To : Director General Ministry of Posts and Telecomm.

Further to your letter n. 802045/3/7 Na of 5th September  
1946.

1. Naples Ferrovia Office was visited on Wednesday 11th September 1946 and a meeting held between Sig. Corvisiero, the Assistant Director British Army Postal Services, and the undersigned writer.

2. The existing arrangement of the lay out of wire and approaches to the departure platforms was examined and an easy solution to the difficulty was found.

3. The A/Director British Army Postal Services, only requires the small hut as a garage and the whole of the remaining barbed wire from the iron entrance gates to the yard around the two large huts can be removed. The space immediately in front of the small hut is to be wired off from the rest of the yard and on this alteration being completed by the Royal Engineers Works Section, free access will be available for all types of P.O. vehicles from the loading platform to the Railway departure platform or the outside Roadway.

4. The military guard now doing duty at the iron entrance gates from the roadway will in future perform their guard duties at the newly constructed gateway to the wire compound in front of the garage.

5. These proposals were acceptable to your Administration Officials and on verification from them that the work has been completed it would be appreciated if you would forward a letter to this Office agreeing to the British A.P.O. having free access at all hours to and from the hut used as the garage for military vehicles in the Post Office Yard.



Reference letter n. P.51.21/CS of 2nd August 1946. Following on letter n. 802045/300399/3/7 Na dated 14th last month; we have taken due note of the informations ~~said~~ which have been sent to our General Directorate of the Dependant ~~organs~~ Bodies Naples, and we confirm that, as concerns the availability of the premises, after the already effectuated transfer, by the British Military Post, of four drawing-rooms and two rooms of the second advanced ~~part~~ part of the Naples Ferrovia building, the development of the parcel service is absolutely warranted, also if the British Military Post has again occupied, for its use, the small iron Romney huts, adjacent to the other similar two huts, which are larger, and which are still in possession of the Naples Ferrovia Parcel Office. But, in a first time (with ~~telegram~~ the telegram dated 29th August 1.m.) and in a second time (with an express of 3rd current month), our Naples Postal Movement Inspectorate has notified the great difficulty which occurs to the transport of the parcels from the postal office and from the two huts to the trains in departure and to the trains in arrival, difficulty which has been caused by the following three principal reasons:

1) Works for the restoration of a track of manoeuvre before the railway square, which shuts out the transit to the motorcars and to the transhipment-handcarts ~~to~~ to go from the office to the loading and unloading tracks of the cars.

2) Justified prohibition, from the Ferrovie, of access to the tracks with motorcars, as up till now it has been made, and that will be tolerated, exceptionally, for other few days.


3) The enclosure, with thorned thread, disposed by the British Military Post Command, of ~~all~~ the whole of the postal building and of the annex huts. By this mean all the ~~accesses~~ direct accesses, whether from the huts, or from the building which recently has been transferred from the British Military Post to the ~~tracks~~ railway tracks, has been closed; for this reason a connection has been established through the civic streets of the Corso Meridionale and of Via Novara, in which an intense routing of the vehicles is unwrapped; and through which it will be absolutely impossible to effectuate the transport of the parcels by means of handcarts, when the deferment granted ~~from~~ by the Ferrovie for the use of the motorcars will be due.

Following on what we have ~~said~~ said above, our General Directorate, recognizing that the difficulties marked by the Naples Movement Inspector and by the Ferrovia Postal Office Director are justified, beg your A.C. to give the charge to an Officer, to go urgently to Naples, ~~to~~ with the aim of make agreement arrangements, with our Postal Movement Inspector Sig. Corvisiero, and with the British Military Post Office Director, to examine if and in what way, the trace of the already disposed wirefence can be modified, with the aim of make possible the ~~access~~ direct access from the Postal Office to the railway square, avoiding the difficult and dangerous transit through the civic streets.

P.51 - 18 CS of 29 June and P.51 - 19 of 26 July 46.

1. The details of the accommodation to be returned from the British Army Postal Service to the Civil Post Office Naples Ferrovia Office are definitely confirmed as shown in the copy of letter forwarded with my P.51-19 CS of 26 July 46. In effect all but 3000 square feet of the total of 20,050 sq. ft. is now being handed back.
2. The premises were examined with your Administration representatives on Tuesday 30 July 46, and the conditions regarding surrender of one Nissen hut and the unrestricted access to it through the yard at the rear of the sorting office, were entirely acceptable.
3. Officially the date for the release of the specified portion of the premises is 10 August 46, but it is thought that the local arrangements already made will permit of the Naples Post Office authorities using it from today.
4. Your early reply approving the proposals regarding unrestricted access to the first hut, through the Post Office yard will be appreciated please.
5. It is hoped that with this early release of your Naples P.O. premises your arrangements for the reintroduction of the Internal Parcel Post service can be proceeded with satisfactorily.

Reference your P.6.258/CS dated 5 July 1946 and further to  
our G-5: 990.12 dated 15 July 1946.

1. It has been decided to allow the following portions of the Civil Post Office to be returned to the civil administration:
- a. The whole of the upper floor (9650 sq. ft. to be surrendered).
  - b. The ground floor less the portion at present in use and still required as the Counter and Callers Section (7,400 ex 10,400 sq. ft. to be surrendered).
  - c. The basement.
  - d. The loading platform.
2. It will be necessary, however, that the Italian Civil Administration surrender one of the Nissen huts in the yard of the premises, for use by 15 Base APO as a garage. The approach to the hut is through the yard, and a guarantee will be obtained that the Army Postal Service will be allowed unrestricted access to the garage at all times.
3. The target date for the completion of the reorganization and release of the accommodation is 10 August 1946. It will be noted that all but 3,000 sq. ft. of the total 20,050 sq. ft. in question will be released.



With reference to your 798994 8/4 of 28th May 1946.

1. I have discussed this matter with the authorities in Udine and Venezia Giulia Zone A and it is agreed as follows.

2. Directorates in Italian Government territory may be advised that the service is extended to the Province of Udine and to Venezia Giulia Zone A (that is, the portions of the Provinces of Gorizia, Trieste and Pola indicated in your lists as being under Allied Military Government).

3. The Communications Officer A.M.G. Venezia Giulia will instruct the Provincial Director Udine and the Direttore Superiore Trieste concerning the commencement of the outward service from Udine and Zone A.

4. Such parcels originating in Zone A for delivery in Zone A will not need to be diverted to Censorship, but those originating in Zone A for delivery in other ports of Italy will be forwarded through the Udine and Venice Censor Stations in the same manner as other postal matter.

5. Civil Censorship Group will instruct the Provincial Directorate Udine whether such parcels originating in Udine need be submitted to censorship.

6. It seems likely that you will receive demands from wholesale distributors of medicinal supplies to be given the same facilities as are afforded to the producers.







1. In view of the proposals to extend the service it is pointed out that so far as the Regions of Liguria, Piemonte and Lombardia are concerned the policy followed has been more restricted than would appear to be the case in para 2 of the A/M letter.
2. It would be more correct to say that the specific firms using the service at the time of the Liberation have been allowed to continue to do so. No permission has been given to extend the facility to other applicants during the period of AMG control and the service is not advertised to the public as being in operation.
3. If authority is given for this service to be extended to Venezia Giulia and Venezia Regions it is considered that the facility should be advertised as available to all firms in the North of Italy
4. A decision will be necessary on the exact meaning of the word "Medicine" as applicable to these packets, for numerous applications have been made to post "medicine products and appliances" and "sanitary requisites".

1. Extract is attached of letter from Communications Officer Venezia Giulia as to the commencement of a medicinal parcel service between Venezia Giulia and Italy:-

"Further, a request is made by the Pharmaceutical Society of Venezia Giulia that we institute a Medical Parcel Service as obtaining in Italy. This service to be between Venezia Giulia Zone A and Italy.

The parcel post does not yet operate in Italy but a Medical Parcel post up to 5 Kg. exists and Venezia Giulia Zone A would like to participate. Can this be arranged?"

2. When this question was last raised in P.16.384 dated 17 July it was found that this service had been in operation in Liguria, Lombardia and Piemonte Regions on their liberation and in view of the favourable transport situation there it was allowed to continue in operation. The Ministry at that time was not in favour of re-commencing this service in Central and Southern Italy owing to Transportation difficulties. It is assumed from your letter RXII/Com/Bull dated 8 August that this service was not in operation in Venezia Region.

3. Before the matter is again referred to the Ministry please inform us whether such service is now in operation in Venezia Region, and if not whether you now consider it practicable to institute such service.



The service temporarily interrupted by the war, is now about to be re-established and reorganised as provinces are handed over to the Italian Government's jurisdiction.

The Provincial Directorates will adopt in each case their own arrangements, without awaiting special instructions from the Ministry.

I do not see any objection to such services being re-established in A.M.G. territory also.

It is thought best to make it clear that this does not concern disposition, but transport of non-postal parcels not weighing more than 20 Kg., which the so-called commissioners carry out, on the basis of a concession obtained by the Postal Administration, from one locality to another, one behalf of third persons.

Such commissioners work under their own direct responsibility and the Postal Administration, which have in Italy the exclusive control of the transport of parcels or bundles up to 20 Kg. weight and which interferes with their services only to collect the charges fixed in table A n. 41 (G) of supplement bulletins n. 6 of 1945.





With reference to above mentioned letter and in reply to what requested in paragraph 3 of the same, we inform you that the carriers authorised for carrying packages up to 20 Kg., are those to which the administration has granted regular concession according to a licence from the Posture, since that service is reserved to postal administration.

The carriers make privately transports said above and apply the tariffs established and fixed by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry. Besides those tariffs, the carrier themselves are obliged to correspond the post rights in the proportion fixed at N. 41 of "Supplements al Bolet. 1406, by applying packages stamps on the proper labels which have to accompany the forwarding of each package."

The carriers are carrying packages by different means,

independently from time-tables fixed by the administration

Subject: Parcel delivery services by concessionary Companies.

To : Under Secretary of State for War and Telecommunications.

1. The question has arisen whether the delivery of parcels by third persons should again be allowed to operate under your postal regulations and subject to the fees payable by concessionaries under article 44, table 4 of the agreement to Bulletin No. 6 of 1945.
2. So far as this Commission is concerned there is no objection to the suspension of mail facilities in provinces where there is no internal communication before instructions to this effect are issued to postal officers in military government. I should be glad to be informed whether you are contemplating a similar regulation while the authorities are established in my area as at 20th June and if so, what instructions are to be given to provincial governors in Italian government territory.

SUBJECT: Parcel Carrier Service.

TO : Communications Sub-Commission, Headquarters, Allied Commission

1. Attached is correspondence relating to a request by local carriers for authority to resume the carrying of parcels up to 20 Kgs. in weight. There are 87 carriers in the City of Florence.

2. As is known, the parcel post service by the Post Office has not been resumed in A.M.G. territory and, so far as this Region is concerned, the transport position would not permit its resumption at this stage.

3. Nevertheless, it is felt that this factor alone should not prevent the resumption of the service by carriers which, in addition to (a) providing a service to the public and (b) assisting the labour situation by employing the carriers, would again produce revenue to the Post Office in the form of payment for each parcel carried by the carriers. Details of these payments are shown at para.41 (c), page 9 of Supplementary Bulletin no.6 of 1945.

4. Another aspect to be considered is that of Censorship. Effective Censorship would be impracticable; the best that could be done would be to have snap checks occasionally. If the service were restored, therefore, it would have to be on the basis of no Censorship. This arrangement might be permitted in the territory outside Army area.

5. The matter is submitted for consideration.

TRANSLATIONNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CARRIERS - ROMESection of Florence

The Carriers operating in the City of Florence, joined in extraordinary assembly, convoked by the Regional Deputy of the National Association of Carriers in the premises of the "Signori Co.Ltd." in order to discuss the circular issued by the local Direction of Posts and Telegraphs on the 21st March by which, following dispositions of the Allied Command the authorisation granted to the Carriers (ref. R.Decree no.578 of 23 February 1923) for the conveyance of parcels up to 20 Kgs. in weight, is suspended,

1. Noticed how this suspension harms besides the commercial class also a numerous category of workers which gets subsistence for their families from this activity;
2. Certain that all the members of this category will accomplish their activities with comprehension, observing all the regulations that eventually could be issued by the Allied Command;
3. Hope that the Allied Authorities will kindly grant the requests of the members, and revoke the suspension in question; such disposition has, only be applied in the Province of Florence.
4. Ask that a Deputation of the Carriers category be received by the competent authorities in order to illustrate the above request.

A Deputation was met on 19 April.

There are 87 Carriers in Florence. They carry only parcels or merchandise (not letters); under the decree referred to in their letters they were licensed [REDACTED] to carry parcels up to 20 Kgs. They paid a yearly fee for the license and, in addition, a payment was made to the Post Office in respect of each parcel carried. The present suspension means that their employees are out of work and is thereby causing hardship. They asked that the suspension be removed.

It was explained that parcel post by Post Office channels was still suspended and general issues were therefore involved which did not affect only Florence Province.

The representation would, however, be laid before higher Headquarters and a reply given in due course.

Interview with Director-general on 28 Apr 45.

Re. Florence carriers. No private carrier services officially started in Italian territory. It is known, however, some operating irregularly and without license. Ministry has asked ENAC to organise & control services. If properly controlled at Florence, there would be no objection. Told them censorship objection.

ENAC rates, by Royal Decree, too high for postal contracts. Italian P.D. requires small vans and cheaper rates. 150 vans to be handed over by Allies.

1. There are, at present, objections to the resumption of private carrier services, which have not been resumed officially in other parts of Italy.
2. as stated in your report, effective censorship of parcels conveyed by private carriers would be impracticable.
3. It is regretted, therefore, that until provision can be made for an effective control of such services, and before a relaxation of censorship becomes possible, authority for the 87 parcel carriers of Florence to resume their activities cannot be granted.

Spoke to Capt. Matroni on 24 Apr. He says AFHQ are definitely opposed to the private carriage of letters and parcels - they stopped private distributors in Naples. Censorship would object on security grounds. There could not be any effective censorship of letters and parcels carried by private firms and individuals.
