1. RAJUBA Repeater Station has been captured intact. Internal maintenance personnel are available and the U.S. cable maintenance detachment normally responsible for the whole of the PALERMO - CATANIA - MESSINA cable is prepared to work for the British Military Authority.

2. You will therefore send a small line party (I suggest an N.C.O. with some experience of U.S. cables with 2 or 3 line-men) to safeguard the Repeater Station and to direct and supervise the work of the civilian employees with cable repairs. The N.C.O. i/c will keep close touch with O.S.O., 30 Corps, who will advise him regarding the tactical situation.

3. First priority requirement is communication via the cable from RAJUBA to CANTALISSETTA, and, if necessary, beyond to provide lateral communications between 30 Corps and U.S. Forces.

4. Second priority requirement is repair Eastward from RAJUBA as far as the tactical situation permits.

5. Please arrange for the nine civilian employees to be placed on the ration strength of your line party. Arrangements for pay will be made later with A.M.S.C.F.

7. A maintenance truck is stationed at the Reporter Station, but this has been immobilized by the enemy, and until certain small repairs can be effected it will be necessary to use M.D. transport.

8. Please arrange for progress reports to be submitted daily to my Staff Officer (Lines).

9. Will C.S.C., 7 Army kindly allow civilians mentioned in para 5 to work on the cable in his area, as far as CALTALUSSETTA.

As the whole of the civilian personnel connected with this U.S. cable are living together at MADUSA it is suggested that C.S.C., 7 Army should arrange with me for any calls which he may wish to make on their services.

1. Reference attached copy of letter 17 Aug 43 from Italoable, original of which was directed to you.
2. Italoable is a privately owned communication Company having interest throughout various parts of the Island of Sicily.
3. In order to preserve the operating organization and property for future civilian communication use, it is essential that all records, not of military value, be turned over to Company officials. Such action will permit officials to form an organization capable of operating their lines and equipment when the military situation permits turning same back to them.
4. Since this is a private Company, all funds taken and held for safe keeping should be returned to them.
5. It is requested that report be made with respect to action taken in this matter.
