SUBJECT: Transmittal of Messages to and from representatives in Algiers.

TO : North Africa District.

Headquarters, Allied Control Commission, APO 394.

1. When AFHQ was at Algiers the Greek and Yugoslav representatives there, having no signal communication of their own, were allowed to make use of AFHQ signal services to send their messages to the Greek and Yugoslav members on the Advisory Council for Italy, and similar facilities were afforded from Italy there- by the representatives there could communicate with their representatives in Al- giers. Consequent on the move of AFHQ it is necessary to substitute another system whereby the same facilities may be afforded to the Greek and Yugoslav representatives.

2. It is requested you will ensure that the following procedure is im- plemented:

a. The Greek and Yugoslav representatives in Algiers have been instruct- ed through Mr. Duff Cooper's office (acting as Agents in Algiers for the British Resident Minister here) that messages intended for their members on the Advisory Council for Italy should be handed to Mr. Duff Cooper's office. There they will be perused and will be passed on to you for transmission. Should you get any messages direct from the representatives in Algiers they should first be passed to Mr. Duff Cooper's office for perusal.

b. On receipt of a message from Mr. Duff Cooper's office it should be sent by cable to ACC Main repeated AFHQ, the text of the message (which may be in code) being prefaced by a short explanatory phrase such as the following: "Request the following message from -----be transmitted to the -----re- presentative on the Advisory Council for Italy."

c. In the reverse direction ACC are requested to send messages from the Greek and Yugoslav members on the Advisory Council for Italy and intended for the Greek and Yugoslav representatives in Algiers or elsewhere in cable form ad- dressed to North Africa District. On receipt of such messages North Africa Dis- trict will refer them to Mr. Duff Cooper's office for delivery to the addressee or onward transmission as necessary.

3. You may receive requests from representatives of other nations in Algiers for facilities for onward transmission of messages and these should be referred to Mr. Duff Cooper's office as they arrive.



Subject: Italian Government Communication between Italy and Spain.

To: H. E. Don Renato Frunaz, Permanent Secretary for Foreign Affairs.

Your Excellency is aware that the question of delay in the transmission of your Government's messages between Italy and Madrid has received the serious consideration of Allied Headquarters. Obviously some reduction in the time of transit is most desirable. It is all the more unfortunate therefore that the quickest method of transmission, by radio direct to Madrid, cannot at present be brought into use. The extreme shortage of radio frequencies in the Mediterranean area, and especially on the Italian mainland makes it essential that frequencies be assigned to stations concerned with the direct conduct of war operations.

The importance of the rapid interchange of your Government's diplomatic correspondence, especially under present conditions, is of course, appreciated, and accordingly, the following revised system of routing for such messages has been evolved. It is hoped that, as a result, a very considerable reduction in the transit time will result.

The messages will be enciphered by your Government, the cipher text and a copy of the plain text being passed to the Allied Control Commission (Adjutant General) for transmission via the Brindisi - Malta - Gibraltar submarine cable system. At Gibraltar the message will be handed in at the Spanish telegraph office (still in cipher) for transmission via Spanish landline to Madrid, and thence to the proper address.

Incoming messages to Italy will be filed, after ciphering, with the Spanish telegraph office in Madrid and will then be transmitted by the above routing in reverse, to your Government.

The date of introduction of the above procedure will depend on the state of readiness of the cipher officer, especially at Madrid. For this purpose, it will be necessary to send a copy of the cipher to Madrid by means of an officer courier, and arrangements will be made with Lt. Col. Ducros, of the Cipher Office Commando Supremo, as regards cipher to be used, suitable date for commencement of the service, etc..
