1. We are advised that there is likely to be an availability in the future of large size u/s dry batteries.
2. It is understood that torch batteries can be manufactured by breaking down these batteries and using the LT cells, which still have a proportion of their life intact.
3. If facilities exist whereby torch batteries could be made for civilian use in this manner under Government control, a sample lot of the u/s batteries can be made available.

2. It is understood from Col. Keith's Memo that it may be possible to release to the Italian Government the equipment now at Verona Repeater Station.

3. This equipment is very badly required, and it is accordingly requested that it be handed over to the Under-Secretary of State for Posts and Telecommunications.

4. It is also requested that consideration be given to the supply of transport for the removal of the equipment at Zauchen.

It is understood that Italians would not be allowed to go to Zauchen to collect the bays, and in any case there are only a few 15 cwt vehicles available which are needed for normal maintenance.

This Office have been informed that, that Command have give order to desmond, already initiated the cilduct lines who served the airports into provinces of Taranto and Matera.

Within such conduct, it's taken away the telephone lines installed for the communications of the same airports.

Because this Firm encounter big difficulty to find transportations, to provide for material necessary for the maintenance required for the Apulia and Lucani Acqueduct, make request to that Command for the assignment of 250 kilometers of telephone lines completed of all, 40 km. of steel pipes of 6", and km. 30 of steel pipes of 4".

With that material this Firm will suddenly provide to establish telephone communications for the best and more efficacious surveillance of the installations, more necessary for does of the Lucani Acqueducts that falls on impervious zones, without roads, and at the substitution of that conducts more deteriorated and to make better that service of hydro alimentations to numerous population centers.

If that Command can't give the whole material as same as the request, this Firm will be satisfied also of less quantity. In this case the execution of work will be limited of does of more urgent necessity.

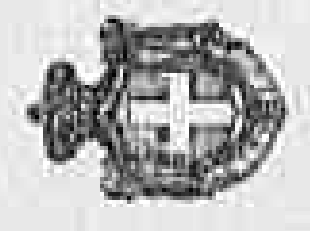

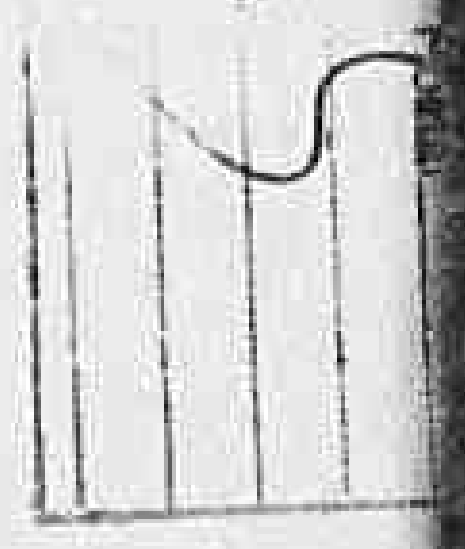

It is intended that captured civilian material made available to MG/AFS under the provisions of the Directive above referred to should be dealt with under the terms of the plan for the control of the manufacture and sale of industrial products in Northern Italy attached to the letter of this HQ of 9 July '45, ref. 1.000/BS.

3. The agency to receive declarations of availability of captured civilian material to be made available to AG/AMC by JMWOC, Base Sections, and Districts in the field, or by controlling agencies of AMHQ will be the Liaison Office of the War Materials Disposal Subcommittee.

4. a. The category of materials which are determined to be of Italian origin within the meaning of sub-section (1) to paragraph 9k of the Arms Directive above referred to and to which title had not passed to the Germans shall be determined by War Materials Disposal Subcommittee with the assistance of a claims board set up by that Subcommittee consisting of Italian personnel selected with the agreement of the North Italy Industrial Council and the Italian Government. The War Materials Disposal Subcommittee will make the necessary volumes of these materials to the owners under financial arrangements to be made where necessary with the advice of Finance Subcommittee. The Finance Subcommittee will designate for this purpose an officer in the Northern Area to give such advice as may be required from time to time.

b. Material of Italian origin, title to which had not passed to the Germans and the ownership of which cannot be determined, will be disposed of in the same manner as all other materials handed over to AG/IR under the terms of the Directive.

5. all materials made available to AC/HR other than those referred to in 4a will be disposed of as provided below. The War Materials Disposal Subcommission is constituted as the authority to issue valuations of materials to the Italian Government requested by the North Italy Military Council (AIMC), which is hereby authorized to make such allocations necessary.

3. The agency to receive declarations of availability of captured civilian material to be made available to AG/MSG by London, these Sections, or Districts in the field, or by controlling services of AFHQ will be the Milan Office of the War Materials Disposal Subcommittee.

4. 2. The character of materials which are determined to be of Italian origin within the meaning of sub-section (1) to paragraph 9k of the Army Directive above referred to and to which title had not passed to the Germans shall be determined by the Materials Disposal Subcommittee with the assistance of a claims board set up by that Subcommittee consisting of Italian personnel selected with the agreement of the North Italy Industrial Council and the Italian Government. The War Materials Disposal Subcommittee will make the necessary releases of these materials to the claims board under financial arrangements to be made where necessary with the advice of Finance Subcommittee. The Finance Subcommittee will designate for this purpose an officer in the Northern Area to give such advice as may be required from time to time.

5. Material of Italian origin, title to which had not passed to the Germans and the ownership of which cannot be determined, will be disposed of in the same manner as all other materials handed over to AG/MSG under the terms of the Directive.

6. All materials made available to AG/MSG other than those referred to in 4a will be disposed of as provided below. The War Materials Disposal Subcommittee is constituted as the authority to issue releases of captured materials to the Italian Government represented by the North Italy Industrial Council (NICO), which is hereby authorized to make suballocations necessary to enable firms and individuals to withdraw the materials in question from controlling services. These releases will contain all the information appearing in the declaration of availability called for in paragraph 7 below.

7. When materials are designated by the NICO for distribution in Italian Government territory, the Italian Government will issue the necessary instructions through the President of the NICO for suballocation to such firms and individuals as may be situated outside territory under AG control.

8. The Milan office of the War Materials Disposal Subcommittee will circulate the appropriate services under the Commanding Generals of 5th Army, 13th and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Districts requesting that declarations of availability of captured civilian materials to AG/MSG be issued in triplicate and in such form as to show the exact location and description of the goods, including quantities, types, condition, packing, state of readiness for shipment, origin (Italian, German or other, or, if unknown, a statement to that effect), and the designation of the unit having physical

control thereof. However possible, destruction of availability of captured civilian materials should be accompanied by existing documents, such as bills of lading, invoices, or evidence of sale or any record from which prior valuation of the goods might be ascertained. The Milan office of the War Materials Disposal Subcommission will likewise circulate similar copies of the form of the release which it will issue in the name of AG/AM with the appropriate Subcommission endorsement so that the form may be readily recognizable by units expected to be called upon to honor suballocations made under such releases.

8. The War Materials Disposal Subcommission will channel all releases covering industrial plant, machinery and equipment, semi-fabricated goods and raw materials, in triplicate, to the Milan office of Commerce Subcommission, which will submit a copy of the same to the AMIO for consideration, thereby according to the terms of paragraphs 3a (4) (5) and 1 (4) of the Directive of this HQ of 2 July '45. A second copy bearing the endorsement of the Industry Subcommission will be forwarded to the controlling service when the program of distribution submitted by the AMIO has been approved thereby.

9. The War Materials Disposal Subcommission will channel all releases covering consumer goods in triplicate to the Milan office of Commerce Subcommission, which will transmit one copy of the same to the AMIO for consideration under the terms of paragraph 3a of the Directive of this HQ of 2 July '45. A second copy bearing the endorsement of the Commerce Subcommission will be forwarded to the controlling service when the program of distribution submitted by the AMIO has been approved thereby.

10. The Milan offices of Industry and Commerce Subcommissions, upon transmitting such releases to the AMIO, will obtain from the latter Receiving Reports in triplicate covering the goods, to be signed by the President of the AMIO or by his delegate on behalf of the Italian Government. These Receiving Reports, in the form attached hereto, will contain all the information called for in paragraph 7 above and will be transmitted to the War Materials Disposal Subcommission. Two copies of the Receiving Report will be transmitted by the War Materials Disposal Subcommission to the Chief Accountant, Finance Subcommission, as evidence of the assumption of obligation of the Italian Government for the value of the materials and will be accompanied by such evidence of prior valuation as may have been obtained from the controlling service. The Chief Accountant will later transmit to the Italian Government one copy of the Receiving Report with request that the Italian Government certify the price at which such materials have been released for sale by the AMIO, or the fair value thereof, in the event of other disposition. Any adjustments which may be required in such Receiving Reports due to non-delivery of materials retained shall be submitted subsequently by the AMIO to the War Materials Disposal Subcommission, which will investigate, where necessary, the justification for such adjustment and transmit its findings to the Chief Accountant by Finance Subcommission in the Northern Area.

1. Restoration of civil communications is still severely handicapped by lack of bronze and/or copper weld wire.
2. The Germans are reported to have used a wire similar to the US Army copper weld, but no information is available as to whether any stocks of such wire were found in the German Signal Store.
3. It would be appreciated if this Sub-Commission could be advised as to the availability of any such wire for release or sale to the Italian PT Administration.
4. Failing availability of wire from German stores, could any copper weld wire, & sleeves be made available from US Army stocks?
5. It is appreciated that the Signal Section has been very generous in releases of wire, and that any further release may be difficult to arrange. Unfortunately there are no sources of supply at present available to the Italian PT Administration, and civilian communications cannot be restored in the desired amount due to this shortage of wire. It is therefore hoped that it will be possible to arrange for release, either from captured German stocks or surplus Allied stocks.

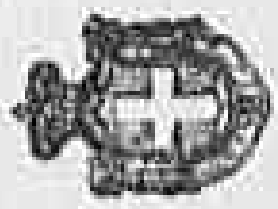

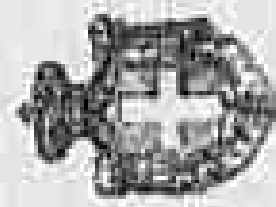

2. The matter has been referred to Major Hawker who does not appear to have received the letters.

3. The following points are mentioned in connection with your references to Rome-Naples route.

(a) Your letters of 7th May and 21st June, refer to the placing of three telegraph wires on the routes whereas your letter of 27th June refers to two loops in bronze.

(b) The sale of the Minturno-Sparanise line was postponed as unsuspected demands required its use again by the Allies.

(c) As has been stated before, a request for the placing of wires on military poles should be accompanied by accurate diagrams of the sections of route concerned showing where you wish the wires to be placed.

(d) Major Hawker will discuss the matter with your representatives, and will raise again with CSO L of C the question of the possibility of using the Minturno-Sparanise section for civil purposes.

There are some details raised in your letter which will be taken up separately but there is one point of major importance which has been brought to your attention on several occasions: i.e. the urgent necessity of increasing facilities between Rome and Florence. This will, according to all indications, remain a bottle-neck for some time to come and military facilities will not be available for civilian use.

3. It is therefore strongly recommended that the 60 tons of wire mentioned in para. 3 of your letter be used to provide additional circuits between Rome and Florence rather than Rome-Ancona. For the Rome - Ancona service it appears that some military facilities will become available before the surveys etc. mentioned by you could be completed. For Florence - Rome the delays inherent to surveys etc. do not exist and by application of carrier equipment a total of 8 telephone circuits between Rome and Florence could easily be made available.

4. It is very doubtful that any additional quantities of wire can be made available from Allied Sources so that not only must economy in use of present stocks be exercised but a strong drive to recover wire not in use must be made.

With reference to your T.14.8.CS of the 21st inst., we beg to point out that we are arranging all that is necessary for the realization of the following connections, using the quantity of 3 mm. bronze wire recently sold to us by the Allies:-

1. Laying of two loops in bronze between Rome and Naples. For this connection we have foreseen the use of lines belonging to the telegraph and railway Administrations, and of lines used by the Allies apart from the Minturno-Sparanise line offered for sale, as per your letter T.14B.29.CS. of the 5th April last and, later, revoked with your letter T.14B.48.CS of the 23rd May last.

The beginning of the work now depends, therefore, on the reply to our letters Nos. 603227/2200 of the 7th May last and 604004/2200 of the 21st ult. of which we are enclosing copies, and by the possibility of substituting the abovementioned Minturno-Sparanise line.

For the laying of the two loops in question, the use of 60 tons of bronze if foreseen, should we renounce to the Minturno-Sparanise line.

2. Laying of a second loop in 3 mm. bronze wire between Chiusi and Florence in continuation with the Rome -Chiusi loop which will shortly be completed. For the laying of this second loop, using the bronze wire already in possession of the Circolo of Florence, only 10 tons of bronze wire, to be withdrawn from Naples, will be necessary. Instructions have already been issued for the transport of the material to Florence by rail.
3. Laying of two loops in 3 mm. bronze wire between Rome and Ancona (about 60 tons of wire are necessary). The necessary surveys will be made as soon as we will have the necessary transport means; for this purpose we have already interested the Circolo of Ancona.

It must, however, be borne in mind that only a few weeks have lapsed since the said Circolo passed under the jurisdiction of the Italian Government.

Further, it will be necessary to obtain the authorization of the Allies to place the loops in question on many stretches of the polification occupied by the Allies.

For the work as per paras 1) and 3), the despatch of 50 tons of 3 mm. bronze wire from Naples to Rome by rail has already been arranged.

Summing up, to be able to complete the above work within a few

months, about 130 tons of wire will be required, whilst at Naples only 9 1/4 tons were delivered.

We have no doubt that you, as usual, will arrange that we be placed in position to have the necessary material made available to complete the two loops on the three very important Rome-Naples, Rome-Florence and Rome-Ancona arteries, and that we shall be allowed, where absolutely necessary, to place wires on the pole stretches used by the Allies.

In particular, for the Rome-Naples artery, we kindly request that you re-examine the possibility that the, many times mentioned, Minturno-Sparanise line be sold to this Ministry which would enable us to save a noteworthy quantity of bronze wire for the Rome-Naples line and to establish many important communications in the Minturno-Sparanise area so much tried by the war.

We shall await your kind reply.

It is the intention of this Ministry to re-activate with direct and "omnibus" wires the telegraph-telephone line Rome-Pavona, Velletri-Cori-Terracina - Sparanise - Napoli using, as far as possible, the line constructed by the Allies between Sparanise and Minturno and now offered for sale to the Italian Government, as per letter T.143.29.CS of the 5th April 1945 of the Communications Sub-Commission.

Now, ^{while} as the direct wires of the ^{any longer} Calcevia-Fossanova-Minturno stretch (where this Administration does not possess a polification) could be placed on a railway polification in concrete, two "omnibus" telegraph wires for Terracina on the 17 Km. Fossanova-Terracina stretch could only be placed on the railway polification re-activated and used by the Allied Military Commands.

As that would be very useful for the civil requirements, as it would enable the connection of important agricultural centres as Piperno, Sezze and Sonnino with Terracina (already connected with the Provincial Capital Town of Littoria), we do not doubt that you will, as usual, do all in your power to obtain from the competent Military Commands the authorization to place on the Allied lines the wires abovementioned.

With our letter No. 603227/2200 of the 7th May last, whilst we informed you of our intention to re-activate the telegraph and telephone polification Rome- Velletri- Cori - Terracina - Nepoli, we requested the authorization to be allowed to lay from Fossanova to Terracina (about 17 kms.) three "omnibus" telegraph circuits on the polification used by the Allied Commands.

Now, by inspections carried out for making up the surveys, it results that also for another 10 kms. and, precisely, from Km. 63 to Km. 73, near Sezze, our polification, outside of the railway polification, has been used for Allied wires. It would, therefore, now be necessary that you grant us authorization to lay the three above wires also along this stretch, naturally, below the military lines, assuring you that the work would be done with the utmost care so as to avoid any interference to the Allied communications.

We shall await your kind prompt reply.
