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REMARKS

1. Captain Long studied Sicilian railways, with particular reference to repairs necessary to war-damaged bridges, tunnels and structures to permit restoration of railway service, for both civil and military requirements, in conjunction with Military Railway Service, Allied Force, from 5-11-43 to 17-3-44, assuming increasing responsibilities as M.R.S. officers were withdrawn, in preparation for transfer of supervisory responsibility from M.R.S. to Transportation Sub-Commission, A.C.C.
2. On transfer of supervision, 18-3-44, Captain Long became responsible for developing and prosecuting plans for railway repair and re-construction, working in liason with Italian railway, civil and military authorities as well as in close co-operation with other military and A.C.C.agencies.
3. Under Captain Long's vigorous direction, restoration of damaged bridges, tunnels and structures advanced rapidly. Captain Long displayed ingenuity, energy and tact of highest order in co-ordinating activities and obtaining desired results.
4. Captain Long has had broad railway experience in civil life and by his work in Sicily has amply demonstrated his ability to cope with railway repair, reconstruction and operating problems now the responsibility of Transportation Sub-Commission, A.C.C., in wider fields of activity. Captain Long's promotion to next higher grade is amply justified and is respectfully recommended.

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
