(3) Of this amount approximately 25,537 thousand million lira is the estimated cost of replacing buildings and equipment damaged by war, at 1946 prices. The remainder is the estimated cost for additions and improvements.

(4) The information in the 2nd and 3rd paragraphs above are from the Piano Quinquennale di Ricostruzione of the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications. The Minister requests that this plan be cited if the figures are used in your publication.

- b. POSTAL SERVICES:
- (1) Page 22 Economic Survey Supplement 23 Aug. 46 Postal.
 - (2) Para 102 (A) Suggest "Postal Service" not "Mail Service."
 - (3) Para 104 (A) Main Heading suggest "Postal Service"
 - (4) Para 106 An appropriate of 750 million lire was programmed in the budgets 1946-50 for the modernisation of equipment and the sum of 495 million lire for recovery of war damage. (Authority: Piano Quinquennale di Ricostruzione 1946)
 - (5) Para 104 First sentence hardly correct. Italys' Postal service was always regarded as reasonably fast between various centres but slow in delivery in City areas.

- (6) Italys' postal traffic is always comparatively low. With 11,500 Post Office handling 2,856 million letters annually, the service is slight compared to Great Britains which in 1941 with much the same population but only two thirds of the area had as many as 24,800 offices handling 6,250 million letters.
- (7) The returns for nine months of 1946 show that 6,996,444 gift parcels have been received in Italy from the United States of America.
- (8) Statistics for letter services for the current year are not available at the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications and no comparison can therefore be made at present.

1. Codes and ciphers of the Italian Government are not held by the Allied Commission. At the time that a cryptographic section was assigned to the Allied Commission, an Italian subsection, under an Italian Army Officer handed Italian codes and ciphers. These codes and ciphers were withdrawn along with British and American codes and cyphers when cryptographic work of the Allied Commission was taken over by the Signal Office of the Rome Area Allied Command.
2. I have not found a directive, or indication of a directive, requiring the Communications Sub-Commission to obtain copies of Italian Codes and Ciphers.

SUBJECT: Brazilian Telegrams to Frankfurt.

1. The Brazilian Embassy in Rome receives telegrams from Frankfurt, Germany, but is unable to reply by telegram because commercial facilities are not available and there is no authority for sending such telegrams over Allied Military Circuits.

2. It is recommended that the Rome Area Allied Command Signal Center be authorized to transmit official Brazilian Embassy telegrams to Frankfurt.

- a. The number would be small and it would aid expeditions communication between Brazilian representatives.
- b. An examination of traffic on that circuit indicates that additional traffic imposed by such authority would not interfere with military traffic.


