27 February 1946REQUISITIONING OF SIGNAL SUPPLIES

1. Effective 1 March 1946 the requisition of Signal Supplies and equipment will be in accordance with the procedure set forth herein.
2. Requisitions will be made out to Signal Officer, Rome Area, MTOUSA, and must in all cases bear the signature of the initiating unit commander.
3. Requisitions must be complete in every detail showing basis, authority, amount on hand, due out and etc.
4. All units or organizations having detachments throughout the Rome Area will submit consolidated requisitions and draw supplies for all such detachments.
5. Requisitions will be submitted twice monthly so as to reach the Signal Officer by 1700 hours on the 1st and 14th of each month. After being edited and approved by the Signal Officer requisitions will be forwarded to 3197 Signal Service Company for consolidation and drawing of supplies from the Signal Base Depot.
6. 3197 Signal Service Company will notify units concerned when requisitioned supplies have been received and are available for issue.
7. No unit will requisition and draw supplies direct from Signal Base Depot unless authorized to do so by the Signal Officer, Rome Area, MTOUSA.
8. In cases of emergency requisitions may be hand carried, through the Signal Office for approval, to Supply Officer, 3197 Signal Service Company for issue.
