their proposal will not be considered possible or oportune, suggest
the demolition or recovery of the equipment in order to avoid
removal and robbery.

In any case, the use of any line for the networks of the
governmental or private organizations and the demolition of any
plant for the recovery, the maintenance and custody of the relative
equipment, cannot be effected without previous authority from the
Allied Communications Division and the Azienda Recupero Alleanza
Residui to be requested through this Office.

With reference to cable N.1454180/244 of 23.1 and phonogram N.283813/600 of 24.1 of Azienda di Stato, we inform that in the contract of purchase of Allied equipment signed by the A.R.A.R., a clause was included, with which the Italian Government is kept ~~indefinitely~~ not to change or demolish the plants without previous approval from the proper Allied authorities, as results from attached letter.

Furthermore, on the basis of letter N.31667 DG/RIL/A/226.2E3 of 19.10.46, communicated with letter N.1764859/CTI/MA of 23.11.46, this Administration is for the time being simply depositary of this equipment, of whose consistence is responsible to A.R.A.R.; consequently until the question of the purchase by this Administration will not be completely defined, for any possible change of consistence previous authority will be requested from A.R.A.R.

1. Reference telephone conversation Dr. Cuscianna - Major Stopford.
2. Information has been received from Allied Commission Liaison Officer with H.Q. 86 Area, Venice, that serious damage is likely to be caused to the instruments of the TELVE Exchange in that city owing to lack of diesel oil for heating purposes, and should this occur telephone communications in 86 Area will be seriously affected.
3. Formerly the TELVE Exchange was heated by coal but owing to the difficulty of obtaining this fuel in the early days of our occupation of Venice instructions were then issued by AMI for the heating apparatus to be changed from coal burning to oil burning and sufficient fuel had been supplied through AMI to last until 10th January 1947.
4. On 30th September 1946 TELVE applied to the Milan Office of the Ministry of Fuel for an allocation of oil but this application was refused. The Allied Military authorities have recently made a loan of diesel oil to TELVE which will be sufficient for only 14 days and it is impossible to make further loans from Allied Military stocks.
5. The TELVE Company are asking for 120 qts diesel oil per month in order that their instruments may be kept at an even temperature, and it will be greatly appreciated if you will please confirm to this Headquarters that arrangements have been made for a civilian allocation to cover this quantity.

We forward the list of equipment ceded by the Allies, which at the check effected by the Regional Directorates of the Office of Control for Telecommunications resulted missing.
2. Such lists are made according to order of mentioned Directorates. For plants partially missing the percentage in value of the deficiencies has been indicated.
3. Some plants, and precisely the ones in the zone of Caserta and part of the ones in the zone of Leghorn, remained in consignment to the Allied military Authorities, which use them on their own account and have their own personnel for their maintenance (See Att. A of list.).
4. This Administration will bear in mind that the decision of the Interministerial Committee for Reconstruction, with the address to the various State Administrations to take in consignment the fixed plants transferred from the Allied Command, wanted only to provide to the maintenance which this Azienda is in no position to face. The delivery does therefore not consist in a regular cession, and no charge can derive from those consignments to the interested Administrations, except the duty of guarding and maintaining the State's patrimony entrusted to them.
5. The Service VI, the Central Directorate of Maresse and the Azienda di Stato per i Servizi Telefonici, for the part of their own competence, will have to certify that the regular consignment of the plants and equipment ceded by the Allies and recognized existing, has been made.

1. The Chief Signal Officer has sent the following telegram to this Division;

"S.I.R.T.I. reports 50 per cent cut in allocation of petrol from CIF sources. This liable effect military comms. Request you investigate possibility or restoring allocation to normal".

2. S.I.R.T.I. is the Italian Agency responsible for maintenance of telephone lines used by Allied Military Forces.

3. It is recognized that gasoline supply is very low at this time. However, failure of S.I.R.T.I., to obtain adequate gasoline will result in it being necessary to divert army stocks to S.I.R.T.I. use in order to continue adequate maintenance of telephone lines. Maintenance problems are made more acute by constant thievery of telephone lines that must be replaced promptly.

4. If you could inform me of the possibility of increasing the allocation of gasoline to S.I.R.T.I. I would inform the Chief Signal Officer of what to expect.

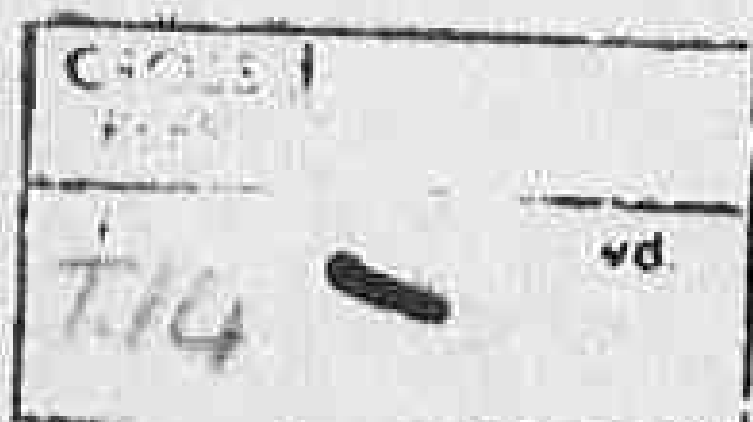

Your views about the gasoline situation for MARESPE have been transmitted to the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications. It is pointed out, however, that the supply of motor fuel in Italy is sufficient for only 14 days operation, and is being apportioned carefully. Use of this fuel by the telecommunications people should be limited. A disproportionate use in the telephone companies could result in other essential users receiving quantities too low for effective operation.

Referring to LAC 148 Appendix B Annexure 1 and comparing with CAL 59, the following points should be noted.

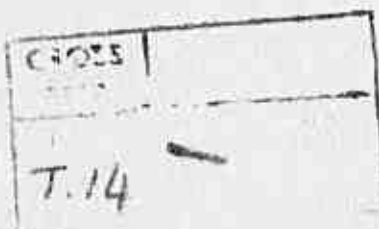
1. Serial 63 LAC 148 reads 75,000
CAL 59 reads 7,500
Serial 15 LAC 148 reads 2,000
CAL 59 reads 1,000

If this means that these items are in short supply then it is advisable to cancel Serial 63 altogether as the amount (7,500 ft) is useless.

2. Para 2 of CAL 59 shows items available ex UK but four of the items show American catalogue numbers. Is it to be assumed that this American material is available in UK or will the UK hand the items back to America as "Not available ex UK".

3. Only 17 items are shown in CAL 59 whereas LAC 148 shows 34 as coming from stocks other than British Theatre.

Is it to be presumed that the remainder i.e. 17 items are coming from American Theatre Stocks if so are we aware that the items are actually available.

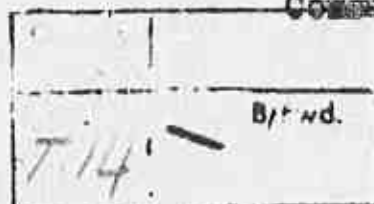
With ref to your letter 414. 71C of 11 October (received this office 22 Oct) herewith are the particulars asked for. I regret the delay but it has been necessary to sift through my files to obtain the relevant information.

I have sent you copies of correspondence lettered A to F and they should be perused in that order. As the correspondence is read it will be seen the difficult position I am in when you ask me for details of material which I consider as urgent. I cannot give the details because, as the correspondence will show you so many details have been changed but not confirmed by AFHQ or the Combined Chiefs of Staff. I can only quote the major part of LAC 139 but I feel at the same time that LAC 139 is not a true representation.

I would suggest to you that you do the same as I have done, that is to say, amend and counter-amend items whenever possible and where certain items have been left indecisively amended or left untouched, keep to LAC 139.

Herewith is a short explanation of each letter.

- A. LAC 139 is an extract from the original and only shows material still urgently needed.
- B. LAC 142 shows first amendements dealing with availability of U.S. theater stocks and changes the type of wire and the amounts.
- C. CAL 45 approves certain items but also changes others, i.e. items Serial N°s 1.8.9.10.11.15.16.20.21 and 64. These changes were studied by the Communications Sub-Commission who pointed out unsuitabilities and also

- asked for certain items to be cancelled.
- D. Includes a copy of my telegram to Communications Sub-Commission pointing out certain discrepancies in CAL 45 and asking for more particulars. The letter addressed to me answers my telegram and is a copy of that which had been passed to Economic Section by Communications Sub-Commission.
- E. LAC 147 is AFHQ's answer to CCAC pointing out unsuitabilities etc of certain items contained in CAL 45. I have noted against these certain items whether or not they have been received.
- F. 414.7/C to Major Jeffrey from Lt. Arensberg particularizes certain items over which a major confusion exists. This letter was sent subsequent to a talk between Lt. Arensberg S. Col. Millar and myself. It will be seen that the resultant telegrams F1, F2 and F3 confuses the issue even more.

I appreciate that a muddle exists due in part to non-availability and bad selection of substitutes but unfortunately nothing seems to have been brought to a final conclusion.

If it is the intention of CCAC to withhold these supplies, it would help the receiving end considerably if we were told so that other arrangements could be made.

Hoping that you can assist in this matter.
