1. Refer to your letter 5 Oct. 1943.
2. There is available for immediate ~~shipment~~ from Campofranco about 3,000 tons of sulphur. Cars will be loaded by shippers and unloaded at destination by Consorzio per i Magazzini Generale della Sicilia. Shipments are at present scheduled for Porto Empedocle, but it is thought that by the time you get trains running on this line, arrangements may have been completed to receive shipments at Termini Imerese.
3. Some tonnage of rock salt will be ready to move shortly, probably to Palermo.
4. It will be required to move 4 to 6 tank cars of water per week from Cammarata to Campofranco.

SCHM. 2. ANGOT CONTROL OF CIVILIAN TRAFFICTRAFFIC BY RAIL IN SICILY.OBJECT.

To suggest a system by which civilian freight on Railways could be controlled, in two phases:-

- (a) Phase I - Concurrently with the carrying of British (and American) military traffic.
- (b) Phase II - After Military despatches have dropped much below the capacity of the line.

PROBLEM. In both cases; the railway capacity is likely to be less than civilian demands. Some authority, therefore, must control the acceptance of traffic in accordance with the best interests of the civilian population.

This authority must be government i.e. in this case, ANGOT. As ANGOT is short of staff, the system of control must be as nearly automatic as possible.

SCHM.

1. (a) traffic should be accepted under one of three priorities:-

- (a) Essential traffic
- (b) Ordinary traffic
- (c) Luxury traffic

2. Books of Forms of Authorisation should be printed, of a distinctive colour for each priority. The forms should be numbered in series in each book, three forms to each number, so that they can be filled in triplicate; the number of series should also be continuous from book to book.

3. A specimen form for essential traffic would be on the following lines:-

Serial 5.

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This authority must be government I.O. In this case, ANGOT. As ANGOT is short of staff, the system of control must be as nearly automatic as possible.

Scheme.

1. All traffic should be accepted under one of three priorities:-

- (a) Essential Traffic
- (b) Ordinary Traffic
- (c) Luxury Traffic

2. Books of forms of authorisation should be printed, of a distinctive colour for each priority. The forms should be numbered in series in each book, three forms to each number, so that they can be filled in triplicate; the number of series should also be continuous from book to book.

4. The third copy of each form will remain in the book at
H.Q. ANGOT.

The first and second copies would be completed by the
Station Master and Consigner at the station. The Station Master
would retain one copy, the Consigner would retain the other, and
report with it to H.Q. ANGOT, so that date of despatch could be
entered from it on to the form remaining in the book.

5. Similar forms, with suitable differences in colour and to the setting, would be used for ordinary and luxury traffic.

6. The railways would be ordered to construct all station masters:

- a. That a lower priority traffic must always give way to a higher priority.
- b. that no traffic must be accepted until wagons are available (topping during at stations).

7. This system of station would be entirely separate from whatever system is used adopted by the railways for documentation and charging of traffic.

8. Military traffic would always have an overriding priority and the railways would be so instructed.

Conclusion.

This scheme would automatically ensure priority for essential stores, and enable AMG to keep in touch because:-

- a. traders holding "essential" authorisations could para 4 above, would constitute a complete record of destinations.
- b. be relieved upon to complain to AMG in case of difficulties.
- c. the books of forms L. 16001 H.C. kept up to date with particulars of despatched or expedited in
