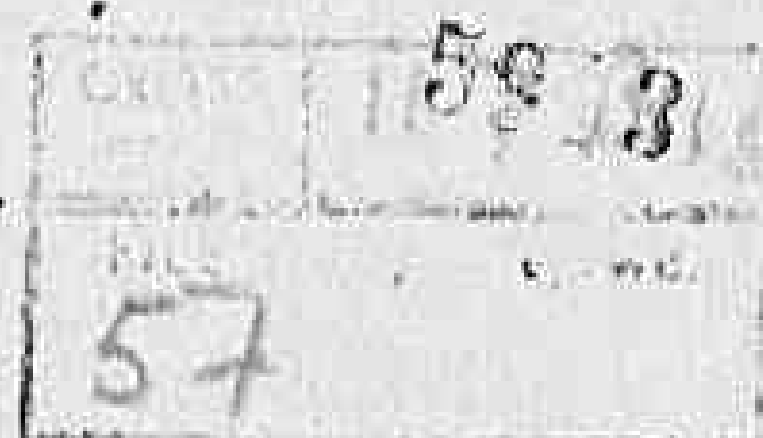

Reference P.45.116/CS of 25th September 1945.

1. In the copy of the telegram incorporated in the above letter the maximum weight limit should have read 1000 and NOT 100 grams.

2. It is thought that the relative telegrams sent from the Ministry were correct.

3. Subsequently it was agreed to restore as from 15th October the following normal postal services between Italy and the British Empire, Russia, Eritrea, Libya and Somalia up to the maximum weight limits specified in the Postal Convention.

Letters (Lettere)	Maximum weight
Commercial papers (Manoscritti)	2 Kilos
Printed papers (Stampe)	2 Kilos
Samples (Campioni)	500 Grams
Blind Literature (Carte punteggiate)	7 Kilos

Express letter services were also authorised to the above countries.

The postage rates for the new services are: -

Manoscritte:	First 250 grs - 5 Lire : then 1.50 Lire each additional 50 grs.	
Campioni:	First 100 grs - 3 Lire : then 1.50 Lire each additional 50 grs.	
Carte punteggiate:	1 Kilo - 50 c. : then 50 c. each additional Kilo	
Stampe:	For each 50 grs. - 1.50 Lire	
Express:	10 Lire	5912

A circular telegram giving the foregoing information was sent by the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications to all Provincial Directorates except those in Venezia Giulia.

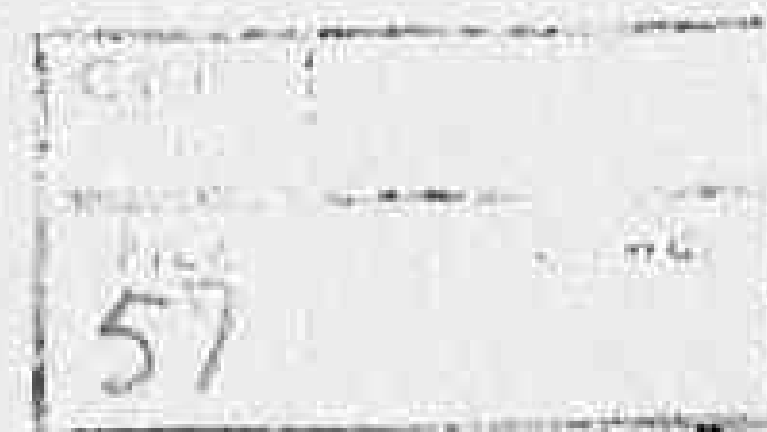

4. For the present the U.S.A. has not agreed to a similar extension of services between Italy and U.S. and its possessions and the service therefore remains limited to a postcard and 1000 gram letter service.

5. Venezia Giulia. The foregoing extensions of service referred to in para (3) were not applied to Venezia Giulia because the position as regards commercial correspondence was not clear. Now that non-transactional correspondence from Venezia Giulia has been approved (and there is an early prospect of transactional correspondence also being authorized) no objection is seen to the services mentioned in paras 3 and 4 being introduced in Venezia Giulia. The information given in respect of foreign services in the booklet "Tariffe PTT" published in the name of the Direzione Superiore will need amplification.

Subject: Udine Province. Conti Correnti.

To : Postal Officer Venezia Region.

With further reference to para 4 of your VG/Com/100 of 31st August and to my P.57.70 of 14th September 1945.

1. I enclose a letter from the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications pointing out the accounting difficulties arising from the transfer to Venezia of accounts opened at Trieste Conti Correnti Office by residents in Udine Province.

2. Under the ordinary regulations of this service it is permissible for a current account holder to designate the C.C. Office at which he wishes to be inscribed independently of his place of residence. Therefore, now that the service is working freely between Italy and Allied occupied territory in Venezia Giulia (unless it is intended to introduce special regulations) it will be possible for a resident in Italy to open an account with the Trieste Office and vice versa, and in these circumstances there seems to be no point in the special transfer of the accounts of the Udine holders.

3. If on the other hand it is decided that the Trieste C.C. Office may not hold accounts of residents living outside Venezia Giulia then the best course would seem to be to close such accounts and ask the holders to designate another C.C. Office at which the account should be reopened.

4. Please discuss the matter with the Directorates concerned and Finance and notify this office of the decision.

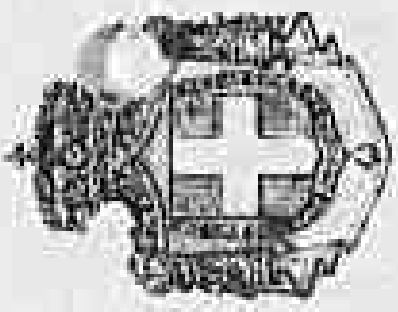

La detta comunicazione, assai tardiva, non permise di impartire tempestive e complete istruzioni telegrafiche, tanto più che sarebbe stato indispensabile conoscere quale procedura contabile l'Ufficio conti correnti di Trieste avesse intanto già attuata, di propria iniziativa, e stante anche l'impossibilità di corrispondere telegraficamente col detto Ufficio.

Le istruzioni, pertanto, in attesa di ulteriori notizie furono, in quel primo momento, limitate alle più imprescindibili, per la formazione del bilancio giornaliero.

Successivamente, da una circolare diramata ai correntisti interessati dall'Ufficio dei Conti Correnti di Trieste, si apprese che il trasferimento dei conti di cui trattasi, aveva carattere ten-

il sistema di teleselezione è in funzione o non lo è.

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In conseguenza di ciò e anche della notizia che erano già all'esame di codesta sottocommissione nuovi provvedimenti intesi a riattivare i servizi a denaro nella Venezia Giulia, le istruzioni telegrafiche, che frattanto erano state preparate da questo Ufficio Centrale, furono necessariamente sospese.

Così, in attesa di conoscere le determinazioni della Sottocommissione, i conti correnti, trasferiti da Trieste a Venezia, cartamente nell'intento di favorirne le operazioni, rimasero invece, e sono tuttora, forzatamente inattivi.

Infatti, mentre nella zona suddetta, per effetto delle disposizioni contenute nella lettera P.57.74/CS del 14 settembre u.s. sono stati già ripristinati i servizi a denaro, con le limitazioni ivi stabilite, è rimasta invece ancora insoluta la situazione dei conti correnti trasferiti temporaneamente da Trieste a Venezia.

Per essi si prospettano le seguenti due soluzioni:

1) Restituzione all'Ufficio dei conti correnti di Trieste dei conti correnti della provincia di Udine, trasferiti temporaneamente a Venezia, semprechè, come si ritiene, sia venuto meno il motivo per cui il detto trasferimento fu disposto.

In questo caso, che sarebbe il più semplice ed il più favorevole per i correntisti, non vi è che da disporre la restituzione dei conti all'Ufficio conti correnti di Trieste, dandone partecipazione ai correntisti medesimi.

2) Confermare il trasferimento dei conti di cui trattasi a Venezia. In tal caso, ai fini della contabilità, necessita che il provvedimento cessi dall'essere temporaneo e diventi definitivo.

E' infatti da considerare che non sarebbe possibile far coesistere presso due Uffici conti correnti diversi (Trieste e Venezia) due gruppi di conti contrassegnati dal medesimo numeratore (11), senza ingenerare una facile confusione nelle relative contabilità (tanto più che vi concorrono migliaia di uffici postali).

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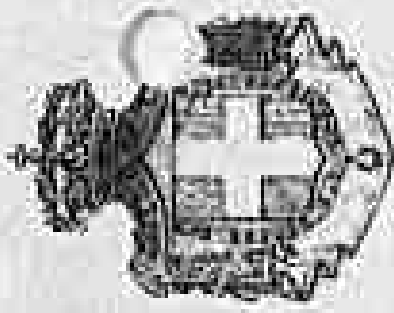

SUBJECT: Transfer of current accounts from Trieste C.A. to Venice.

With telegram n. 100 of September 6, which reached our Central C.A. office on 7th September, the Venice P.T. Provincial Directorate informed us that A.M.G. had arranged to transfer within the following day 3th October from the Trieste C.A. Office to Venice, all the current accounts of Udine Province, which were administered by the Trieste C. . Office and asked for the necessary instructions, concerning the accounting operations.

Said communication, rather a late one, did not allow us to issue in time and complete telegraphic instructions: furthermore it would have been indispensable to know what accounting procedure the Trieste C.A. Office had already put into operation ~~maxima~~ on its own initiative, and also owing to the impossibility of ~~maxima~~ corresponding by telegraph with the above office. The instructions, therefore, awaiting further information were on the first moment, limited to the most unavoidable for the ~~maxima~~ setting up of the daily balance.

Further on from a circular issued to the interested current account holders from the Trieste Conti Correnti Office we learnt that the transfer of ~~maxima~~ accounts in question were of a temporary character, for which the number of the account (that is to say both the "numerator" as well as the "denominator" had to remain unaltered). Consequently to this and also from the information that your Subcommission was already examining new provisions with the aim of re-establishing the financial services in Venezia Giulia the telegraphic instructions which in the meantime had been prepared by our central Office were necessarily suspended.

Therefore awaiting to know the decision of the Subcommission, the current accounts which had been transferred from Trieste to Venice, certainly with the intention of keeping the operation remained instead and still are, by force inactive.

In fact, while in the above areas by the effect of the instructions issued in letter P.57.74/CS of 14th September the financial services are already re-established with the restrictions established there the position of the C.A. transferred ~~in~~ temporarily from Trieste to Venice remains insolved.

The following two solutions are proposed:

1) To return to the Trieste C.A. the c.a. of the Udine Province temporarily transferred to Venice, always if ~~maxima~~ as is believed the reason of ~~max~~ transfer no longer exists. In this case, which would be simplest and more favorable for the holders, the return of the accounts to Trieste is no longer necessary and the same holders may be informed.

2) Confirm to Venice the transfer of accounts in question. In such case for accounting purposes it is necessary that the provision be no longer temporary but becomes definite.

It must be taken into consideration that it is not possible to leave at two different c.a. Offices (Trieste and Venezia) 2 groups of c.a. signed by the same "numerator" (11) without letting an easy confusion occur in the relative accounting (even more so as thousand of offices are involved) and without fitting out conveniently the Venice c.a. Office for the visa of the money orders of the Trieste group. Furthermore it is indispensable to forward always to said Trieste office all the relative payment orders and these should, time by time, be extracted from the general "note di carico" model ch.10 B received from the various Provincial Directorates and then forward them, having previously drawn up other model ch.10 B notes to the Venice C.A. Office with an evident hindrance to the speed of the operations.

To avoid all these inconvenients we should close such accounts in group 11 and re open them again in group 9.

This provision, anyhow, may be would not satisfy the whole of the interested holders (about 900) and therefore, if it is not absolutely indispensable, it is better to avoid doing so.

Therefore we are awaiting to know the decision of your Subcommittee to issue to the competent offices the definite accounting instructions.

1. It is assumed that in view of the issue of the new postage stamps which came on sale on 1st October 1945 all types of carte valori should now be requisitioned from Rome by the Northern Regions.

2. It is also assumed that no more stamps should be printed at Novara and the Postal Officer Lombardia Region is being asked to confirm that no such printing is proceeding.

3. In deciding on the disposal of the old type stamps on hand in the various Provinces - including those of the Northern Regions - no doubt the need for supplying Venezia Giulia with stamps of this kind will be borne in mind.

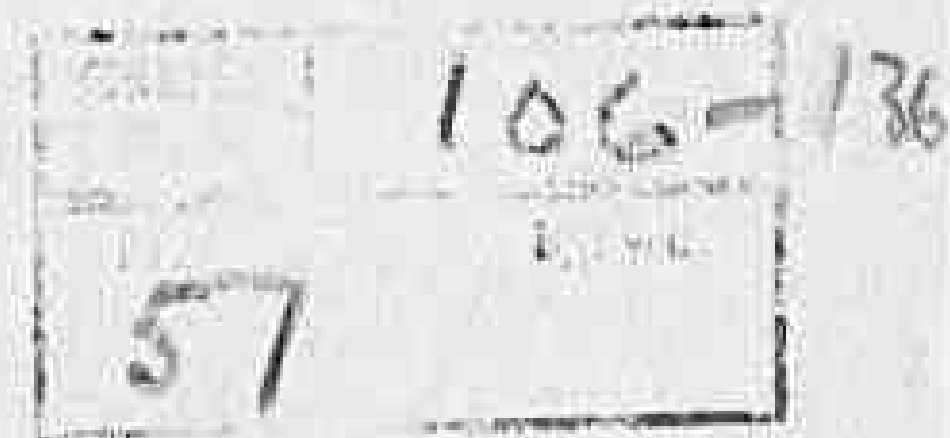

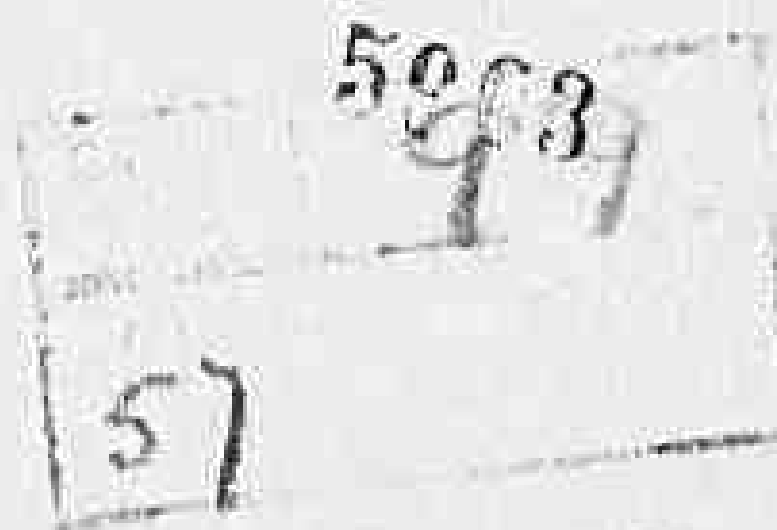

Subject: Venezia Giulia Post Office Financial Services.
 To : Finance Sub-Commission.

1. With reference to the re-establishment of Post Office Financial Services between Italy and the part of Venezia Giulia under Allied Military Government authorized in my P.57.74/CS of 14th September.

2. So far as new transactions are concerned the service from Italy will be restricted to the offices shown on the lists furnished by Venezia Giulia Region.

3. As regards old Conti Correnti payment orders drawn in favour of account-holders in the Trieste Conti Correnti Group and lying at Provincial Ragioneria in Italy it would be difficult to make the separation in Italy and it has been agreed that all such orders may be forwarded to Trieste where immediate action can be taken as regards those payable in Allied occupied territory.

4. The action to be taken as regards those payable to account holders residing in Jugo-Slav occupied territory can be decided at Trieste in the light of decisions which have no doubt already been given as regards the treatment of the accounts of such persons.

5. Copies of two telegrams issued by the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications on the subject are herewith.

Following on partial re-establishment of current accounts service with Venezia Giulia we have arranged that payment orders in favour of group 11 (Trieste) actually on hand at Ragioneria be immediately all forwarded without distinction to current accounts office Trieste. Some current accounts Office shall transfer to Trieste C.A. payment orders in favour said group temporarily credited on service account as the regulations are already known. 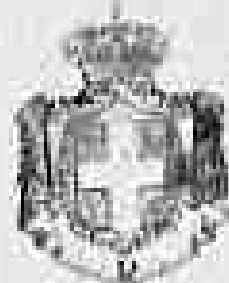

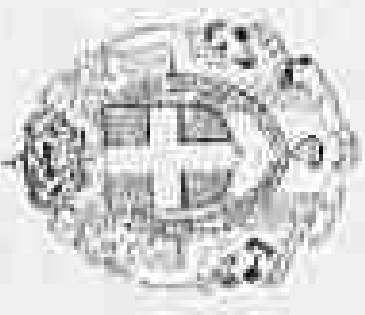

1. Consideration is being given to the possibility of extending the U.S.A. gift parcel service - which at present is confined to the cities of Rome, Palermo, Naples and the Vatican and the islands of Sicily and Sardinia - to the whole of Italy.

2. In this connection it is desired to ascertain whether the service could also be extended to Venezia Giulia on the assumption that the U.S.A. could despatch the relative parcel mails to Trieste.

3. The conditions applicable to the present service are as follows: -

- (a) Not more than one package per month from the same sender to the same addressee.
- (b) Parcels must not exceed 4 lbs in weight (this weight limit is likely to be increased to 5 kilos).
- (c) Parcels are limited to non-commercial shipments of consumer items such as foods, wearing apparel, medicals, smoking preparations and toilet articles not exceeding 25 dollars in value.

4. In Italy the service has been specially exempt from customs examination.

5. In considering this matter it is necessary to bear in mind that the U.S. Postal Authorities may not consider it practicable to confine such a service to those portions of the Provinces concerned which are under Allied Military Government and your views in the desirability or otherwise of extending the service to the whole of Gorizia, Trieste, Pola and Zara Provinces are requested.

References your 13 a/AMG/Post 5 and 8 of 5 October 45.

1. Attention is drawn to my P.57.74.CS of 14 Sept (copy to You) in which instructions were given as to the Postal and Post Office Financial services permitted between Italy and Venezia Giulia. It will be seen that with the exception of the newspaper post and certain legal services all postal services operating in Italian Government territory were authorized, so far as that part of Venezia Giulia under Allied Military Government is concerned.

2. As certain services were permitted only to one of the two administrative areas of Venezia Giulia it was obviously not practicable to introduce such services from Italy until the lists of Venezia Giulia Post Offices concerned were available for distribution to Italian Post Offices. This is the reason why when the extension of the insured letter service to Military Government territory in North Italy was originally approved Venezia Giulia was excluded.

3. By telegram despatched on 1st October the Ministry authorised Directorates in Italy to resume the following services with that portion of Venezia Giulia under AMG:-

Servizi Assicurato Privato

Posta Aerea

Stampe non periodiche fino 1000 gm

Also Vaglia, Risparmio, Buoni Fruttiferi, and Conti Correnti with the Cities of Gorizia, Pola and Trieste.

4. Enquiry has been made of the Ministry as to the reason why the full instructions have not yet appeared in the Bulletin as suggested in para 4 of P.57.74.CS and it is stated that it is due to the fact that certain technical problems have had to be decided in connection with the resumption of the financial services under present conditions. It is, however, hoped to publish the instructions shortly.

5. There is no reason why the above services should not be authorised in the Venezia Giulia - Italy service if this has not already been done.

6. In order to clarify the position as regards services actually in operation please connect a copy of the "Tariffe" booklet marked against each service to indicate whether it is in operation (a) within occupied territory (b) from occupied territory to Italy. If it is desired to reestablish the

1. It is agreed that in returning correspondence inadmissible under the standing instructions the censor station should not refer the sender to any Italian Government Agency or regulations. Civil Censorship Group have been asked to put this matter right.

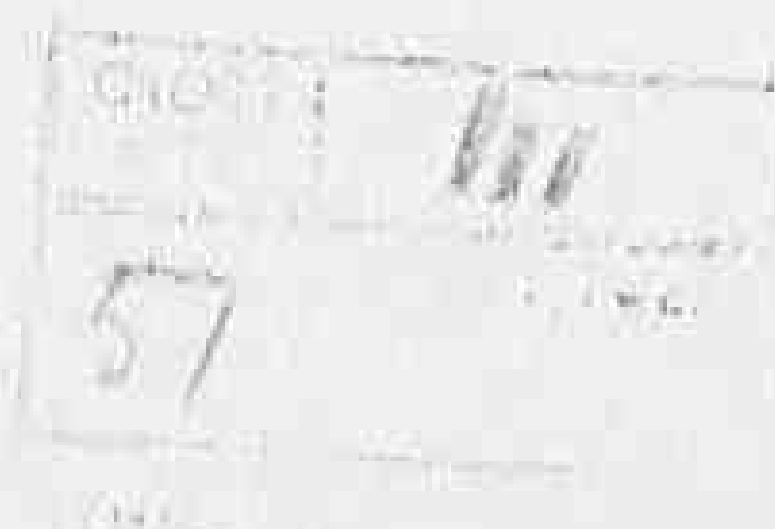
2. As regards the re-establishment of commercial and financial correspondence from occupied territory to foreign countries the question does not rest on local discretion but is dependent on Allied Financial and Economic Policy. In the case of Italy the matter has been the subject of discussions at the C.C.S. level and such facilities as have been allowed have been made dependent on the establishment of effective controls by the indigenous Government. So far no indication has been seen of any proposals to establish similar controls by the Government of Venezia Giulia.

3. The Post Office; this Sub-Commission and its representatives in the field are concerned with providing the channels of communication and the question what types of business communication may be carried in those channels is primarily a matter for decision by the Financial and Commercial Authorities. Censorship is concerned with the enforcement of the standing instructions. On the assumption, however, that proposals for the re-establishment of foreign commercial correspondence from Venezia Giulia have not already been put forward by A.M.G. 13 Corps the question has been raised with the Finance and Commerce Sub-Commissions in the attached ~~P.57.98 and~~ P.57.97.

1. At the present time the outward external postal service from Venezia Giulia is limited to a 40 gram personal and family letter and postcard service.

2. Except in the case of correspondence for Jugoslavia (which under the agreement passes directly without censorship) the whole of the foreign correspondence from Venezia Giulia passes through ~~censor~~ ~
Censor Station in Italy.

3. Reports indicate that there is a considerable demand for the reintroduction of foreign commercial correspondence services from Venezia Giulia at least equivalent to those obtaining in the external service from Italy.

4. In these circumstances perhaps you will consider what classes of commercial and financial services may be permitted and who will exercise in that territory the controls to be applied in Italy by Italian Government agencies. If a decision covering transactional communications cannot be given quickly it is recommended that non-transactional commercial correspondence be authorised in advance.

1. ADMINISTRATION

- a. Matters apertaining to Zone B and POLA communications are dealt with separately and the latest information is being given.
- b. The weekly meetings of the Direttore have been discontinued as they are no longer necessary.
- c. The General Strike of 24 Sep 45 brought to light the necessity for clarifying the Legal position of the State Employees of Post and Telegraphs. This matter is being dealt with.
- d. The Telecom Division was allowed a 10 minute broadcast on 17 Sep 45. Opportunity was taken to point out what had been done and what it was hoped to do in the future. In addition, the illegality of stealing telegraph poles etc etc was pointed out.
- e. The Finance Department have spent much time in deciding on how the TELVE Company should be re-imbursed for services given to the military. This matter is being dealt with in a separate letter.
- f. Epurazione has not yet made itself felt but it is possible that one or two key men may have to go. In addition the large and redundant staff which seems to increase rather than get smaller gives cause for investigation and this will be dealt with in due course. I have asked for lists of the number of personnel employed here and from a quick glance there appear to be many of the higher grades who should be put back into retirement immediately.
- g. Arrangements have been made between C.S.O. 13 Corps and ⁵⁸⁸¹ for the company to take over maintenance of a 20 wire semi-military route between DULINO and MONFALCONE.

I have investigated their complaints and in nearly every case it has been that the merchants have had returned to them their commercial correspondence for the above countries which the merchants had despatched one or two days after the liberation. Naturally the Italian authorities were not sure of the position and had caused this correspondence to be returned. The merchants appreciated the position and have started all over again, but it is still being returned. This time the returned mail bears a printed slip the wording of which is giving cause for concern.
- b. The new issue of VG-AMG overprints stamps were issued for sale and there is no comment except that the present large demand is as the result of collectors, this demand will diminish in the near future.
- c. Attention is drawn to my report on the Second Meeting with the Zone B representatives. I have agreed that commercial and family correspondence is to be exchanged between the two Zones and Italy. I would point out that I have not started anything new, as this Service has been in existence all the time.
- d. Civilian mail from the United States for civilians in JUGOSLAVIA is being sent addressed to "AMG 13 Corps" in sometimes as many as ten bags. This apparently was arranged by Major Turner and will be the subject of a separate letter.
