SUBJECT: R.C.A. and CABLES & WIRELESS

TO: Director, Telecommunications & Postal Sub-Commissions

1. These two firms have offices and instrument rooms at 8 San Felice 2nd Floor, in the same building as the PRO of AFHQ. So that the whole set up can work as a team. (The office is some two hundred yards lower down the road from the Provincia Building)
2. RCA work to New York. They have two transmitters and three wave lengths. They handle RFA's Press messages, US Govt. traffic both ways and "senders composition" from US to this theatre. Their rates are controlled by the PRO in the usual peacetime way. The service opened on Feb. 1st. and is controlled by PBS for AFHQ. Press messages are passed through PRO., the US Govt. messages are received and dispatched to the appropriate Dept, and all other communications are handled through 2nd Base Post Office. A Broadcast to New York is being transmitted on the 29th inst.
3. Cables and Wireless are in much the same position except that they are controlled through CSO 1. of C. for AFHQ. They have one 5KW Transmitter which it is hoped to bring into service at 0800 hrs. Feb. 26th. In addition to their telegraph equipment they have a picture Xmitter and Recr. The two top men are Robinson and Tims.

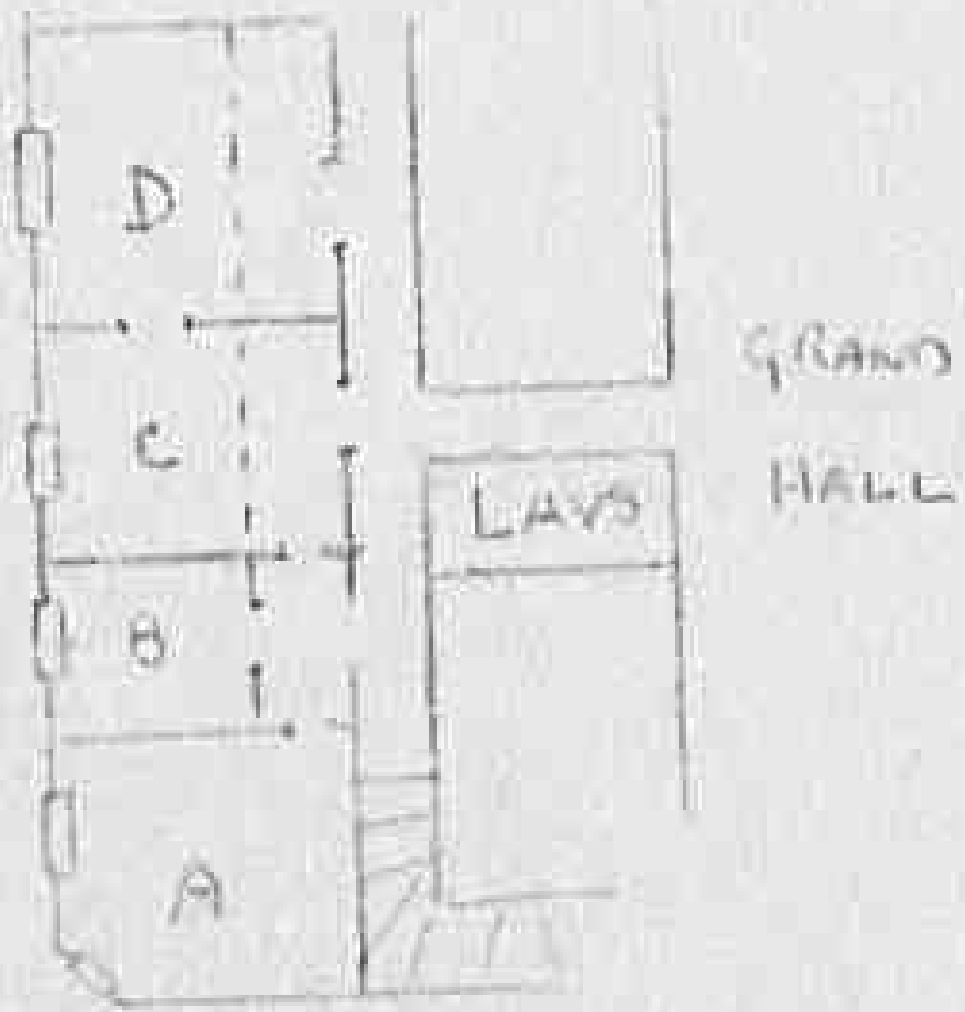

Where, however, such documents are issued to a named officer, or the holder of an appointment, they will be regarded as being held on the personal charge of such officer.

The inviolability of classified information is the duty and responsibility of all persons having knowledge thereof, no matter how obtained. It is the duty of all military personnel to report to immediate superior and/or security officer any violations of military security. Any person finding a classified document unattended will immediately assume custody and will be responsible for its proper safeguarding until returned to proper authority.
