SUBJECT: Alignment of Frequencies allocated for Broadcast Use
to the R.A.I.

TO : R.A.I.

1. Your attention is directed to copies of letters (see Tabs "A" through "K") originals of which letters appear in the files of the Communication Division, Allied Commission. All of these letters are pertinent to the assignment of frequencies for broadcast use to the R.A.I. In comparing these assigned frequencies against the list of frequencies presented by your organization as being in use many irregularities become immediately evident, and it is therefore the intention of this letter that alignment shall be accomplished by you.

2. Inasmuch as all frequencies which were in use by your organization prior to 16 October 1945 were cancelled by letter, Allied Force Headquarters, Office of the Chief Signal Officer, dated 16 October 1945, file reference 311.23/117 (see Tab A) it is not understood why any other frequencies should be in use by R.A.I. with the exception of course of those frequencies which were authorized by later correspondence. The fact is obvious, as may be seen by a reading of Tabs "B", "C", and "D" that you have been reminded of this matter the minimum of three times.

3. You are further referred to Tabs "E" and "F" which explicitly denied to you the use of 1068 Kcs and 6030 Kcs respectively. The former of these two frequencies is reported by you as being in operation in the city of Florence. The transmissions are therefore unauthorized on that frequency as indeed are any other transmissions by R.A.I. on frequencies handed over to it by the IWB. Frequencies of these IWB stations were given to R.A.I., admittedly, but authorization to continue operations on these frequencies after the 16th of October 1945 is lacking. The frequencies allotted to the IWB were a war time measure, that is, - that the frequencies were loaned to the various Allied nations and placed in a common operating pool. You are reminded then that in all cases that IWB frequencies are still the property of the various Allied nations on the basis of the original allocation of that frequency, and that in order to obtain permission to share that frequency, negotiations will have to be undertaken with the foreign nation (See Tab "K").

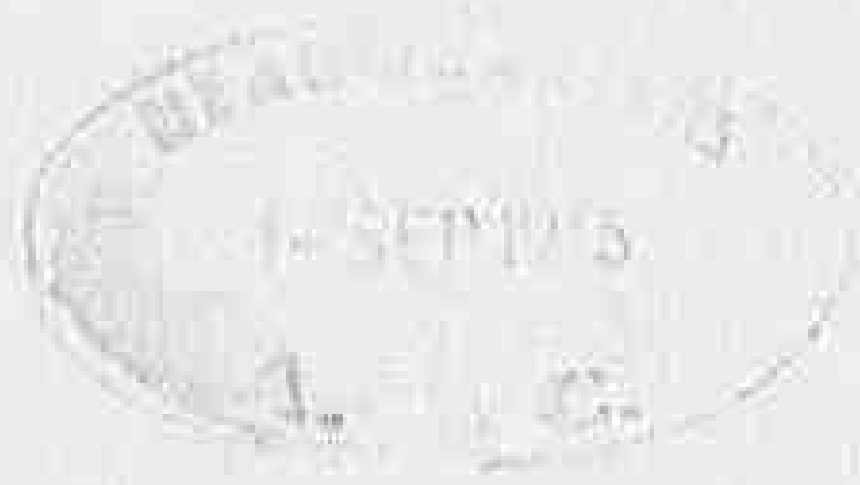
