SUBJECT: Italcable Radio Station in Trieste

TO : Allied Force Headquarters
Att: G-5

1. Telegraph and telephone communication for civilian and Italian Government traffic to Trieste is congested and constitutes a definite hazard to the maintenance of order. A copy of a waiting time report for long distance telephone calls is attached as a matter of information. Efforts are being made to establish additional long distance telephone and telegraph circuits. Circuit facilities are scarce and continuity of service in existing facilities is uncertain.

2. Italcable has requested permission to install and operate a radio station in Trieste for radiotelegraph traffic to Rome and Milan. Italcable radiotelegraph circuits are able to handle telegraphic traffic rapidly, and such a circuit would materially increase communication services with Trieste.

3. If this request is approved, Italcable would necessarily, coordinate its use with and obtain authorization for rates and service from the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications. Also, permission to use an approved frequency would be requested through the Combined Signal Board.

4. It is recommended that authorization be granted for installation and operation of a radiotelegraph station in Trieste.

a. Reference your letter #982360/7330-1 dated 11 November 1946 it is shown that Italcable desires to establish a link with the United Kingdom for the transmission of radio photos using 14736 kilocycles as the medium of exchange.

b. Italcable has also requested the use of 14736 kilocycles in establishing a teletype link with Moscow and for its radiotelephone link with Cairo. It is supposed that the use of this frequency would be alternated on those days when its service was not required by one or the other links.

2. The difficulty is obvious and it is therefore requested that this matter be investigated and clarified, and that the results of your investigation be forwarded to this office.

TO: Allied Force Headquarters, APO 512
Attn: Combined Signal Board.

1. A request has been received from Italcable for reassignment and allocation of the following frequencies:

a. That its present frequency of 9610 kilocycles (link with New York) be changed to its pre-war frequency of 10022 kilocycles.

b. That it be authorized the use of 14736 kilocycle frequency to experiment in establishing a teletype link with Moscow. This frequency will be used on some days only and only during the morning hours.

c. That it be authorized the use of 14736 kilocycle frequency for radiotelephone link with Cairo on such days as are not occupied in establishing the link with Moscow. At the present time Italcable is authorized only the 14485 kilocycle frequency where contact with Cairo is concerned.

2. Request that this office be advised of the decisions made so that it will be able to make appropriate reply to Italcable.
