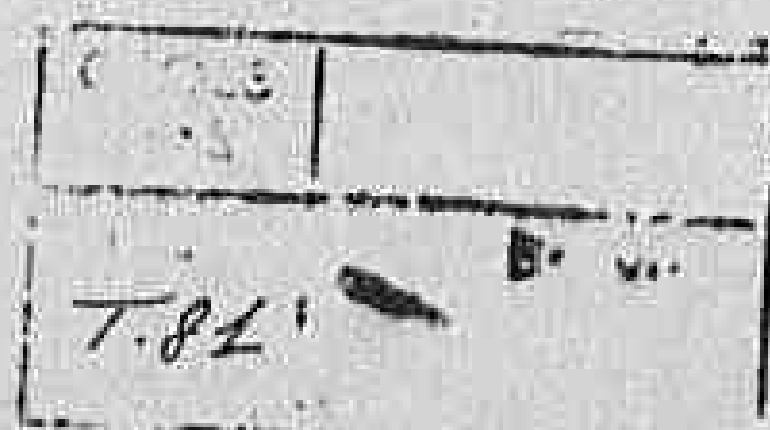

SUBJECT: 50 Line Telephone Switchboard

TO : S-4 2675th Regiment.

1. The Allied Commission has a 50 line, local battery, manually operated, telephone switchboard with 50 local battery telephone that has never been used, except for 10 of the telephones.

2. This equipment was purchased from the Naples telephone company in July 1944 and paid for in September 1944. When the Allied Commission moved to Rome, the equipment was stored in the telephone store rooms of the annex where it is now located in the original packages.

3. This Commission does not need the equipment. The Signal Section, Allied Force Headquarters, can use the equipment in a telephone operators school at Caserta.

It is my recommendation this equipment be shipped to S-4 Signal Section, Allied Force Headquarters. If you agree, it is requested that the necessary shipping documents be prepared. Mr. Tavalato, in the telephone office, can furnish the detailed information for inclusion in the shipping documents.

a. The purchase was made by the 6663 Signal Co. from SET, which firm reports the bill was paid 18 September 1944.

2. The switchboard and 40 of the telephones have never used. The equipment has been in storage in the Allied Commission building in Rome.

3. This equipment is not needed by the Allied Commission. SET would like to get it back for use in its commercial system.

4. It is requested that information be supplied this office as to the disposition that should be made with the equipment.

With reference to your verbal request, bellow is our best offer:

An automatic telephone exchange system PS - 24 Volt with intermediary switchboard at bicords for the sorting of urban communications, furnished for the connection with 90 users and 10 urban lines.

What we actually offer is:

1. 1 Autoswitch as for system with preselectors with tension of 24 Volt, type 100 numbers, now equiped for:
 - 100 numbers, out of which 90 are reserved for users and 10 lines for recalling of the urban lines.
 - 14 final selectors constituted by:
 - 2 Rackets of preselectors and final selectors, each of a capacity of 50 preselectors and furnished of 7 final selectors
 - 10 Panels of preselectors, each furnished with
 - 10 preselectors with their relative relé for users to be mounted on the rackets.
 - 14 Final selectors, with their totality of relé, to be mounted on the rackets.
2. 1 Intermediary exchange bicord system, type to be supported on the floor, in a black metal case, for the sorting of in coming urban calls through bicords. The circuits of the urban lines connected to the switchboard are so disposed of, that the authorized users can effectuate the connection of recalling during urban communications.

The intermediary exchange, now in a working place, permits any further amplification on urban lines as well as on branching lines and on working positions, and is furnished for following equipment:

 - 10 Urban lines
 - 100 Authorized user branchings
 - 3 Booking lines
 - 10 Bicords for sorting of in coming urban calls
 - 1 Circuit for the operator.

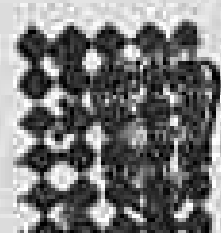

1. The method of settlement with the firm of F.A.C.E. for the two switchboards originally ordered to fulfill military requirements has again been discussed with CSO L of C ITALY and with the Financial Advisor AFHQ in the light of your letter.
2. CSO L of C ITALY has confirmed that there is no longer any military requirement for these boards. Consequently no further expenditure is permitted from Army funds and work has ceased.
3. There are two alternative courses of action:-
 - (a) For a payment to be made to cover expenses so far incurred, in which case the boards, although very near completion, would not be finished. It should be noted that since the bulk of the charge is in lire any payment made through British financial channels must ultimately be redeemed by the ITALIAN Government.
 - (b) The ITALIAN Government should now take over the switchboards and arrange with F.A.C.E. for their completion and for payment to be made in due course.
4. The sterling charges involved are estimated at no more than £600 and the firm has indicated that no further items of WD supply would be required to complete the work. It is therefore emphasized that no advantages would accrue to the ITALIAN Government even if the Allies were to go ahead and pay for the whole work as you suggested.
5. In fact owing to the inability of the firm to estimate the cost of work involved no formal contract has been placed.
6. In view of the indication in your letter that the ITALIAN Government has need of the two boards it is suggested that you reconsider the position in conjunction with your Chief Accountant with a view to recommending the Government to take them over at this stage.

1. It would be a difficult matter to persuade the Italian Government now to take over the Contract, and it is rather unlikely that it would do so.

2. It would appear also that a contract having been made by the Allies with F.A.C.E., the Allies are bound to make the payment. The fact that the boards are not now needed for military purposes does not seem to have any direct bearing on the question of initial responsibility for payment.

3. The solution would appear to lie in payment by the Allies for work done, and resale to the Italian Government.

4. It is felt that the Italian Government would be more ready to take over completed switchboards and to pay a reasonable figure for them than they would be for switchboards in an incomplete condition.

5. It is recommended therefore that the boards be completed, the amount paid in full by the Allies and the boards resold to the Italian Government.

6. This Commission would be glad to undertake negotiations for the sale.

1. A first instalment of 500,000 Lire to the firm of FACH is considered fair and reasonable, in respect of the two switchboards rehabilitated for military use. The total cost of the switchboards will be considerably in excess of this figure, but it is not possible at this stage, to give even a rough estimate, as the final cost will depend considerably on the cost of certain materials purchased by FACH, which cannot at present be assessed.
2. Confirming conversation between Brigadier Buchanan, Lt-Col Jenkins, Lt-Col Scudder and Major Taylor. It is desired that FACH should complete the switchboards in accordance with the specifications and experiments issued by this office.
3. On completion of the switchboards, the question of their being purchased by the Italian State will be taken up through A.C. channels.
4. All materials required for the completion of the switchboards, are available in MILAN from civilian sources. No further issues of military supplies will be made to FACH.

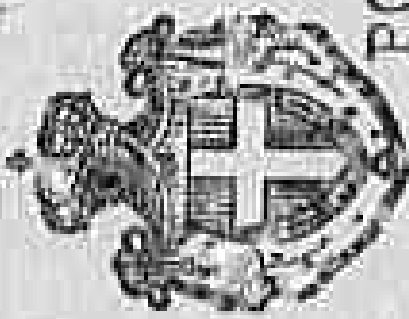

1. Reference is made to letter (T.81.CS) of 4 December 1944 from Communications Sub-Commission to Finance Sub-Commission, Allied Commission, on above subject, copy of which was sent to this Section.

2. A conference on the subject was held on this date at the call of the Signal Supply Officer with representatives of the following sections of AFHQ-MTOUSA present: Signal Section, G-4, G-5, Fiscal Director.

3. Agreement was reached that the switchboards required for essential civil communications in various cities in Northern Italy should be manufactured under contracts between the Italian Government and FATME, with the Allied Military authorities furnishing through the Allied Commission such assistance as may be necessary to assure the manufacture of the civil switchboards.

4. A formal communication in the above sense may be anticipated from this Headquarters in the near future.

5. It was explained by the Signal Section officials that the Army has no direct interest in the production of these boards, and is therefore entirely unwilling to contract for their manufacture. This position seems to us to be logical. The component parts of the civil switchboards which cannot be obtained by the manufacturer (estimated by the Signal Section at not more than 20 percent of total material needed), will be provided to the AC on the usual requisition, and would be turned over by the AC to the Italian Government for supply to the manufacturer. This conforms to the existing procedure, and will result in the usual report to the Chief Accountant, AC, by copy of issue voucher.

6. As to the switchboards destined for military operational use, the Army will sign a contract with the manufacturer without reference to the Italian Government.

7. It would probably be preferable, in this and in other instances of major procurement, for the Army to rely on the Italian Government to arrange manufacture, issuing to the Government the components unobtainable in Italy. However, you are well aware that little progress has been made in perfecting the procurement services of the Italian Government and in this instance the Signal Section considers it essential to make its own arrangements with the manufacturer for such production as is of direct military concern.

8. Renewed consideration is being given here to the question of the ultimate disposal to the Italian Government of installations such as those mentioned in para 6 above. We will communicate with you on this subject later; it is not immediately related to the subject at hand.

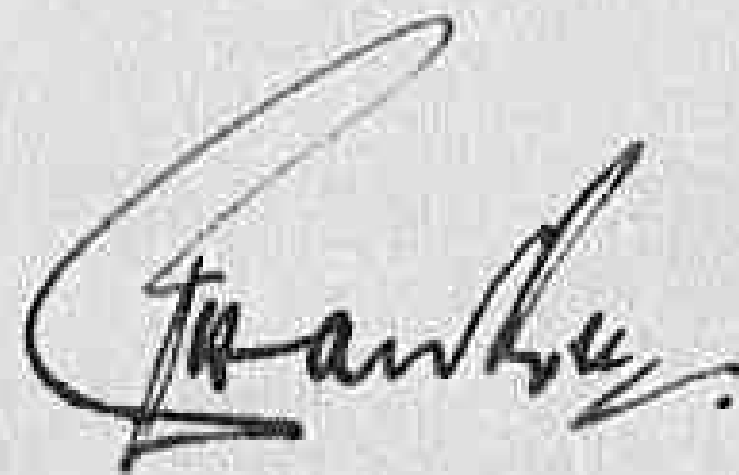
