1. Under the provisions of WX/86356 and 87510, all cargo arriving in Italy after 30 November 1945 under the MGS (TOG) type requisition will be the property of the Army, and, as such, will be handled by the Army.

on Imported Civilian Supplies.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394.
(Attn: Transportation Sub-Commission).

1. Reference is Allied Commission letter 10/A/Tn/1 of 1 November, 1945.

2. This report indicates that no imported civilian supplies were received from either US or UK during October against the Military Supply Programme (TOG) as all shipments are credited against the YB and YT programmes.

3. AFHQ letter AG 400.38/021 GEG-0 of 9 September notified Allied Commission that the combined military civilian supply programme was to terminate with August loadings. However, it is the understanding of this Section that some supplies have continued to arrive against the military programme, although in diminishing quantities.

4. For example, it is believed that among others both the ZEBULON PIKE, HR 865 and the EXCELLER, HR 926 carried supplies against the military civilian supply programme, with the usual TOG markings, and that the shipping papers were not marked YB.

5. Will you please confirm that in fact no supplies against the military programme were received in Italy from either US or UK during the month of October.
