MEMORANDUM:

TO: Lt. Col. L. E. Vining, Building.

1. As you know, various departments of the I.S.R. are continuously asking assistance toward procuring tires and spare parts for I.S.R. motor vehicles. I think it most important that I.S.R. have enough motor transport for key supervisors to cover their jobs and to shift materials. In the past, individual (departmental) requests have been individually handled - with little success. But the over-all picture has not been developed, so that a proper case can be presented.

2. I therefore recommend the assignment of an officer to develop from the I.S.R. exactly what motor vehicles they have in operation, what service they are performing; how many non-runners, where they are, and what is required to put them in running order; how many vehicles and what kinds are needed and justification for the need. In other words, a development of the facts as to what motor transport they have, its condition and use being made of it, together with a comprehensive statement of their minimum total needs and what will be required by way of additional vehicles, tires and tubes, repair parts, etc.

3. Then, when these facts are developed, request for such assistance as the facts justify should be made.

ATTENTION: Colonel D.S. Adams, Director

1. At meeting to day, during which locomotive position currently existant on mainland of liberated Italy was discussed, it was decided that 20 steam locomotives should be brought from Sicily. These locomotives to comprise two Class 735, 11 Class 740, and seven Class 480. This should completely eliminate Classes 735 and 480 from Sicilian roster and all repair parts exclusive to such classes should be assembled, loaded in cars and moved with locomotives; details of exact quantities of materials so moved to be furnished for information of Superintendent, Motive Power, who will advise disposition after arrival of cars at Reggio.

2. Experience in moving other rolling stock from Sicily indicates that "bottle-neck" will be at Messina-Reggio ferry. It is understood that Lt. Col. O. S. Lindberg, of Transportation Sub-Commission, is currently available and it is suggested that he be assigned to make transfer. Arrangements can be made to furnish him with appropriate transportation and a driver who is familiar with, and has assisted in, such moves - also a sergeant. It occurs that possibly Lt. Philby, now at Reggio, can be impressed to assist.

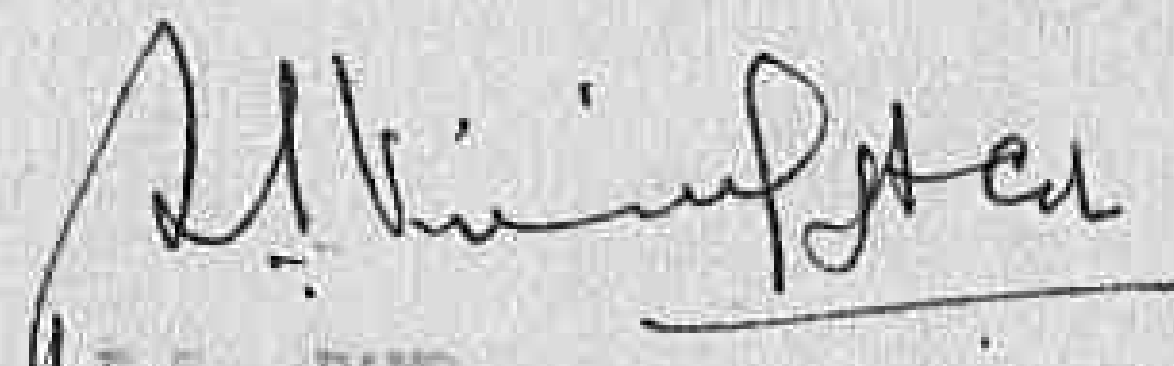
