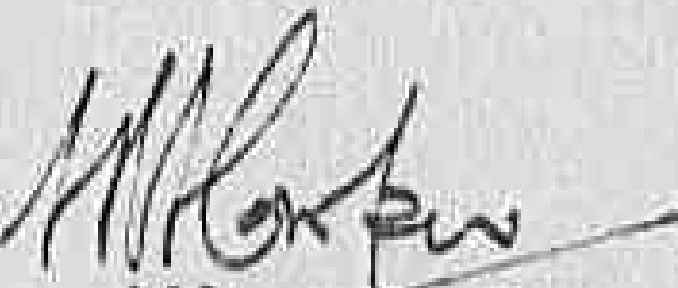
SUBJECT: - Port Liaison Officer, Venice.

TO : - HQ AC Transportation and shipping Branch.

1. Lt. Evans, the PLO Venice, has advised us that he expects to go over to UNRRA by 1st of April.

2. Please advise us who will replace Lt. Evans and when the replacement will be on the job.

3. For your information Venice is an exceedingly important port because many cargoes go in to Venice for Udine and Venezia-Giulia. A good PLO with the necessary staff is essential to see that Udine and Venezia-Giulia secure all the supplies arriving for them and to see that orders for the forwarding of the supplies for Udine and Venezia-Giulia are properly executed. As you know the supply of Udine and Venezia-Giulia are AC responsibilities and therefore the supervision of the clearance of the supplies at Venice appears to us also to be an AC responsibility.
