- 1.- The attached memo WMD/51 policy/12 has just come to my attention, having been issued during my absence from HQ's.
- 2.- This Sub-Commission disagrees with the policy outlined in as far as it effects items peculiar to telecommunications.
- 3.- All bids for salvage submitted by this Sub-Commission are made on behalf of the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications and no bids are submitted on behalf of private concerns.
- 4.- When bids are submitted it means that the items bid for are of extreme need to restoration of telecommunications, and allocation of such items to the Ministry of Industry and Commerce, bidding on behalf of private concerns (in some cases reported to be scrap dealers, who stand to make large profits from purchase of such items) is not believed to be in the best interests of restoration of Italian commerce and industry.
- 5.- Ordinarily the time between publication of lists and closing of bids is too short to permit the lists to be examined by the Ministry of P. and T. and then put thru' the ministerial machinery of the Ministry of Industry and Commerce.
- 6.- It is therefore requested that no preference be given to bids from the Ministry of Industry and Commerce over those submitted by this Sub-Commission on behalf of the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications.
