Your request for the provision of a wireless link between ITALY and SARDINIA was recently reconsidered by AFHQ. In view of the fact, however, that communication will shortly be possible by submarine cable between NAPLES and CAGLIARI, the request for a wireless link was rejected.

It is anticipated that the cable will shortly be in operation, and you will be informed in due course regarding the arrangements for passing traffic.

1. NAPLES - SALERNO - BARI Circuits.

I have renewed our demand for a further three circuits, in writing and also by a visit to C.S.O., L. of C., Italy, and a telephone call to A.C.M.F. The situation is that the cable is full and A.C.M.F. is not prepared to release any existing circuits. Carrier equipment is now being installed to provide additional circuits, and our further three will be provided from them. It is expected this will take about three weeks.

2. Radio Circuits.

I attended the conference in Algiers which decided against any use by the Italian Government of radio without A.F.H.Q. express authority. I do not think that permission will be given unless a strong case is presented, chiefly on grounds of security, and especially as we cannot undertake to monitor.

3. Do you wish any action to be taken on either point? I feel that it will have to be made through command and not technical channels if any result is to be expected. Shall I prepare drafts on either subject?

Subject: Bari-Salerno Circuits.

To: The Under-Secretary of State for Telecommunications and Posts.

1. The CSC 15 Army Group authorized the following scheme for the communications of ACC and the Italian Government in Salerno.

- (a) Before the arrival of ACC and the Government in Salerno, the three Bari lines would be terminated on the Naples ACC switchboard.
- (b) after the above arrival, the three lines from Bari would be terminated on the Government switchboard, and the three lines from Naples on the ACC switchboard.

2. The above arrangements did not allow for the present arrangement whereby part of the Italian Government has been transferred to Salerno in advance. Alterations had to be made and the circuits at the moment are connected as follows.

Two lines from ACC switchboard to Bari civil exchange. One line from ACC switchboard Naples, to Bari military exchange.

It is true that temporarily the Government operators will have to dial the ACC switchboard to obtain Bari lines, but, on the other hand, in the ultimate arrangement the reverse will take place i.e. ACC operators must dial the Government switchboard to obtain Bari.

It was necessary under existing arrangements to ensure that the ACC personnel at Naples and Salerno, as well as the Government, have access to the Bari circuits, and the ACC switchboard seemed to be a suitable switching center. In view of the fact that the present plan will not exist for long, perhaps you will agree that it will serve until the arrival of the Government in Salerno.

It is not clear why the Government has been restricted to the use of one line only, and this matter has been taken up with Colonel Henderson.

nostra richiesta.

Veniamo oggi informati che il Col. Henderson comunicò al

Subject: Circuits for Allied Control Commission.

To: CSO, 15 Army Group.

1. According to the minutes of the Telecommunications Board, Italy, the CSO 15 Army Group controls the allocation of circuits in the main telephone cable.
2. As the CSO is aware, the ACC will move to Salerno shortly. Communication is now required by AMG and will be required shortly by ACC with the Regional Civil Affairs Officer, Region 2, who is stationed at Matera.
3. At present his only telephone circuit is from Matera to Potenza.
4. From a study of CSO L of C Instruction No. 8, it would appear possible to provide ACC and AMG with a Salerno-Potenza circuit without affecting Allied Force requirements. Information is not held here regarding size of conductor of the cable, amplification required, etc., but if a Salerno-Potenza L of C circuit has adequate transmission, perhaps the CSO could arrange such a circuit for ACC.
5. The provision of such a circuit would enable the HQAO, Region 2, to have telephone communication with Salerno.







CABLE CONSTRUCTION DIAGRAM





SUBJECT: Wire Circuits NAPLES - BARI

TO : Headquarters, 15th Army Group

1. By a letter of 12 November 1943 the Allied Control Commission requested that six circuits be reserved on the Bari - Naples main cable for the use of the Italian Government and of the Commission if the decision was reached to move the Government and the Commission to Salerno. A reply from Headquarters 15th Army Group indicated that only three circuits would be allotted initially. However, it was understood through a conversation between the Chief of Staff of the Commission and Brigadier General Lemitzer that three additional circuits would be made progressively available so that the necessary six circuits would be obtained in time to meet our requirements in Salerno.

2. The decision has now been made to move the Italian Government and the Commission to Salerno. For planning purposes, the date of completion of the move is assumed to be January 1, 1944.

3. It has recently been learned from the Chief Signal Officer, 15th Army Group, and confirmed by the Chief Signal Officer, Lines of Communication, Italy, that only three circuits will be available by January 1st. This will impose such a restriction upon the communications of the Government and the Commission as to make impossible the efficient administration of the territories to be handed over to the Italian control. Also, the supervisory responsibilities of this Commission cannot be exercised adequately under this restricted allocation.

Subject: Move of the Italian Government and ACC to the Salerno Area.

To: G. S. O., L. of C., Italy.

1. The move of the Italian Government and the ACC to the Salerno Area has received definite approval, and the occupation of the Papal Seminary, Salerno, by the chief officers of the Italian Government is expected to take place. The date of the move is not settled, but will be as soon as possible after arrangements can be completed, probably not later than 1 January 1944.

2. Telephone communications in the Salerno Area will be required as shown in Appendix A. The chief differences between these arrangements and the tentative proposals discussed with you are that it is desired to have a PBX for the ACC offices, and that it is considered essential that the civil interurban exchange should be restored to operation, as in towns in the present King's Italy. It will be observed that 6 circuits NAPLES - SALERNO - BARI are shown; it is not considered that the Italian Government and this Commission will be able to function with less. This matter is being taken up with 15 Army Group.

3. Certain branches of the ACC (mainly, the Economics Directorate) will be located in the Provincia Building, Naples. In confirmation of the proposals discussed with you, the arrangements shown in Appendix B are considered suitable.

4. A teletype (or teleprinter) circuit from the ACC offices at Salerno to your main Naples office is also considered necessary, to carry traffic for Adv AFHQ, 15 Army Group, ACC offices in Naples, and for Palermo, Malta, etc., via the Naples - Palermo cables. The arrangement shown in Appendix C is considered suitable.

5. I should be glad of your comments on the above paragraphs and also for estimated dates by which it is expected that facilities can be made available. I should also be grateful for estimated dates on the completion of Naples - Salerno and Salerno - Bari circuits and of the Naples - Palermo - Malta cables.

6. The detailed requirements of the Italian Government can be obtained from Count Pellegrini, SET director Naples, with whom Dr. Fano Under-Secretary of State for Telecommunications and Posts will establish contact. The detailed requirements in Naples can be obtained from Lt. Col. Joe Richards, Hq AMG, Naples Provincia Building, and for the ACC in Salerno from Lt. Col. Moss Vernon, Hq Camp Commandant, Palace of Justice, Salerno and officers proceeding from here.






ITALIAN GOVT & A.C.C. TELEPHONE REQUIREMENTS IN SALERNO.


A.C.C. TELEPHONE REQUIREMENTS

A.C.C. TELETYPE


A.C.C. TELEPHONE REQUIREMENTS IN NAPLES.







SUBJECT: Wire Circuits NAPLES - BARI.

TO : General Officer Commanding, 15th Army Group.

1. In our letter of 12th November 1943 we requested that six (6) circuits be reserved on the BARI - NAPLES main cable for the use of the Italian Government and of this Commission should it be decided that the Government and the Commission move to the Naples area. This request was confirmed in a discussion between Brigadier General Maxwell D. Taylor of this Commission and Brigadier General L. D. Lemitser of 15 Army Group Headquarters.

2. The move has now been authorized and will be taking place as soon as arrangements can be made; the probable date of completion of installation being about 1st January 1944.

3. Since the above it has been learned from GSO, 15 Army Group, and confirmed by GSO, L. of C., Italy, that only three (3) circuits on this route can be made available by the time that the transfer of Government will be effected.

4. It is not considered possible that efficient control of the territories to be handed over to the Government can be exercised by them with this restricted allocation of communication facilities. We, therefore, have to ask that our original request and your agreement therewith should be complied with if it can possibly be done without seriously hampering military operations; I should be grateful for your reply as early as possible as the policy to be pursued may be affected by your decision.

SUBJECT: Operation of Italian Radio Circuits.

TO : All Concerned.

1. The present operational status of Italian radio stations and equipment requires that certain definite steps be taken to bring their activities more closely under Allied surveillance and control. To accomplish this end, the following policy is set forth and will become effective immediately:

a. The operation of all radio stations, both military and civil, by the Italians will be prohibited, except as follows:

- (1) Naval stations authorized and supervised by Commander-in-Chief Mediterranean.
- (2) Stations essential to the operations of Italian aircraft, authorized and supervised by Air Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean.
- (3) Essential stations authorized and supervised by 15 Army Group.
- (4) Stations specifically authorized by this headquarters, including Italian broadcast stations which are controlled and supervised by Information and Censorship Section, this headquarters.

b. The plain text of all authorized Italian radio traffic will be turned over to the Allied authority charged with supervision of the individual circuit.

c. All Italian held radio transmitting equipment, except that specifically authorized under paragraph a, above, be immediately turned over to Allied representatives authorized by General Officer Commanding-in-Chief, 15 Army Group, Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean, Air Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean, Allied Control Commission and Allied Military Government. To effect this:

- (1) The Allied Control Commission will order the Italian Government to take necessary action in areas under its control.
- (2) Headquarters, Allied Military Government will take necessary steps to effect action in areas under its control.



1. General. - The strength and equipment for this Headquarters require certain increases to provide satisfactory service; in particular the capacity of the telephone switchboard is inadequate and early action on this is requested.

2. Telephone Arrangements. -

(a) The present switchboard has only a capacity of twelve lines (two 6-line U.S. boards, Type B07A). This inadequacy has been previously reported to you in my No. 162 of 23 September; the request for additional facilities was passed by you to 15 Army Group, who passed it to C.S.O. Fortbase; despite repeated requests nothing has been provided because of non-availability.

(b) It is now considered that a switchboard of the U.S. Type B109 is required, together with the necessary local cabling and telephones. An American type switchboard is recommended as the operating and maintenance staffs are U.S. Army personnel, but a British 40-line F and F type board would serve.

(c) There is no suitable Italian equipment available.

3. Switchboard Operators. -

(a) The addition of one switchboard operator would ease the personnel situation. At present there are three operators including the supervisor; one of these is sick and the lack of any personnel pool in this area makes it desirable to hold a spare man at this headquarters in case of any casualty.

(b) If possible it would be appreciated if T/5 John G. PERRY, 10600278, Co "A" 2625 Signal Service Regiment, A.P.O. 512, could be posted, as he is brother to Sgt Perry, serving at this headquarters.

4. Despatch Riders.

A provisional establishment of three motor-cyclist despatch riders is considered essential for the work of this headquarters. By arrangement with C.S.O. Fortbase three despatch riders of South African Signals are at present attached here, but their return is continually being requested, and the only satisfactory arrangement is for the personnel to be borne on our provisional establishment.

SUBJECT: Wire Circuits NAPLES - BARI  
TO : Headquarters, 15th Army Group

1. By a letter of 12 November 1943 the Allied Control Commission requested that six circuits be reserved on the Bari - Naples main cable for the use of the Italian Government and of the Commission if the decision was reached to move the Government and the Commission to Salerno. A reply from Headquarters 15th Army Group indicated that only three circuits would be allotted initially. However, it was understood through a conversation between the Chief of Staff of the Commission and Brigadier General Lemnitzer that three additional circuits would be made progressively available so that the necessary six circuits would be obtained in time to meet our requirements in Salerno.

2. The decision has now been made to move the Italian Government and the Commission to Salerno. For planning purposes, the date of completion of the move is assumed to be January 1, 1944.

3. It has recently been learned from the Chief Signal Officer, 15th Army Group, and confirmed by the Chief Signal Officer, Lines of Communication, Italy, that only three circuits will be available by January 1st. This will impose such a restriction upon the communications of the Government and the Commission as to make impossible the efficient administration of the territories to be handed over to the Italian control. Also, the supervisory responsibilities of this Commission cannot be exercised adequately under this restricted allocation.

4. In view of the serious effects on Commission and governmental activities, the Allied Control Commission requests reconsideration of the original request for the allocation of six circuits.

Reference your letter 2737/8/X dated 25 November, 1943.

1. At the BARI end the circuits will be required on the BARI inter-urban switchboard.

2. The site to be authorized for the Government in the NAPLES area has not been decided, but it appears likely that either SALERNO or SORRENTO will be allocated.

3. IF SALERNO, the circuits will be required on the SALERNO inter-urban switchboard.

4. IF SORRENTO, it is probable that an exchange will be installed for the Government on to which these circuits will be required. The matter of extension of the circuits from the nearest repeater station, SALERNO or NAPLES, will be raised if the SORRENTO site is allotted.
