Subject : Civilians Travelling in W.D. Transport.

Distribution below.

1. W.D.O. 345/45 specifically forbids the conveyance of civilians in vehicles owned or hired by the W.D. except when such civilians are :-

- a) Government officials or
- b) Travelling on official business directly connected with military matters
- c) Civilians employees of the W.D. or
- d) Accredited British camp-followers whether of officer status or not eg. ESEA, C/MW, SSAPA, IMCS etc.

This prohibition includes transport of civilians in W.D. transport for social purposes.

2. All civilians enumerated in para 1 travelling in vehicles owned or hired by the W.D. will be in possession of a pass as shown at Appendix 'A' to this instruction, and all other civilians so travelling will be required to sign an indemnity certificate as shown at Appendix 'B'.
3. In the case of civilians other than those enumerated in para 1 travelling in W.D. transport the drivers of such transport will be in possession of an authority as shown at Appendix 'C' to this instruction.
4. Proformas as at Appendices 'A', 'B' & 'C' may be obtained from the W.D.O. (B) on Application by Vice Presidents, Heads of Section etc. stating the number of civilians to be carried, the purpose for which transport is required, the route to be followed and that conveyance by civilian transport is generated in the circumstances impracticable.

Any abuse of this concession will result in its immediate withdrawal.

1. E.O. 345/45 specifically forbids the conveyance of civilians in vehicles owned or hired by the W.D. except when such civilians are :-

- a) Government officials or
- b) Travelling on official business directly connected with military matters
- c) Civilians employees of the W.D. or
- d) Accredited British camp-followers whether of officer status or not eg. EUSA, OWW, SSAFA, BRCS etc.

W.D. transport for social purposes.

2. All civilians enumerated in para 1 travelling in vehicles owned or hired by the W.D. will be in possession of a pass as shown at Appendix 'A' to this instruction, and all other civilians so travelling will be required to sign an indemnity certificate as shown at Appendix 'B'.

3. In the case of civilians other than those enumerated in para 1 travelling in W.D. transport the drivers of such transport will be in possession of an authority as shown at Appendix 'C' to this instruction.

4. Proforma as at Appendices 'A', 'B' & 'C' may be obtained from the W.D.O. (3) on Application by Vice Presidents, Heads of Section etc. regarding the number of civilians to be carried, the purpose for which transport is required, the route to be followed and that conveyance by civilian transport agencies is in the circumstances impracticable.

Any abuse of this concession will result in its immediate withdrawal.

Subject: Reports of Survey.

To : Commanding Officer, Each Unit, This Command.

1. Reports of survey reaching this Headquarters indicate a general lack of knowledge with respect to their initiation and preparation. The responsibility for initiation and preparation of reports of survey rests with the officer who has property responsibility for the articles which have been lost, damaged or destroyed.

2. In many cases too much time is allowed to intervene between the initiation of the report and the date the loss, damage or destruction of the property occurred. In every instance reports of survey must be prepared within 30 days after the discovery of the loss, damage or destruction of property, unless exceptional circumstances prevent. Where delay has occurred such delay will be explained by a certificate which will accompany and become an exhibit to the report of survey.

3. All parties initiating or preparing reports of survey will consult AR 35-6640, 16 April, 1946, and TM 14-904, April, 1945. The technical manual contains a complete explanation of the report of survey system and also carries a step by step explanation of the manner in which M.D.A.C.O. Form #15, Report of Survey, will be accomplished.

4. Where vehicles are the subject of reports of survey a classification of the property as "new", "good", or "fair", must be established and the valuation fixed. Attention is directed to MTOUSA Ordnance Operations Bulletin No. 8, 30 June, 1945, which sets out standards for depreciation and cost adjusting of vehicles.

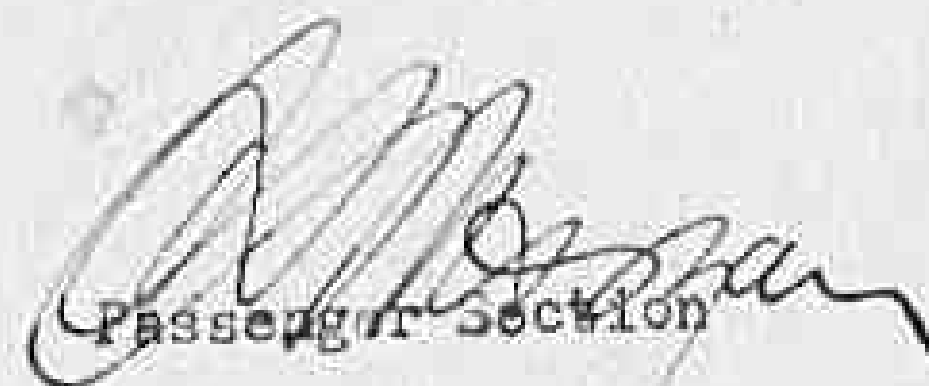

The President has approved legislation authorizing integration of qualified reserve and AUS Officers into the Regular Army.

It is directed that the following information be disseminated to all Commands under your jurisdiction and that maximum publicity be given in newspaper and news press releases. The War Department circular is being distributed.

* Pending distribution, the following is furnished: Subject: "Appointment of Officers to the Regular Army".

1. General.

- (A) Public Law No. 281 28 December 1945 authorizes the procurement of additional male Regular Army Officers to increase the commissioned strength of the Army to 25000. All appointments under this law will be made prior to 6 months subsequent to enactment.
- (B) Appointment will be made in the grades of 2nd Lieutenant, 1st Lieutenant, Captain or Major. No Officer will be appointed in a grade higher than that which he held in war time.
- (C) The grade and rank of an appointee will be determined in accordance with the amount of constructive service or actual commissioned service, whichever is the greater, with which he is credited as indicated in paragraph 3, below.
- (D) An officer appointed under the provisions of this circular who at the time of appointment is holding a temporary commission whether on active or inactive status, in a higher grade will retain such temporary commission until reduced in the general reduction program of temporary grades for other Regular Officers. Appointment in the Regular Army will NOT militate against promotion to a higher temporary grade.

2. Eligibility for appointment. Any male citizen who served on active duty as a Commissioned Officer in the Army of the United States or any component thereof at any time between 7 December 1941 and the date of enactment and was NOT separated therefrom under other than honorable conditions is eligible for appointment under the provisions of Public Law No. 281. Applicants in this category who are now Enlisted Men will be discharged for the convenience of the Government to accept Commissions in the Regular Army if selected.

3. Determination of service credit.

- (A) Constructive service credit will be given for the number of years, months and days by which the applicants age on the date of appointment exceeds 25 years.
- (B) Actual commissioned service to be credited to each applicant will be the number of years, months, and days the applicant, after attaining the age of 21 years, was on active federal service as a Commissioned Officer in the Army of the UNITED STATES or any of its components, between 7 December 1941 and the date of appointment, provided that in computing the total period of active federal service of any such person who was honorably discharged or placed in inactive status subsequent to 12 May 1945 shall be credited with service from the date of such discharge or relief from active duty to the date of appointment.

4. Determination of grade to which appointed.

- (A) The grade in which an individual will be commissioned will be determined by the amount of constructive or actual commissioned service, whichever is greater, computed as indicated in paragraph 3(A) and (B), above. Based upon this, appointments will be made in grades in the several arms and services as follows:
 - (1) Promotion list arms and services (except Adjutant General's Department and Judge Advocate General's Department). 2nd Lieut less than 3 years service, 1st Lt 3 or more but less than 13 years, Captain 10 or more but less than 17 years, Major 17 or more but less than 23 years.
 - (2) The Adjutant General's Department and Judge Advocate General's Department: (See paragraph 6(A) and (4) below) Captain 10 or more but less than 17 years, Major 17 or more but less than 23 years.
 - (3) Medical Corps, Dental Corps, Veterinary Corps, and Corps Chaplains: 1st Lieut less than 3 years service, Captain 3 or more but less than 12 years, Major 12 or more but less than 20 years.
 - (4) Pharmacy Corps; 2nd Lieut less than 3 years service, 1st Lieut 3 or more but less than 6 years, Captain 6 or more but less than 12 years, Major 12 or more but less than 20 years. Medical Administrative and Sanitary Corps Officers of the Army of the UNITED STATES may be appointed in the Pharmacy Corps under the provisions stated herein for that Corps. As this is an interim measure, special educational requirements for the Pharmacy Corps are waived.
- (B) NO person will be appointed as a Commissioned Officer of the Regular Army under the provisions of Section 4 of the Act of 28 December 1945.

- (1) In a promotion list arm or service if he would upon appointment receive credit for 23 or more years of service under section 5 of the Act, or has attained his 48th birthday.
- (2) In the Medical Corps, Dental Corps, Veterinary Corps, Pharmacy Corps or Corps of Chaplains, if upon appointment he would receive credit for 20 or more years of service, or has attained his 45th birthday.

5. Determination of rank.

- (A) An individual appointed under the provisions of Public Law No. 000 (281) (?) will rank immediately below Officers in the same grade already in the Regular Army with an equivalent or next greater length of service.
- (B) Among the newly appointed Officers in the same grade, where over 2 or more are credited with the same amount of service (see paragraph 3, above) order of rank will be determined by seniority of age. In cases of identical age, it will be determined by the greater amount of active commissioned federal service. Where both age and length of active commissioned federal service are identical, it will be determined by composite score.

6. Method of application.

- (A) Applications will be submitted so as to reach the Adjutant General's office, WASHINGTON 25, DC, NOT later than 1 March 1946. Applications must be made on WD AGO form 62, 1 November 1945. Applications received by the Adjutant General, WASHINGTON 25, DC, after 1 March 1946, will NOT BE considered. A formal application will be required regardless of whether or NOT a statement of interest or other form of application has been submitted previously. Each application will be prepared in duplicate. Both the original and duplicate will be signed and distributed as follows:
 - (1) An applicant on active duty will submit the application in duplicate through his immediate Commander.
 - (2) An applicant NOT on active duty or who is now on terminal leave will submit the application in duplicate direct to the Adjutant General, War Department, WASHINGTON 25, DC, Attention: AGSO-R or, if residing outside the continental limits of the UNITED STATES, to the Commander of the Theater in which residing.
 - (3) An Officer who desired to apply for appointment in the Judge Advocate General's Department and had less than 10 years constructive or actual commissioned service, but is between the age of 30 and 35 years, will submit his application and be processed in the manner prescribed by

- (4) Officers under the age of 35 years who desire to apply for commission in the Adjutant General's Department, may do so regardless of the limitation as to age and grade stated in paragraph 4(4) (2) of this circular.  - (2) Immediately upon receipt of the application by the Adjutant General, steps will be taken to procure an Officer Evaluation Report from the most suitable of the former Commanders listed on the application.
- (B) For those residing outside the UNITED STATES, including ALASKA:

 - (6) Transmission of the above completed papers by air or the most expeditious method to the Adjutant General, WASHINGTON 25, DC, Attention AGSO-R. All papers, with the exception as set forth in paragraph 9(E) (1) (2) (3), pertaining to an applicant to be submitted together, when completed, securely fastened without the use of staples which puncture the paper.
- (C) As soon as practicable, after the receipt of a duplicate application at a Personnel Center from an Officer on active duty, the Personnel Center Commander will request the appropriate Commander

in whose jurisdiction the applicant is stationed to issue necessary orders for the applicant to proceed to the Personnel Center specifying the date on which he should arrive. (D) Upon reporting to the Personnel Center, an applicant will be given the general survey test (WD AGO HRT 552). An applicant who fails to meet the requirements of this test will be disqualified and so notified immediately. However, any candidate possessing a degree from a recognized college or university who fails to complete the general survey test satisfactorily may present his own certificate to the effect that he possesses a degree from a college or university to the proper authorities at the Screening Center and receive authorization to complete the balance of the integration instruments. This certificate will be forwarded to the Adjutant General and the eligibility of this Officer for appointment in the Regular Army will be reviewed by a board of General Officers appointed by the War Department. (E) Each applicant who satisfies the requirements of the general survey test will be given a final type (Officer appointment type) physical examination as provided in AR 40-105 and Circular 59, WD, 1945. In addition, in the case of candidates being examined for flying status, the standards set forth in AR 40-110 will be applicable. The report of physical examination, with the exception of those made on applicants who are to serve on a flying status, will be recorded on WD AGO form 63. - (2) forwarded to the Adjutant General, WASHINGTON 25, DC, Attention AGSC-R, by air mail without delay. Physical examination report, WD AGO form 64, original and 2 copies on all applicants for flying status will be forwarded by the examining board directly to the Surgeon General, WASHINGTON 25, DC, by air mail without delay.
 - (3) In each instance where the individual does NOT meet physical standards as prescribed in the above cited regulations, the examining board will state whether or NOT a waiver is recommended; full information regarding the defect and the reason for recommendations on waiver will be included in each report. The report of physical examination will be transmitted as indicated above by air or the most expeditious method.
- (F) Each applicant who passes the general survey test and is physically qualified will complete the biographical information blank, (WD AGO MT 459) and will appear before the Officers Interview Board (see paragraph (G), below).
- (G) (1) Interview Boards which operate in the UNITED STATES, excluding ALASKA, will be appointed by the War Department. Those which operate outside the UNITED STATES, including ALASKA, will be appointed by Theater Commanders, and Commanding General Alaskan Department.

If after an examination of all lists, it is discovered that there are applicants who have NOT been recommended for commission, but whose composite scores are higher than any who have been recommended by a major Command, excluding specialists, as indicated in paragraph 11(C) (1) above, their names will be submitted to the respective appropriate major Command for consideration. The Adjutant General will be notified promptly of any resulting changes or substitutions.

- (B) When all recommendations are complete and the War Department Review Board has completed its action, successful applicants will be notified and commissions issued by the Adjutant General. List of those remaining in order of their eligibility will be retained in the files of the Adjutant General for consideration in the event of future further selections.

13. War Department Review Board.

- (A) All cases in which the applicant is rejected under the provisions of paragraph 11(D), above, will be referred to a Board of General Officers appointed by the Secretary of War.
- (B) When received back from the major Command of second choice, such cases will be referred by the Adjutant General to the review board together with all supporting papers, including reasons for rejection (see paragraph 11(D) above). This board will review each case, giving consideration to the reasons for rejection and will determine whether the rejection should be sustained. Action by this board will be final.
- (C) Upon completion of action by the review board, all papers will be returned to the Adjutant General, Attention AGSO-R, with indication as to the action of the board.
- (D) In those cases in which the board reverses the rejection, the Adjutant General will so advise the major Command concerned and place the applicant's name in the proper position on the list according to composite score.

SUBJECT: Officer Efficiency Reports

TO : All Concerned

1. The following instructions are issued to insure uniformity in the preparation of efficiency reports. The rendition of efficiency reports is the responsibility of the unit to which the officer is assigned or attached at the close of the reporting period. See also memo to AG 600-185, 15 November 1944, as amended by War Department Circular 131, 1 May 1945; paragraph 80, Change Number 2, TM 12-425, 10 April 1945; and WD AGO Form 67, 27 September 1944.

2. The following type of entries will be made under the applicable item on WD AGO Form 67:

a. Item A: Theater will be shown as "Mediterranean Theater". Organization will be the organization of the reporting officer. Date of report will be the date prepared by the reporting officer.

b. Item B: Serial Number will be shown as illustrated in paragraph 2, AR 345-1, 11 March 1944. Arm or service will be that in which commissioned or currently detailed. For warrant officers, other than bandmasters or army mine planter service, the entry will be "None". Component will be entered as MA, REG, IG or AUS.

c. Item C: When an officer has served in more than one organization during the reporting period, the prior organization and AIC number, the duty performed and manner of performance rating will be shown, and the notation that the entry was taken from WD AGO Form 66-1. Example: "160th Inf, APO 666, Platoon Leader, Pr 66-1, 3.4". The total number of days will include all nonduty periods and will equal the period covered by the report which will be computed by actual count. Example: "1 July to 31 December 1945 equals 184 days". Nonduty periods will be entered under one more headings as appropriate. Personnel to be reported under heading "staff" or "administrative and executive" is a command decision and will be based on type of duty performed. Duty assignment will be descriptive of the type of principal duty performed.

d. Item H: Where the answer is yes, a certified true copy in duplicate, or the favorable or unfavorable communication will be attached to the report. Both copies will be signed by the certifying officer.

Letters recommending promotions, awards, etc., are not considered as official communications to be included in the rendition of efficiency reports. Decorations and awards are not required to be reported but may, at the discretion of the reporting officer, be answered "yes" under Item 1 and an entry made under remarks showing nature of award, authority and date of presentation. Letters of commendation, criticism and reference to awards or decorations will pertain to the inclusive period of the report only.

c. Item 0: Where the reporting officer is not in a command position the words "Commanding What" will be X'ed out and the official capacity entered, i.e., AG of S G-1, Adjutant General, Engineer Officer etc.

3. Indorsements will in general be prepared in substance as prescribed in paragraph 13, AR 600-185, but may be appropriately modified to cover each case.

4. To insure compliance with paragraph 11b (3) and (7), AR 600-185, when an officer is reassigned a statement will be prepared and forwarded with his WD AGO form 66-1, showing all non-duty periods accrued since rendition of the last efficiency report.

5. Efficiency reports are considered to be confidential in nature and should be so handled, but it is not the intent of the War Department that individual reports be so classified, except when the report actually contains information that requires proper classification. Individual reports will be forwarded unclassified unless they contain information of a classified nature as defined in AR 380-5, or when the report is a part of reclassification proceedings.

6. Whenever an efficiency report is rendered under the provisions of paragraph 14, AR 600-185, the number sixty-seven will be entered in parentheses "(67)" in the column with the rating officer's initials under Item 15, WD AGO Form 66-1. Entry of manner of performance rating under Item 15, WD AGO Form 66-1 will be the numerical index of the officer's proficiency in the performance of a principal duty and will be determined by the use of a work sheet for Items G, K, and M of WD AGO Form 67, and recorded in its numerical form. Example: "Platoon Leader-112th Infantry Regiment -- 1 July 1945 to 31 December 1945 -- 4.7 - (67) ABC". (See WD Circular 131, 1 May 1945 and TM 12-425).
