R o m eTo the kind attention of Major HawkerSupply of fuel oil.

We beg to inform you that due to the unsuitable conditions of the electric power supply still prevailing in Rome we are compelled to keep in operation the motor generators installed at Torrenova, Malnome and Rome.

Therefore we feel indebted to you and to the R.A.A.C. for every assistance given us in order we never run short of fuel.

Owing to the difficulties met by R.A.A.C. to supply us with the weekly 375 gallons needed for the immediate consumption, last December, we asked the Camera di Commercio di Roma to furnish us with 4400 litres of fuel oil and 80 Kgs. of lubricating oil for each one of the Torrenova motor generators.

We have recently got 4000 litres of fuel oil and 72 Kgs. of lubricating oil. Now we are asking to have the same quantities for this month, and we shall be obliged if you will put your visa on the enclosed forms which then shall forward to the Camera di Commercio.

Owing to the services dealt by us for or in the interest of the Allied Command or troops, we take the liberty of asking for your kind intervention in order to get a formal assurance from the Italian authorities stating we will be authorized to receive the following quantities of fuel oil, lubricating oil and paraffine (benzine) :

-fuel oil 1500 gallons per month
-lubricating oil 120 Kgs " "
-paraffine 20 gallons " "

and that, up to these quantities, we will be granted of their disposal.

Hoping to have succeed in making the matter clear, and thanking in advance, we remain, yours sincerely.

1. Reference is made to the meeting held Dec. 13th, 1945 in which has been discussed the extension of radio telephone service Rome - U.S.A. for use by members of U.S. forces in Livorno and Udine.

At this meeting, a supply of fuel oil for operation of emergency power unit due to unsuitable voltage of the electric power plant in Rome, was assigned to Italcable.

2. The Signal Officer, R.A.A.C., through the kind intervention of Captain Ramsay, has already provided us with 75 gallons of fuel which has been transported to our Torrenova transmitting station.

3. Taking into account that the power plant installed at Torrenova must be kept into operation for, at least, 12 hours per day, a fuel consumption of 375 gallons per week is foreseen.

4. You will oblige if you could assure us that this provision of fuel will be guaranteed as long as it is needed. 488

5. A kind reply at your earliest convenience will be appreciated.

La situazione attuale del riscaldamento delle installazioni telefoniche che situate nel territorio amministrato dagli italiani é la seguente:

- 1) Per l'Italia centro meridionale ed insulare si sta provvedendo con la lignite messa a disposizione dal Ministero dell'Industria e Commercio.
- 2) Per la centrale telefonica di Roma - dove occorre necessariamente del carbone per lo speciale impianto delle caldaie - il Ministero dell'Industria e del Commercio ha disposto una perizia al fine di accertarsi se effettivamente le predette caldaie funzionino esclusivamente col carbone; dopo di che assegnerà il carbone o la lignite a seconda del risultato della perizia.

Per la centrale di Roma occorrono 170 tonnellate di carbone: tale fornitura é assolutamente urgente essendo terminate le assai scarse rimanenze dell'assegnazione della scorsa stagione invernale.

Comunque con lettera n° 962155/87 del 21 corr. é stato interessato il Ministero dell'Industria e del Commercio a fornire il carbone per l'alimentazione delle caldaie dell'Ufficio Interurbano di Roma in seguito alla lettera del O.C. ROME FAULT CONTROL qui trasmessa il 14 corrente.

1. It is of the utmost importance that sufficient heat be available to protect telephone and telegraph installations from the lasting and damaging effects of dampness, during the coming winter.
2. It is not a question of supplying heating for entire buildings, but only the bare minimum to keep dry those rooms containing telephone & telegraph equipment.
3. To this end, if you have not already done so, you should immediately insure that Telephone Companies, Azienda di Stato and Telegraph Administration make a survey of their premises in order to determine what heating should be supplied.
4. You are fully aware that every pound of coal is vitally needed for industrial purposes and only the barest minimum can be made available for heating. It is therefore necessary that heating by coal be used only as a last resort and that wood, coke and electricity be utilized to the fullest extent. This may result in increased expense, but expense is secondary to conservation of coal.
5. When the survey referred to in para 3 is being made an inspection of all doors and window openings should be made with a view to insuring that heat leakage is reduced to the minimum.
6. When the needs of coke, wood and coal have been determined and you have assured yourself as far as possible that such requirements cover only what fuel is necessary to protect installations you should submit estimates to the Regional Officer involved or appropriate Italian Agency. Copies of requirements submitted are to be sent to this S/C.
