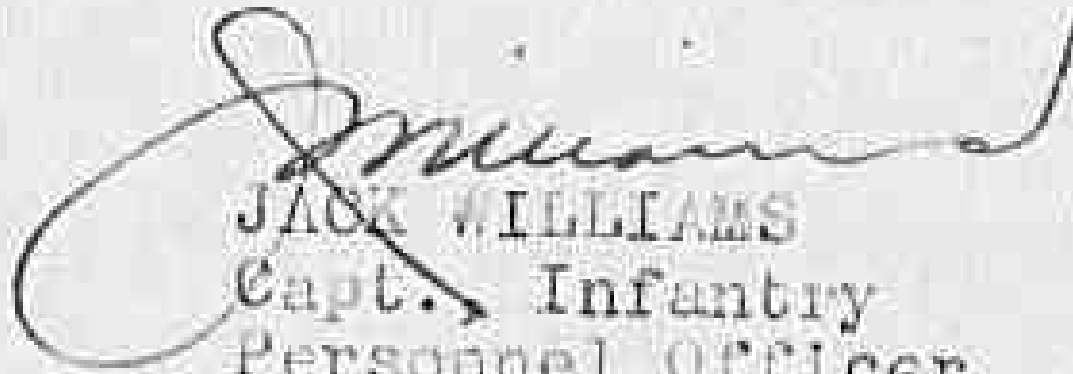

Dear Smith:

I understand that as you are not signing on for a further period in the Army you will be due for release about 31 July. It is proposed that Captain R.L. Bent should take over your duties and I wish you particularly to see he gets every opportunity of understanding them. Bent has not had rail experience so you will have to take special steps to see that he understands the rail work. This should not be too difficult for him since it is to a large degree being handed back to Italian control at Ancona; but the Senior Transportation Officer there will still have to retain an over-all control regarding priorities, etc.; the Movements Division is issuing instructions on this subject for the benefit of all concerned.

We are also issuing shortly a brief memorandum on the duties of Senior Transportation Officers. In the latter instruction I am showing Bent as Senior Transportation Officer. This is, of course, no reflection on you; but as Bent is staying on and you are not, he should get cracking on coordinating transportation work at Ancona as soon as possible.

I hope to see you before you depart from Italy.

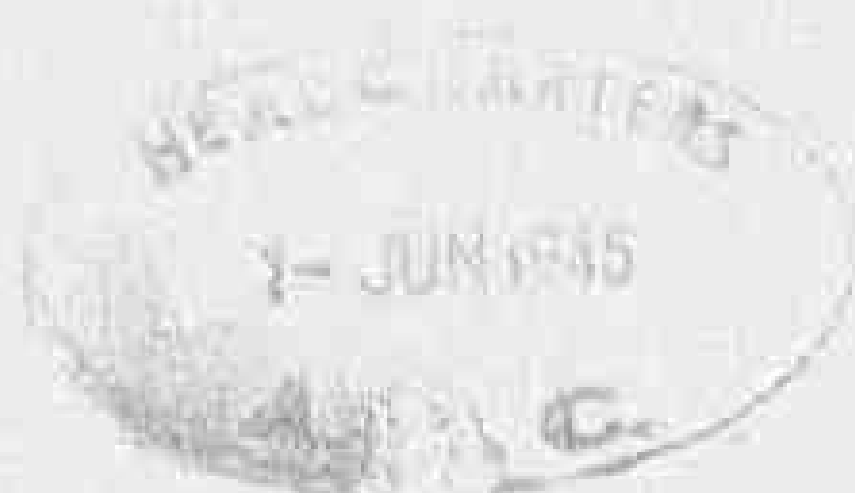

3. The grounds for my application are as follows:

(a) Upon release from the Service I am taking up Farming, as I was about to do when called up for service in 1939.

The Farming Year starts at Michaelmas (29 September), and runs longer normally starts from this date. As I have to find a farm, and negotiate for the purchase etc., there will be insufficient time for this before 29 September, if I am not released on the normal date for my group, the result of which means missing the opportunity of obtaining a suitable farm, as no available will have been disposed of by 15 August to the 1. 1. each later. 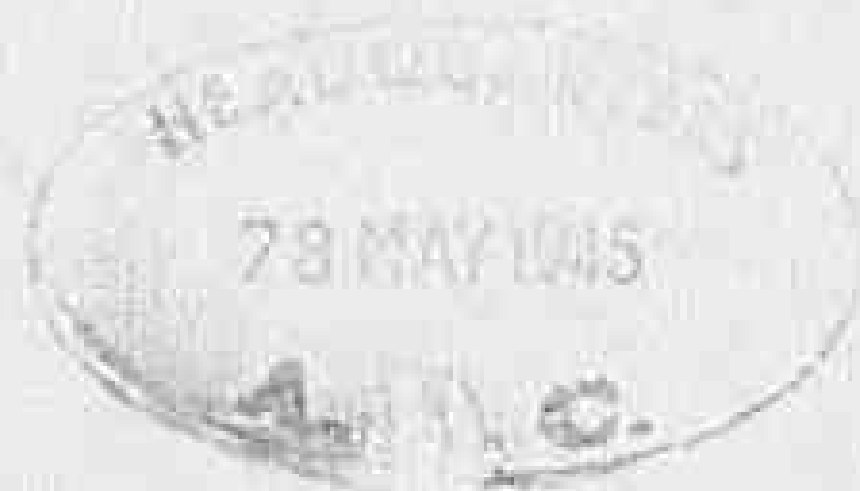
