SUBJECT: The Ufficio Superiore Telecomunicazioni

TO : GHQ CMF
Att: Chief Signal Officer

1. The work of the Ufficio Superiore Telecomunicazioni is not effective in producing and maintaining communication facilities necessary to provide communication when needed. Delay is experienced in effecting circuit changes, repair and adjustments. This delay is caused primarily, it is believed, in uncertainty as to authority for orders and duplication of effort by UST and other offices of the Azienda di Stato. Meanwhile there are several good engineers in the UST whose time is not utilized efficiently because of being separated from the main headquarters of Azienda di Stato.

2. It would be in line with your present policy of turning operation over to the Italians, to return also UST functions to the Azienda di Stato.

- a. The engineers could be more efficiently employed.
- b. Full responsibility for maintenance as well as operation of Azienda and Concessionary Company circuits would be placed fully in the hands of the head of Azienda di Stato.

- (1) The head of Azienda di Stato is capable of assuming this responsibility, and has shown a willingness to handle promptly communication problems given to him.

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3. It is recommended that the UST be abolished and the functions of that office placed under the Director of the Azienda di Stato per i Servizi Telefonici.

- a. As it would be necessary for the Long Lines Liaison Office to maintain circuit records; the Azienda di Stato should be required to keep two men in the Long Lines Liaison Office to maintain these circuit records.
- b. Orders effecting circuits would flow from the Long Lines Liaison Office to Azienda di Stato where full responsibility would be imposed for prompt actions.

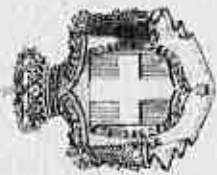
