1. Paraffin wax is essential for telecommunications work as an insulating material.

2. The S.E.T., operates and maintains, and is at present rehabilitating all telephone exchanges from Naples Southwards including Sicily, and the demand for this Company is considered to be too small.

3. The firm of Armando Ventrella is a very much smaller firm doing essential work in Naples, and its demand is too great.

4. The demands should therefore be adjusted as follows and these may be considered as essential.

- a. S.E.T. 60 Kgs.
- b. Armando Ventrella: 20 Kgs.

1) - I agree with you on the instructions of para 1) of the above mentioned letter, concerning supervision on the use of such material. But, as I have already verbally pointed out, I think opportune to change the relative distribution of material as follows:

SET Kgs. 60
Ditta Ventrella Kgs. 20

2) - Ditta Ventrella in fact is charged with the maintenance of the installation of the aerial alarm network (sirens and relative ganged controls) in Naples City. Therefore the said Ditta has not right of precedence, in respect of the SET.

3) - Instructions on the matter are being issued from the Inspectorate of the Naples Telephone Agency.

To: Under-Secretary of State for PP.TT.

1. Demands for controlled paraffin wax have been received from the S.E.T. and from Sig. Armando Ventrella, Naples. This material commands fabulous prices on the black market and it is therefore essential,

- a. that only bare requirements be supplied
- b. that the work being done is essential to the war effort and
2. that a very close watch will be maintained on its use after supply to the firms concerned.

2. The use of the wax is stated by the firms to be as follows:

- a. Armando Ventrella: 50 Kgs for insulating union fittings for about 100 pairs of telephone cable joints, and to replace other insulating materials not available on the open market.
- b. S.E.T.: 30 Kgs for same purpose and for telephone cable distribution boxes.

3. The demand of the S.E.T. is probably justified but your opinion is requested on the demand in para 2(a) above. For whom is the work done, for instance.
