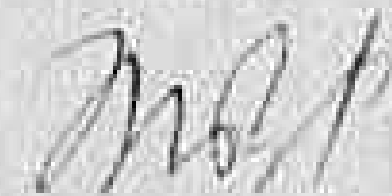

1. Transportation Sub Commission A.C. are trying to obtain the services of a qualified Railway Signal Engineer, and it has been suggested that Capt. E.M.
