectation of early release, have made private arrangements in connection with their return to civil life, the cancellation of which would involve them in considerable hardship. A special allotment of 14 days leave has therefore been authorised by G.H.Q. to meet such cases of hardship. This applies only to officers in Groups 24-26, and may be granted to an officer who is experiencing genuine hardship, even in the case of those who have had leave already. Permission to grant this special leave has been delegated to S.D.A. 13 Corps, and appropriate District HQs. Local orders should therefore be scrutinised for any special instructions on this matter, and application for this leave should be made through normal Army channels, with a copy to G-4(b) at this HQ.

6. An assurance is given that this G.H.Q. will keep continuously in the closest touch with the situation, and that you will be informed of any further developments or changes at the earliest possible moment.

7. This instruction is applicable to British officers serving with Allied Commission, Italy, but it does not in any way alter the fact that on the handbook of territory to the Italian Govt. a number of British Officers will be declared surplus to A.C. requirements. At this stage it is not possible to give you any information as to their disposal, but you will be informed as soon as possible of any orders which are received from G.H.Q.
