TO: All Concerned.

1. Letter, this headquarters, file and subject as above, dated 4 September 1945, is rescinded. Either the full designation of a unit or an authorized abbreviation, as listed below, will be used in headings and texts of messages to be transmitted by electrical means.

2. Reference is made to AFHQ Signal Instructions, Item 2, Section V, subject: "Submarine Cable Communications", for listing of authorized telegraphic addresses. Distinction is necessary between a telegraphic address and an authorized abbreviation.

a. A telegraphic address is a short meaningless word, coupled with the office location (e.g. TROOPERS, LONDON) assigned to a military, civil, diplomatic or political organization, and used for routing of traffic via commercial channels by either submarine cable, radio or landline.

b. An authorized abbreviation is used by a military organization in lieu of the full official designation, in the address or text of a message to be transmitted by electrical means, in order to eliminate unnecessary groups.

3. The list of authorized abbreviations below is not intended to include all headquarters and units in the theater. It has been instructed to those to which traffic is particularly heavy and whose designation lends itself to an intelligible abbreviation. The list must be kept short enough to permit complete familiarity by all personnel who must use it. Therefore, additions to the list will be kept to a minimum.



1. The following defined short terms are furnished for the information and guidance of all concerned.

A. PENBASE: This is the authorized short radio or TWX address for Headquarters, Peninsular Base Section, which at the present time is physically located at Leghorn.

B. PENSOUTH: This is the authorized radio or TWX address for that part of Headquarters, Peninsular Base Section located at Naples and known as Headquarters, Southern District, Peninsular Base Section.

2. These short terms will be used only in radio, TWX addresses or informal buck-slips, and will never be used to designate geographical segments of the Peninsular Base Section.

3. The entire territory of PBS will be referred to as Peninsular Base Section. PBS territory geographically located south of the Rome Area, ITOUSA, will be referred to as Southern District, P.B.S. That territory north of the Rome Area, ITOUSA, will be referred to as Peninsular Base Section less Southern District.

4. All radios, directives, and other communications will be written in accordance with the above instructions. This information will be given wide distribution.



2. Reference is made to AFHQ Signal Instructions, Item 2, Section V, subject: "Submarine Cable Communications", for listing of authorized telegraphic addresses. A telegraphic address is a short meaningless word assigned currently to a civil, diplomatic, or political agency only, for use in routing traffic via commercial communication channels; whereas an authorized abbreviation is used by a military organization in lieu of the full official designation in the text of a message or in the heading when routing is in plain language by secure signal channels.

3. The list of authorized abbreviations below is not intended to include all headquarters and units in the theater. It has been restricted to those to which traffic is particularly heavy and whose designation lends itself to an intelligible abbreviation. The list must be kept short enough to permit complete familiarity by all personnel who must use it. Therefore, additions to the list will be kept to the minimum.



1. The following is extracted from War Department letter, Adjutant General's Office, file AGOB-F 311.5, SUBJECT: War Department Code Names and Abbreviations, dated 13 March 1944, for the information and guidance of all concerned:

- a. Government agencies in the United States have contacted the War Department for information concerning alphabetical abbreviations used in communications and other official documents emanating from overseas theaters. In the majority of these instances it has been found that these abbreviations were not authorized by Army Regulations.
- b. 

SUBJECT: Identification Symbols.

TO : Commander in Chief, Allied Armies in Italy.

1. This is in reply to the attached letter from the Signal Officer of your headquarters. Five letter correspondence symbols are allotted by the War Department to those headquarters who have authority to correspond directly with the War Department. Although these symbols have some value to headquarters receiving messages in that they enable a headquarters to identify the staff section which originated the message, the principal value is to enable a headquarters receiving a message which is in reply to another to promptly transmit it to the interested staff section.

2. Many headquarters who have authority to correspond directly with the War Department have found other methods more expedient. For example, it is now customary to number all outgoing messages serially. In replying to a message which has a serial number, it is customary to bury in the reply a reference to that serial number, i.e., "reur 1234, dated February 23". When such a message is received the message center refers to message number 1234 of February 23 and routes the reply to the officer or staff section who originated it. Such systems cause the use of correspondence symbols to be unnecessary.

3. If after considering the statements contained in the preceding paragraphs it is still desired by Headquarters, Allied Control Commission that correspondence symbols be assigned, it is suggested that the request be resubmitted. A list should be submitted of the various staff sections and subdivisions of the office to which the allotment of symbols is desired. A recommendation for the symbol to be assigned each should be included. Please note the attached copy of Staff Memorandum No. 28.


