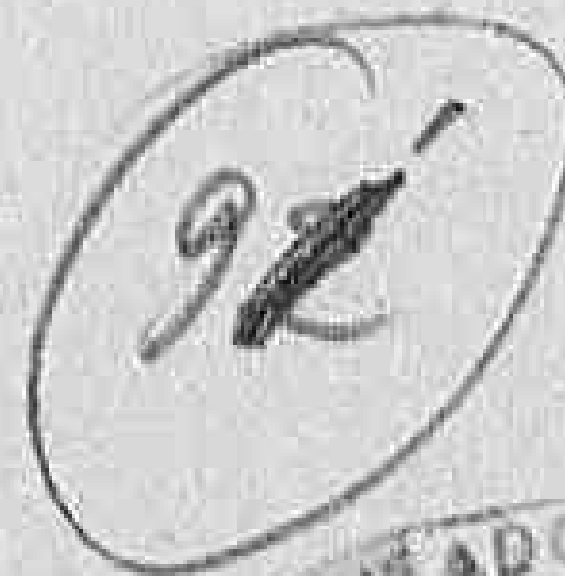

Sir:

The recent transfer of practically all Italian ports to Italian administration and control has resulted in a consequent diminution of my duties and responsibilities to an extent which, I believe, no longer calls for a man of my training and experience. It is, in fact, true to say that I am now reduced to performing mainly clerical duties which could be equally or better performed by a Clerk.

The impending closure of Allied Commission will, ipso facto, terminate my appointment thereto and, as I have no desire to transfer my services to UNRRA or to any other service in Italy which might detrimentally affect my status or which might lead to a prolongation of my agreed maximum period of foreign service, I would respectfully suggest that the War Office be now advised that my services are no longer required in this theatre and that I be recalled to the United Kingdom.

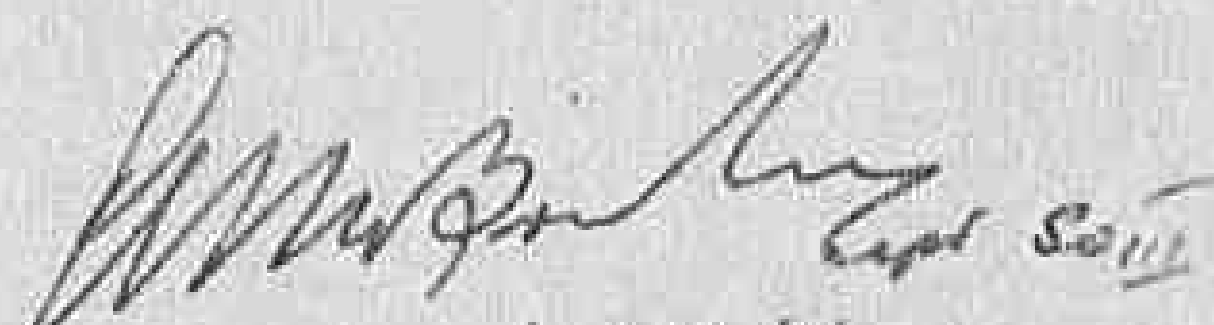

Further to this HQ letter of even reference dated 7 Aug 45, the full text of D.S. 43HQ letter M.6110 dated 5 Aug 45 is repeated for information and necessary action.

Reference is made to MAI Serial No. 4 para 60 of 7 Apr 45 and to GROS 263/45 and 712/45.

1. War Office have made it clear that personnel due for Release and suffering from Venereal Disease will be retained in a theatre overseas for the minimum time necessary to render them non-contagious. In effect this means as soon as they have completed hospital treatment.
2. By this definition therefore, personnel suffering from Venereal Disease are fit to proceed to UK under the Release Regulations immediately on discharge from hospital.
3. It has further been decided that it is not possible to justify one ruling in respect of personnel returning to UK on Release, and another for those returning for any other reason, e.g., LIAB, PYTHON, etc.
4. The criteria on which a Medical Officer will certify personnel under treatment or surveillance for Venereal Disease as fit to proceed to UK as laid down in MAI Serial No. 4 para 60 of 7 Apr 45 will therefore no longer apply.
5. So long as such personnel can be certified as free from contagion in the ordinary medical examination carried out in accordance with para 1168 King's Regulations 1940, they will be considered fit to proceed.
6. MAI Serial No. 4 para 60 of 7 Apr 45 will be cancelled in due course. It is requested however, that in the meantime this instruction be immediately brought to the notice of all Medical Officers."

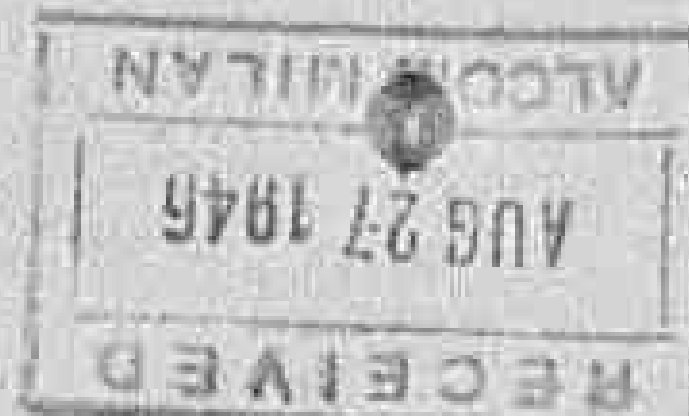
