Subject : Release of Supplies of Calcium Carburet.

To : Under-Secretary of State for PP.TT.

1. Reference your letter No. S/8.6/3365 dated 25th October, 1944.

2. The Industry Sub-Commission of this Headquarters informs me that the release of Calcium Carbide for civilian needs is controlled by the Ministry of Industry Commerce and Labour.

3. Your application should therefore be forwarded to the Ufficio Provinciale Del Commercio dell'Industria or direct to the Ministry of Industry.

4. It is however pointed out that calcium carbide is in extremely short supply and justification for your application will be necessary in proving that other means of emergency lighting are either unsuitable or not available.

5. It is suggested that as your requirements are only for occasional lighting in emergency an application requesting the provision of small consignments at given dates, if proved to be then required, would be more favourably considered, than the demand for 5 tons to cover a period up to 30 June 45, for it cannot be known in advance that such a quantity will be consumed.

Contents have been appreciated of your aforesaid letter concerning the supply of copper sulphate necessary to the dependent Telegraph Offices. We assure you that, according to provisions that will be enforced by the Federazione Italiana dei Consorzi Agrari, the Provincial Directions of P and T, will be authorized to withdraw only the amounts which are deemed absolutely necessary for the telegraph traffic - this is a view to avoid abuses.
