1. IN COMPLIANCE WITH SPECIAL REQUEST FOR INFORMATION CONCERNING TRAFFIC LOAD OF THE SIGNAL CENTER, HQ ALLIED COMMISSION, DATED 25 OCTOBER 1944, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS SUBMITTED FOR YOUR PERUSAL:

A. BREAKDOWN OF AVERAGE DAY'S TRAFFIC, BY MAJOR STATIONS AND GROUP COUNT TO AND FROM THOSE STATIONS

WHILE IT MAY SEEM THAT AN EXCESSIVE GROUP COUNT IS SHOWN UNDER "OTHERS", A FURTHER BREAKDOWN WOULD TAKE US INTO A LARGE NUMBER OF SMALL STATIONS TO WHOM WE MAY SEND 200 GROUPS OR LESS, AND FROM WHOM WE RECEIVE SIMILAR AMOUNTS.

B. ALL TRAFFIC HANDLED BY TELEPRINTER CIRCUITS IS CLEARED BY CALLING THE DISTANT STATION THROUGH THE ROME SWITCHBOARD. ROME ALLIED AREA COMMAND DOES NOT ACT AS RELAY STATION FOR OUR TRAFFIC.

C. TRAFFIC TO THE LOCAL ROME HEADQUARTERS (RAAC) IS FOR THE MOST PART HANDLED BY DR. THIS PREVENTS THE ENGAGING OF OUR LINES AND ALLOWS OTHER STATIONS TO CALL US AT ANY TIME.

D. THE SMALL AMOUNT OF RELAY TRAFFIC HANDLED BY THIS SIGNAL CENTER IS USUALLY TRAFFIC FROM SOME REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS. THE ORIGINATORS IN THESE CASES HAVE SHOWN LAEE, MJAJ OR LRAR AS ADDRESSEES AS WELL AS THIS HEADQUARTERS.

E. ROME ALLIED AREA COMMAND DOES PROVIDE QUITE A RELIABLE DR SERVICE WITHIN THE ROME AREA. A COPY OF THEIR MDLS DIAGRAM IS INCLUDED FOR YOUR INFORMATION. HQ ALLIED COMMISSION ALSO FURNISHED DR SERVICE, FUNCTIONING UNDER THE ADJUTANT'S DEPARTMENT. 5577

2. IT IS HOPED THAT THE ABOVE INFORMATION WILL BE OF SUFFICIENT BREAKDOWN TO GIVE YOUR OFFICE A TRUE PICTURE OF OUR PRESENT SITUATION. IF IT IS DESIRABLE, WE CAN SUBMIT FURTHER BREAKDOWN, SHOWING ALL STATIONS THAT WE WORK. HOWEVER, IT IS FELT THAT SUCH A REPORT WOULD BE TOO BULKY, AND WOULD FURNISH LITTLE REAL INFORMATION.
