1. Cable, Hqs. Piemonte Region, protesting Major Buckley's transfer to Transportation Sub-Commission has been received.

2. Transportation Sub-Commission has been authorized five engineering officers for railway work, and only two officers are available. Military Priority 1, Construction Work, requires immediate action which is not possible with limited personnel. It is the considered opinion of Transportation Sub-Commission that Major Buckley is fully qualified for this work.

3. A temporary assignment or attachment for temporary duty subject to recall on 48 hours notice would not be acceptable to Transportation Sub-Commission. It would not be practicable to have an officer withdrawn during construction of important military character without a qualified replacement being available.

4. Transportation Sub-Commission requests that necessary action be taken to effect Major Buckley's transfer to Transportation Sub-Commission or that an equally qualified railway engineer be made immediately available. Unless this be done it will be necessary to advise DARS that Transportation Sub-Commission cannot fulfil its agreed to responsibilities.

Instructions for the Compilation or Revision of A.F.'s B.199A.

(To be read in conjunction with Pamphlet A.F. B. 199B/1A)

TO ALL OFFICERS

ALL officers, on being commissioned complete A.F. B199A (Officers Record of Service) in duplicate. It may not be generally known to what purpose these forms are put once they are completed. The object of these notes is to tell officers what this purpose is, and to assist them in the compilation by indicating, in a general way, what information is required.

As to the use to which these forms are put. One copy goes direct to the respective personnel branches at the War Office and, from Part II Orders issued in this Theatre of War, a complete chronological history of the officer's movements, promotions and appointments, is compiled.

Army Form B199A was originally designed for the Regular Army and later applied to the Territorial Army in peace time. Consequently, it falls short of requirements under present conditions in some aspects, and it is for this reason that Officers are being asked to go into additional detail when compiling the form.

The completeness of the information held at this Echelon about a particular officer may materially affect (a) his future employment and promotion, (b) his suitability for special employment and (c) THE PRIORITY OF HIS RELEASE FROM SERVICE AT THE CESSATION OF HOSTILITIES. It should be remembered that an officer may become unemployable within his own arm of the service either by reason of his having been wounded and subsequently medically down-graded, or upon receiving special Confidential Report recommending a change of employment. The A.F. B199A is frequently the only source of information upon which this H.Q. can accurately assess the officer's suitability for alternative employment. It will be clear, therefore, that it is of the utmost importance that ALL questions on the A.F. B199A should be answered fully and with intelligence.

The following notes are intended as a guide to the officer making out his A.F. B199A for the first time, or revising it at the request of G.H.Q. 2nd Echelon.

PARA 1. *Religious Persuasion.*—This will not merely show whether Christian or Jew, but will show exact denomination, i.e., C. of E., R.C., Methodist, Presbyterian, etc.

PARAS 1, 2 and 3. ALL names and addresses should be written in BLOCK caps. Mistakes in an address due to bad or indifferent handwriting can have the most serious consequences. This may occur, for example, when this H.Q. has any communication with an officer's next of kin.

PARA 6c. *Business Qualifications.*—Few officers do complete justice to themselves in answering this question. Any experience attained by an officer prior to his enlistment should be recorded in detail. For example, it is not sufficient for a professional accountant to state merely "Accountant." It is required to know the type of accountancy; whether "Chartered," "Cost" or "Municipal" Accountant, and whether he is employed or whether practicing on his own account. If the latter, the number of years of such practice must be stated.

An officer may have changed his employment and yet still retain a business qualification from his former employment. The fact should certainly be recorded, and an indication given as to the interval which has lapsed between the change of employment and the date of his joining the Army.

PARA 6f. *Special Knowledge or Experience not Included in paras. (a) to (e).*—This is the one question which few officers answer satisfactorily. It should include any information which, although apparently irrelevant at the time, might, under certain circumstances, be of value as regards the posting or placing of an officer. No restriction is placed on the facts which may be included under this heading. An officer's interest, hobbies, pastimes, however seemingly unimportant, should be stated. The fact that he has captained his XI or XV at school or university, that he has formed a Dance Band, is a Church Organist, has interested himself in his home town Debating Society, to mention just a few interests, are of the utmost importance, because they help to give a more or less reliable pen picture of an officer.

Any knowledge of local Town, County, or Rural Governmental Organization is worth recording, as such experience might well prove of use in many employments in the Army.

1. Effective 1 October 1944, the following procedure will govern the transmission of American Red Cross messages through official Signal channels.
2. Under authority contained in AR 650-75, the American Red Cross will transmit messages for any United States officer or enlisted man who desires information relating to family matters of an urgent nature.
3. The message must:
 - (a) Relate solely to family or urgent business matters.
 - (b) Not exceed twenty-five plain English words.
 - (c) Include individuals first and last name, serial number, unit and APO number.
 - (d) Include name and address within the continental limits of the United States for Red Cross to make delivery or inquiry.
 - (e) Not contain terms of endearment, congratulations, greetings, etc. 1123
 - (f) Except as indicated in c, above, will not contain any reference to any unit, headquarters, or any location in the command.
 - (g) Be approved, censored and authenticated by the writer's immediate commanding officer, who will indicate these actions over his signature on the message.
4. One of the following systems will be used:
 - (a) The individual may contact the nearest Red Cross representative who will obtain the necessary facts and transmit them by most expeditious means to the nearest Red Cross Regional Office.
 - (b) When no Red Cross representative is available, the organization commander will transmit facts to the nearest Red Cross Regional Office.
 - (c) Any United States officer or enlisted man may file a message in duplicate at any Army message center addressed to the American Red Cross (AMCROSS). Message centers will transmit such messages to the nearest Red Cross Regional Office.
5. The Red Cross will transmit information received in answer to inquiries by most expeditious means to the individual concerned.

RESTRICTED

6. The Red Cross will refuse to accept or forward messages which do not conform to the requirements of paragraph 3, above.

7. Procedure for handling AMCROSS traffic:

(a) Sealed envelope addressed to AMCROSS.

- i. It will normally be transmitted by next scheduled motor or airplane messenger to the nearest American Red Cross Regional Office.
- ii. It will show a return address of the unit filing the message, or the individual's name, serial number and APO address.

(b) Messages filed in duplicate at a message center.

- i. The original message normally will be handled as in paragraph 4 a, or it may be transmitted in clear over Signal Corps wire telegraph channels available to the nearest Red Cross Regional Office. Precedence below all official traffic will be accorded these messages. The duplicate copy is retained and handled as in normal message center procedure.

8. The American Red Cross Regional Office will prepare a consolidated message, omitting unit designations, of approximately 1000 words, in triplicate, on the regular message form for transmission to AMCROSS, Washington. The message will then be presented to the base censor for approval and after being censored will be filed at a message center for transmission. All three (3) copies will be given a message center number and filing time. The original will be routed via radio to WAR "in the clear" with the second copy handled as the message center file copy. The third copy will be returned to Red Cross for their file. (Reference number is optional.)
