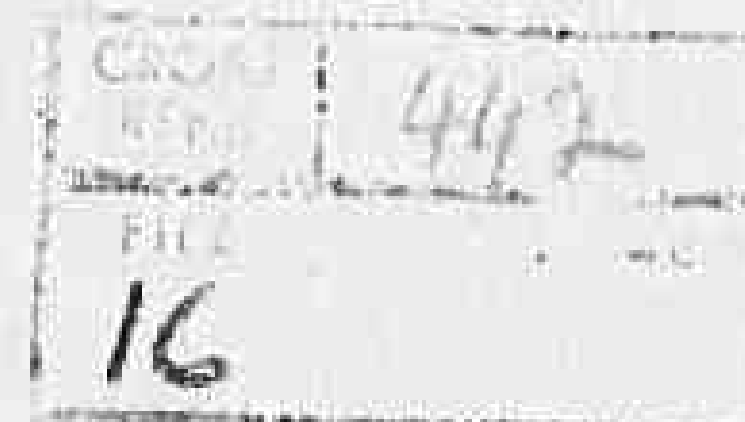
With reference to your 470685/477363 of 15th October.

1. I have read this report with interest and am not surprised to learn that the majority of your large offices are in favour of the selection of local correspondence at the facing-up stage prior to date stamping. From the local point of view this system has many attractions as it avoids local complaints and eliminates the most pressing need for urgency in the primary sorting stage after date stamping.

2. I am still of the opinion, however, that it is a bad system for the service ~~generally~~ as it leads to:-

- (1) Slow facing-up
- (2) Complicated arrangements for date-stamping
- (3) Slackness in organising and carrying out the primary sorting of outgoing correspondence
- (4) Failure to connect with outgoing despatches. From such observations as I have been able to make I think that total time taken in the treatment of towns collections from the moment the correspondence enters the average large office up to the time when it is completely sorted on the primary positions is deplorably lengthy and that this is mainly due to the above reasons.

3. The foregoing is only my personal opinion and it is, of course, possible that in these days of infrequent outward despatches normal considerations do not always apply. I would recommend, however, that before finally deciding on the evidence of local opinion - which is not always entirely reliable in these cases - you should ask your Central Inspectors to make for your information unobtrusive observation at one or two large offices of the total time taken to deal with these collections; (i.e. from the arrival in the office up to when the entire collection was completely sorted for despatch).

Of the 20 offices to whom we had put the question, 15 have confirmed that the system is useful in operation since a long time is useful, which is justified by the possibility to shorten the time which is necessary for the second stage of the sorting of the mails, that is to say the setting a part for their handing over for forwarding & to forward readily the above mails with the first available trip between the office at the station & the central one.

1. Reference your 407375/323626-C.R. dated 26th July, in which you stated you were unable to re-commence certain of the services mentioned in our P.16.378/CS dated 3rd July between North and South Italy owing to limited means of transport and shortage of mail bags, it is pointed out that as far as transport is concerned the rail facilities for transport of mails between Rome and North Italy have recently been greatly improved. As far as the shortage of mail bags is concerned this does not appear to us to be a valid objection to re-commencing the above mentioned services. Any increase in the bulk of the mail caused by such re-commencement would be slight as the majority of such services concern small items (e.g. visiting cards) and concern items of mail which would have a purely local circulation.

2. Furthermore all of the services which you state you are unable to re-commence from Rome to North Italy have been in operation from territory under A.M.G. control to the rest of Italy for several weeks and it is considered very desirable that mail services should be uniform in both directions. It is moreover very doubtful whether the notices to the public in Italian Government territory clearly indicate that the services concerned do not extend to the Northern Provinces and whether the public generally are aware of such limitation.

3. In view of the above remarks please consider whether it is possible to re-commence to the Northern Provinces all the services mentioned in our P.16.378/CS dated 3rd July.

 It is considered that telegrams emanating from these provinces should be subject to pre-censorship, and mail to partial censorship.
 It is particularly desired that this extension of services between UDINE Province and VENEZIA GIULIA, until the policy regarding the latter has been agreed and settled, respect of UDINE should NOT include the opening of such services between UDINE Province and VENEZIA GIULIA, until the policy regarding the latter has been agreed and settled.
2. It is considered somewhat premature from the security point of view to extend telephone services from intra-provincial to inter-provincial in respect of the above three Provinces, but if you regard it of particular importance that such extension should be approved, we should be prepared to consider the matter further.
3. As you suggest, the question of VENEZIA GIULIA is now under active consideration, and is a somewhat separate problem.

5. Money Orders and Conti Conconti. Please press Finance Sub-Commission for a ruling on whether a North-South service can be permitted. All Finance Officers are in doubt.

6. Bonds. The Northern Ministry introduced a new system under which bonds were printed for Provinces instead of for individual offices; the Provincial Directorates issued blocks of Bonds to their Offices. It will take a long time to get in lists of bonds on hand at all the Sub-Offices and the last serial numbers and in the meantime many offices are without bonds. two courses are open:-

(a) Let Novara print a further supply on the Northern system. They have the paper and we could arrange for the fascis to be deleted from the die.

(b) Let the Ministry proceed with printing new bonds for all northern offices (without waiting for details) by starting a fresh series for each office.

Turin favours (b), but (a) would make far easier distribution. Perhaps you will discuss with Finance and the Ministry.

Some Cardboard has been discovered and unblocked and I hope that by now printing is well in hand. Now that we are committed to these stamps, the more produced the better. I will visit Novara again. All the CLN consulted are bitterly opposed to Republican stamps and the Genoa people were even prepared to go without services until new stamps were prepared. I don't think that the general public is of the same opinion and I have authorised Drummond to tell his offices to turn a blind eye on the sale and use of these stamps until the new ones are fully available.

8. Emilia Region. I can't get into touch with Sleichner from here but will try to see him next week. It is an anomalous position to have services running across that Region and not to advertise all Emilia Provinces open. Can we push up stamp supplies for Emilia by air or courier from Rome to Bologna or should I try to supply from this end?

9. Venezia Region. I don't know whether Turner has cleared anything with 8 Army and will try to see him also next week.

To : Major Green at Milan.

Reference your report of 18 May 45, typed copy herewith.

1. It is assumed that you have received signal No. 7705 of 16 May (copy attached) and copies of P. 16.336 and P. 16.337 of the same date, the latter addressed to the Ministry of Posts and Telecomms.

2. Ministry of Posts and Telecomms in North.
It is agreed that the Ministry should not be revived. Rather should it be the aim to remove any obstacles in the way of bringing the north and the south together at the earliest possible moment.

3. New Services.
The two copies of Drummond's instructions have been filed for reference. It is appreciated that some time must elapse before all post offices can be reached.

The Ministry was told this morning by phone, before the receipt of your report, to send mails for the north to Leghorn and Forlì at once so that they should be available for onward conveyance by road. (Copy of the letter of confirmation is attached). It will be seen that a motor lorry for the run from Leghorn to Genoa may be available on 23 May, but the transport for the other routes may not reach Forlì before 1 June 45.

Alasia's road service to Bologna from Milan, and Drummond's service from Genoa to Livorno may start earlier, and pick up the mails from the south. It will remain to be seen whether the volume of mails will warrant the running of all the road services now being arranged.

Stelcher should not, it is thought, experience difficulty in providing for the conveyance of mails between Forlì and Bologna, if the transport he has found at Ferrara and Modena is in good enough condition, and enough petrol is obtainable.

There are prospects of train services between Rome and Bologna being started by the end of this month, but this has not yet been confirmed.

A 40 gramme letter service to the south may be started forthwith. The Finance Sub-Commission have no objection. As stated in signal 7705, there is now no ban on internal movement of currency. The Ministry will be told to raise the maximum weight for letters from the south, from 15 to 40 grammes, forthwith.

4. Prisoner of War Letters.
The British Army Postal Directorate, have been asked to give a

general agreement to PM mails, addressed to Naples, being handed to various APOs in the North.

5. Foreign Letters. The Economic Section agree to the southern foreign rates of postage being introduced throughout the north of Italy. A postcard and 40 gramme letter service to foreign countries may therefore be started as soon as the necessary stamps are available. Both letters and postcards to be of a purely personal or family nature.

The Civil Censorship Group is being informed that all foreign correspondence will be sent to Rome for censorship until censorship stations are established in the north.

The Ministry is being asked to send plenty of 2, 3, 4 and 5 lire postage stamps to Milan and these will be forwarded by air if possible.

Copy of a letter addressed to Economic Section, putting forward the case for the increase in foreign postage rates to the minimum allowed by the International Postal Union, is attached for information, and to enable you to deal with any possible complaints.

6. Money Orders and Conti Correnti.

The Finance Sub-Commission are considering the advisability of allowing a North-South Money Order and Conti-Correnti Service.

7. Bonds.

So that the sale of Bonds should be resumed at the earliest possible moment at all offices, Novara should print a further supply on the Northern system, after the fascias have been removed from the die, and these should remain on sale until the Ministry can send supplies from the south.

The Ministry will be advised to print new bonds for all northern offices (without waiting for details) by starting a fresh series for each office. Finance Sub-Commission concur.

8. Emilia Region

Eleicher is opening up the services in the Emilia Region - he is keeping in touch with this office. He has not reported any difficulty in the continued use of Republican stamps. He will be instructed to bring the services in Emilia into line with those in the rest of the north of Italy, and supplies of postage stamps for the external services will be sent to Bologna from Rome. The Ministry have already been told to send stocks to Ravenna, where records and stocks have been burnt.

9. Venezia Region.

No news from Turner yet, nothing is known of postal services in the Venezia Region.

10. Inland Postage Rates.

It would be well, if you do not see any serious objection, to increase the inland postage rates at the same time as the foreign rates, to the level of those in the south. The Economic Section's view is that the price control regulations do not cover postage rates.

Your letter regarding postal, telegraph and telephone rates did not go through, and the Decrees do not therefore, apply to these rates.

With reference to my letters Nos. P.16.336/CS and P. 16.337/CS dated 16th May, 1945.

1. I wish to make it quite clear that the stipulation, that the envelopes of letters exchanged between the north and south of Italy must be left open, has been cancelled. Closed letters, not exceeding 15 grammes in weight, and postcards may be accepted for all places in North Italy (including Vicenza and Treviso) except Bolzano, Trento, Udine, Gorizia, Trieste, Fola and Fiume.

2. A motor lorry for the run from Leghorn to Genoa may be available at Leghorn on 23 May 45, but the transport for the other services (Forli'-Milan and Forli'-Venice) may not reach Forli' before 1 June 45.

3. Mails for Pisa, Massa, La Spezia, Genova, Alessandria, Asti and Turin should be forwarded to Leghorn, and those for Ravenna, Ferrara, Rovigo, Padova, Venice, Bologna, Modena, Reggio, Parma, Piacenza and Milan, to Forli' by rail at once, to await onward conveyance, by road, from Leghorn and Forli' respectively.

4. At the same time suitable instructions should be issued to all concerned, including the Provincial Directors at Leghorn and Forli' for the provision of the necessary guards for the lorries, and for the loading and unloading of the mails.

Depending offices must be informed arranging to put up to date Prospetto Servizi Ammessi liberated territory by means of adding asterisk in columns 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 22, 23, 29, 32, 33, 34, and 35 on indication Forli' Province, and interesting same offices to put to date also Notizie exhibited public hall.
